The Round Rock Express and Salt Lake Bees (Los Angeles Angels) are set for game two of their six-game series on Wednesday night from The Ballpark at America First Square. First pitch is scheduled for 8:05 p.m. CT.

E-TRAIN RALLY IN GAME ONE

Round Rock came away with a 6-3 win on Tuesday against Salt Lake. The Bees stung first with a run in the second when LF Corey Holland drove RF Chad Stevens in on a single and Salt Lake led 1-0 after two. In the fourth, Stevens posted a leadoff single. Salt Lake later scratched another run across as 3B Yolmer Sánchez hit a sacrifice fly and Stevens scored for a 2-0 lead. Round Rock stole the lead in the top of the seventh. SS Michael Helman belted his second homer for the E-Train and 3B Cody Freeman hit a two-run shot to take a 3-2 edge. Salt Lake CF Kyren Paris responded with a homer in the bottom of the inning to tie it up at 3-3. The Express put two on in the eighth with a walk and a base hit. LF Billy McKinney poked a single into left and DH Trevor Hauver scored the go-ahead run. Strahm came home on a C Cooper Johnson groundout for a 5-3 E-Train advantage. In the ninth, Express 1B Blaine Crim singled and sent 2B Alan Trejo around after his leadoff double. Round Rock RHP Joe Barlow retired the side in the final frame giving the Express a 1-0 series lead in the 6-3 win.

CORY IN THE HOUSE

Round Rock RHP Cory Abbott is slated to make his fourth start and fifth appearance on Wednesday night. Abbott's last outing came in 2.0 scoreless innings of relief in the E-Train's 2-1 win over Reno on May 29. Abbott was not the pitcher of record but held the Aces to two hits and a walk while striking out two. He threw first-pitch strikes to seven out of nine total batters faced.

FREEMAN FEELING IT

3B Cody Freeman recorded his sixth consecutive game with at least two hits after going 2-for-4 with a double and a homer in Tuesday's opener. Freeman is batting .450 (18-40) with four doubles, two homers, 13 RBI, eight runs scored, four walks and four strikeouts during his current nine-game on-base streak. His 18 hits since May 23 are tied for third most in the minors.

NO FREE PASSES

The Express pitching staff surrendered just two walks and struck out eight batters in Tuesday's win. It marks the 12th time this season and third time in their past five games they have allowed two walks or less. Round Rock surrendered a home run last night for the first time since May 25 at Charlotte.

KEEP AN EYE ON KELLEN

Round Rock OF Kellen Strahm nabbed his 21st stolen bag of the season yesterday. He is second in the PCL in stolen bases and tied for fourth in all of Triple-A. Strahm is on pace for 54 steals this year which would put him one shy of the club record set by OF Willy Taveras in 2004.

SEARCHING FOR THE SERIES

The Express have two series victories this year with their last coming April 15-20 at Reno. Round Rock went 6-14 from April 25-May 13. Since May 14, they are 10-8.

BIG LEAGUE EXPERIENCE

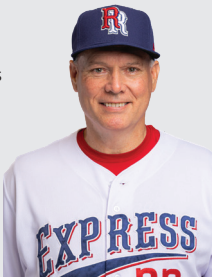

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
