STELLAR PITCHING PILOTS RIDERS TO WIN OVER SOD POODLES:

Josh Stephan pitched six shutout innings to help the Frisco RoughRiders defeat the Amarillo Sod Poodles 3-1 on Thursday night from HODGETOWN. Stephan (4-1) earned the victory, fanning four while walking none to secure his second quality start of the season. Frisco (28-19) struck first in the top of the second when **Tucker Mitchell** rolled an RBI groundout to pull the Riders ahead 1-0. **Cam Cauley** then drilled an RBI double in top of the third, extending the lead to 2-0. In the top of the eighth, **Luis Mieses** pounded his seventh home run of the year to push Frisco's lead to 3-0. Next half inning, Amarillo (21-27) broke through when Jack Hurley cranked a lead-off homer, trimming the deficit to 3-1. RoughRiders reliever **Janser Lara** allowed Hurley's homer, but recovered to notch a six-out save. The Sod Poodles put runners on second and third in the bottom of the ninth before Lara induced a flyout to seal the win. Amarillo starter Avery Short (3-4) took the loss despite spinning a quality start, yielding two runs across six frames.

OFFENSE COMES ALIVE IN AMARILLO:

Since HODGETOWN opened in 2019, the RoughRiders have played 12 more games there than any other Texas League visiting team, and they have enjoyed their time offensively. In 74 games in the Yellow City, the Riders are averaging 6.3 runs per game and 1.75 home runs per game. For comparison, the Riders are averaging 5.0 runs per game and 0.95 homers per game overall since 2019. Since 2005, the RoughRiders have had 11 single games in which they have hit six or more home runs and seven of them have come in Amarillo.

SAVE TONIGHT:

On Thursday night, **Janser Lara** became the 11th different Riders pitcher to record a save in 2025. Frisco is the only team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. Current Triple-A Round Rock pitcher **Robby Ahlstrom** and **Gavin Collyer** are tied for the lead in saves (four) for the Riders and **Skylar Hales** has recorded two saves. Frisco's 18 saves are the most in Minor League Baseball and tied for the most in franchise history through their first 47 games.

OVER THE WALL-COTT:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 13 games, he has blasted four home runs while slugging .554 with five doubles, nine RBIs and nine runs scored. His six home runs for a 19-year-old in Double-A are tied for the seventh-most since 2005 through 47 team games, trailing Oscar Taveras (10), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (10), Fernando Tatis Jr. (9), Delmon Young (9), Jackson Churiso (7) and Samuel Basallo (7).

RISP-ECT THIS:

The RoughRiders overall are hitting .232 with runners in scoring position, but have struggled over their last 30 games. In that stretch, the Riders are 16-14, batting .187 (.45-for-241)/.262/.299/.561 with RISP. Their .193 batting average is ninth in the Texas League and 27th among 30 Double-A teams.

ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. In his last 17 games, Ortiz is hitting .303 (20-for-66)/.395/.545/.940 with four doubles, four home runs and 16 RBIs. Over the last two seasons, Ortiz's five home runs in HODGETOWN are the most by a visiting player in the Texas League. He is hitting .381/.447/.786/1.233 with two doubles, five home runs, 11 RBIs and 11 runs scored in his career in Amarillo.

MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:

The RoughRiders have both hit and given up their fair share of long balls this month. They have hit 23 this month, which is fifth in the league and have allowed 31, which is the most. Frisco's 4.90 ERA is eighth in the league during the month while they are 14-10 in May.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .309 (30-for-97)/.447/.505/.952 over his last 29 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (37) and OBP (.430) while leading the league in walk rate (22.4 percent), a mark which also ranks 4th in Minor League Baseball (min. 150 PA). In May, he is hitting .325/.458/.494/.952, ranking seventh in average, first in OBP and fifth in OPS in the Texas League.

BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first eight starts, his 1.94 ERA is first in the Texas League. He has the best start to a season through eight starts in recorded franchise history by ERA. His 3.6 percent walk rate, 8.5 K/BB and 91.9 percent left on base rate are the best in the Texas League. His 51 strikeouts are the second most in the Texas Rangers organization and his 41.2 innings are the most thrown among Rangers farmhands.

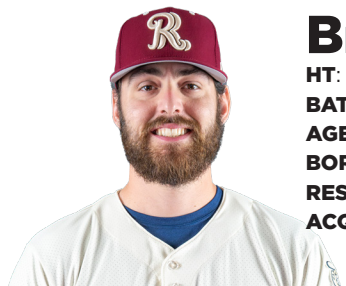

ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2025 SEASON

-In his first outing of the 2025 season, worked out of the bullpen in long relief, allowing four runs over 3.2 innings to Corpus Christi.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out three side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John" ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22
