TODAY'S GAME: The Curve open up a six-game series with the Harrisburg Senators, the teams meet a total of 24 times this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Altoona rallied for 3 runs in the top of the 9th to take a 9-6 win in the series finale at New Hampshire. **Henry Davis** picked up his third straight multi-hit game and **Matt Gorski** masked a 3-run homer in the win.

TRIPLE REHABBERS: The Curve welcomed UTL **Tucupita Marciano**, RHP **Duane Underwood Jr.** and LHP **Dillon Peters** on rehab on Tuesday, June 28 against Harrisburg. It marked the first time in franchise history that Altoona has hosted 3 rehabbing Pittsburgh Pirates in the same game. Marciano is recovering from a stint on the COVID IL (6/17), while Underwood is also recovering from a stint on COVID IL (6/13) and Peters is recovering from a back injury (6/3).

ONE HALF DOWN: With the first half of the season coming to an end on Sunday, June 26, the Curve finished the first half with a 33-36 record in 4th place in the Southwest Division. They rank 1st in Team BA (.252), R (340), 2B (129), and 2nd in OBP% (.335). In the month of June, Altoona leads the Eastern League with 93 BB.

MATTY G IS FOR ME: With his 23rd homer of the season on Sunday, June 26, **Matt Gorski** enters play on Tuesday, June 28 tied for first in MiLB in HR (23), 3rd in SLG% (.657), and 10th in OPS (1.030). Gorski leads Pirates MiLB in HR and is on pace to smack 30 homers this year, he would become the first Pirates minor leaguer to do so since **Mason Martin** hit 35 in 2019.

HAMMERING HANK: Curve C **Henry Davis** began his Curve career 3-for-35 in his first 10 games before stringing together 3 straight multi-hit games to finish the series at New Hampshire (6/24-26) batting: 6-for-12 with 3 2B, 1 HR, 5 RBI and 2 BB.

A GREAT START: **Matt Fraizer** knocked Altoona's second lead-off homer of the season on Thursday, June 23 at New Hampshire. Previously, **Nick Gonzales** homered on the game's first pitch on April 29 at Akron. It marked the 33rd time in franchise history that Altoona has hit a lead-off homer. **Jonah Davis** knocked a pair of them in 2021 for the Curve.

THAT'S ODD: With Saturday's walk-off loss at New Hampshire, Altoona has lost 6 games in walk-off fashion this season. RHP **J.C. Flowers** has been on the mound in three of them: May 28 at Harrisburg, June 9 at Reading and June 22 at New Hampshire.

BIG LEAGUE CURVE: With 2019-21 Curve OF **Bligh Madris** became the 194th alumni head to the majors after their time in Curve, PA with his major league debut on Monday, June 20 against the Chicago Cubs. Madris became the 11th alumni to debut this season, joining **Diego Castillo**, **Beau Sulser**, **Jack Suwinski**, **Cam Aldred**, **Cal Mitchell**, **Yerry De Los Santos**, **Canaan Smith-Njigba**, **Jason Delay**, **Liover Peguero** and **Cam Vieaux**. In 2016 and 2018 the Curve had 14 players make their debut, a figure that could easily fall by the time the 2022 season wraps up.

Curve INF **Liover Peguero** became the third player to be recalled directly to the major league roster on Friday, June 17 when INF **Tucupita Marciano** went on the COVID IL on short notice. Peguero arrived in Pittsburgh in time for first pitch and made his major league debut on Saturday against San Francisco going 1-for-3 with a walk. He became the first Pirate born in the 21st century to suit up for Pittsburgh.

LET'S HIT: The Curve have picked up at least 10 hits in 16-of-their-37 last games. Altoona has had 10 or more hits in a game 23 times this season, most in the Eastern League. The Curve lead the Eastern League in team batting average (.252) and total hits (580); they hold a 30-hit lead over the next highest team in the league (Bowie).

NO LEAD IS SAFE: Altoona has held a lead after 5 innings in 34 of 69 games played this season and hold an 23-11 record in those games. Since May 17, the Curve are 12-2 when they hold a lead after 5 innings.

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: Altoona pitchers have surrendered 73 home runs on the season, tied for 26th-most by a pitching staff in minor league baseball and fourth-most in the Eastern League behind Hartford (93). The Curve have allowed a home run in 43 of 69 games.

THE MEN FROM THE SENATE: Managed by **Tripp Keister**, Harrisburg finished the first half at 30-39 and continue to feature a veteran core. LHP **Brian Gonzalez** (Bowie, Hartford), **Ronald Herrera** (Trenton), **Franklin Kilome** (Reading), **Edgar Garcia** (Reading), **Wilson Garcia** (Akron) and **Dakody Clemmer** (Akron) all feature previous EL experience. Additionally, the Senators recently added 1B **John Nogowski** who had a cup of coffee with the Pittsburgh Pirates last season and provided quite a job.

THE FIRST TO FILIBUSTER: **Luis Reyes** takes the ball in the series opener for the Senators. Reyes made 2 appearances against Altoona in May and allowed 7 runs in 6.2 IP. He's also made 5 starts for Triple-A Rochester this year where he allowed 23 runs in 13.1 IP to begin the season. Reyes first made his way to Harrisburg in 2018, going 5-6 with a 5.18 ERA in 12 starts. He spent the 2019 season in Potomac going 5-5 with a 4.81 ERA in 31 games, seven starts, in which he struck out 78 batters in 76.2 innings pitched. Reyes signed as an 18-year-old for \$85,000 from the Dominican Republic.

CAREER NOTES

2022: Began the season as a member of the Curve rotation... Struck out a season-high 8 batters on 5/10 vs. Somerset... Became the first Curve starter to finish 6.0 innings on 5/21 vs. Richmond in the team's 38th game... Was suspended for 4 games on 5/25 stemming from Altoona's on-field disagreement with Richmond on 5/22, activated to start on 5/29 at Harrisburg... Brought a perfect game into the 5th inning on 6/4 vs. Bowie before allowing an infield single to Adam Hall, allowed back-to-back walks and an RBI double to Cesar Prieto to finish the outing... Allowed 2 HR in an outing for the first time in his career on 6/10 at Reading...

2021: Spent the entire season in the rotation for Low-A Bradenton and helped lead them to the Low-A East Championship... Went 5-3 with a 3.09 ERA in 22 appearances, 19 starts... **Finished the season ranked second in the Low-A Southeast and among Pirates minor leaguers with 113 strikeouts...** Bradenton's pitchers set their franchise record with 1,288 strikeouts, the ninth-most in all of minor league baseball... Started on Opening Day for the Marauders and struck out five in 3.0 innings allowing just one run... Struck out seven batters in 4.0 innings in his second start of the season on May 11 at Dunedin... Finished the month of May with a 1.42 ERA (2 ER / 12.2 IP) and struck out 16 batters...
