Today's Game

The Clippers will send RHP Trenton Denholm to the mound today looking to win consecutive games for the first time since a 5G win streak from 3/28-4/2 (only consecutive wins all year). Iowa will counter with LHP Jordan Wicks. Columbus is 1-5 (.167) versus left handers this year. Wicks has faced Columbus four times in his career, going 1-2 with a 5.23ERA (10.1IP, 11H, 6R, 6ER, 4BB, 16K).

vs. the Cubs

Since a 5G win streak against Iowa from 5/12-6/14/24, the Clippers are 15-15 opposing the I-Cubs (30-22 in the last 52 matchups). In Columbus, the Clippers are 26-22 all time (2-0-5 in 6G series, 0-2-0 in other series). Individually, CJ Kayfus has 5HR and 15RBI in 19G against Iowa in his career, while Nolan Jones has hit 9HR with 31RBI in 30G and Milan Tolentino has 8HR and 18RBI in 19G.

No Repeats

Last night saw the first Clipper win on a Friday this year, after starting the campaign 0-3 (now 5-21 on Friday since starting last season 5-0). The Clippers will hope the Saturday trend continues, as they are unblemished this season (3-0; 29-9 on Saturday since starting the 2024 season 2-12). Tomorrow will bring hope for another trend reversal, as Columbus is 1-2 on Sundays (8-24 since September 2024).

Deficit Shmeficit

The Clippers overcame a 3-1 deficit last night (most comeback wins in the IL, 9), after Wednesday's 4-run comeback (third of the year; no other IL team has more than one, nine teams don't have any). Columbus owns five wins when trailing by at least three (three teams have two wins, five teams have zero). In all, the Clippers have trailed in 18 of 19G this year (only team without multiple no-trail games).

On the Screws

The lineup has produced 13HR in the last 7G (242AB; had 13HR in first 12G, 398AB) with 22 of 39 runs scored in the last 7G being the result of a long ball (56%; homers provided 19 of first 69 runs scored, 28%). However, the Clippers are tied for last in the IL with homers off LHP (1HR in 131AB, George Valera), as only 4% of the team total are off southpaws (largest HR split in the IL, next closest is 8%).

Modest Streak

Travis Bazzana saw his 6G hit streak snapped last night (11x24, 6XBH, from 4/10-4/16; was 2x18 with 0XBH in 4G prior). He was able to extend his on base streak with a walk and, though his walk rate is down this year (14% in 18G, 24% in 26G last year), he has the 2nd most walks in the IL (41) since his Triple-A debut on 8/12/25. Bazzana has not homered since 9/7/25 (82AB) and is just 3x18 with RISP.

Bounce Back

Stuart Fairchild was only 4x27 (.148) in 8G after going 4x4 on 4/3 vs. Indianapolis, having gone hitless in each of 17AB until his 2-run homer on 4/15. He followed up with a single and a double on 4/16 (fifth multi-hit game of the year). Milan Tolentino was just 6x33 (.182) in 10G after doubling twice on 4/2 vs. Indianapolis, but he is 5x9 with a double, 3HR and 8RBI in his last 3G (4/15-4/17).

Gearing Up

Kahliil Watson snapped a 19AB hitless streak Saturday, going 3x4 with a triple and a couple bombs (second career 2HR game, 6/18/25 with Akron), and followed up with doubles on Tuesday and Wednesday (+270 in SLG over last 5G, had 1XBH in first 12G). Unfortunately, Watson has 4K in his last 5AB (26K, t-3rd most in the IL), but he does rank 7th in the IL with 15BB (only IL batter in top ten of both).

Delayed Start

Kody Huff was 1x8 with 5K in March, but has rebounded to hit in 11 of 12G during April (.304, 14x46), drawing 8BB to 10K. He has 11RBI this month, including an RBI streak of 4G from 4/3-4/8 (8RBI total), while also scoring 12 times (four of those on 4/7 at Worcester). His 10G hit streak to start the month was a career best but, as a catcher, he is producing a .718OPS in 7G (.977OPS in 7G at first base).

What's That

Codi Heuer's save last night was the first for Columbus since closing out March with saves in three straight (only Charlotte and Indianapolis are still saveless in April). Including the opponents, it was just the fourth save in a Clipper game this month (all 4G in March featured a save). Despite the small number of saves converted, the majority of Clipper games (11) have been within a 3-run margin.

This Date in Clipper History

4/18/1993

Billy Masse hammered a grand slam to lead the Clippers to a 9-1 victory over the Pawtucket Red Sox at McCoy Stadium. Masse led the Clippers in hitting (.316), RBI (91) and runs scored (81) in 1993 on his way to being named Clipper of the Year. He also homered 16 times and tallied 35 doubles, then a Clippers franchise record, on his way to leading the International League in extra base hits.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,413 to 1,362).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 25-23 (.521) in pitch reviews this season, with batters going 14-16 (.467) and pitchers/catchers going 11-7 (.611). They have run out of challenges in 9G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 0-1 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-34 when playing past regulation (.595, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 84G to require extra play, 67 have been resolved after one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 15th in the IL this year (.973), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 10G this season (6-4, .600), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Milan Tolentino moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 4/7 at Worcester and those runners came around to tie the game in an eventual win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-22 (.792) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-1 (.500, blew 7-run lead in loss) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 396-415 (.488), 366-369 with Columbus (.498).
