Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Rorik Maltrud** to the mound tonight, looking to avoid three straight losses for the first time since a 5G losing streak from 7/11-7/19. The Mets will counter with RHP **Tobias Myers**. Columbus is 47-32 (.595) versus right handers this year. Myers has never pitched against Columbus in his career, but was 1-9 with a 6.00ERA in 14GS for the Clippers in 2022.

vs. the Mets

The Clippers have won the season series in five of the last seven years they have played the Mets (lost in 2023, split in 2019) and have triumphed in 36 of 57G (.632) dating to 6/11/15. They were 2-4 in Syracuse in 2024 (5-1 in the home slate) and 2-3 at Syracuse in 2023. Individually, **George Valera** has hit .319 (15x47) with 7HR and 16RBI against Syracuse in 13G of his career (6HR in 7G at NBT).

Jump Start

Columbus has outscored the opposition 60-18 in the first four innings of the last 10G, with last night marking the first time the Clippers did not lead heading into the 5th since 7/26. Opponents have then outscored Columbus 40-19 from the 5th-9th. The Clippers have scored first in six straight games and nine of the last 10 (Toledo scored first on 7/31 and Columbus took the lead in the bottom half).

Getting Offensive

Over the last 10G, the Clippers have plated a total of 79 runs (most in the IL, 7.9 per game), after coming out of the All-Star Break with 35 runs in the first 9G (16th in the IL, 3.9 per). Columbus had 2HR in 288AB of those first 9G, but have shaken off the rust to the tune of an IL-best 26HR in the last 326AB. Last night snapped a streak of 9G with at least six runs scored (longest in stretch in the IL this year).

Ingle is Back

In 22G since his option, **Cooper Ingle** is 35x93 (.376), drawing 13BB (.449OBP) with 15XBH (6HR, .667SLG). He is one of two in the IL (**Max Anderson**, Toledo), hitting .300/.400/.500, but is 1x13 (HR) since his 11G hit streak was snapped on Wednesday (still has 14G on base streak, .449OBP since 7/23). At catcher, Ingle has a 1.338OPS (15HR) in 39G (.660OPS and 3HR in 33G between DH and LF).

One from One Hundred

Kyle Manzardo singled on Thursday for his 99th career hit as a Clipper (106G). Though he is hitting just .263 in a Columbus uniform, he boasts a .551SLG as 56% of his hits have gone for extra bases (only 21XBH outside of Huntington Park, .455SLG; 34XBH and .647 at home). In addition, he has put together a walk rate of 16% (74BB in 464PA) against a strikeout rate of 18% (82K).

Take it on the Road

Ralphy Velazquez has homered in each of 3G in Syracuse (13AB; had 2HR in 100AB of previous 25G on the road), boosting his OPS away from Huntington Park to .691 (.883OPS in 29G at home). Velazquez also homered three times last week vs. Toledo, as he leads the IL with 6HR since 7/28 (also 1st with a .853SLG, 12RBI ranks 4th). He has only 4K in his last 7G (31PA; 9K in 24PA of 6G prior).

Rare Company

Dating to the nightcap vs. Scranton/WB on 6/19, **Milan Tolentino** is 30x101 (.297) in his last 33G, collecting 18XBH (.614SLG) and 23RBI (was 5x39, .128, in 13G prior). He is one of 11 in the IL with at least 13HR and 13SB, along with **Kahlil Watson** (Columbus and Omaha are only IL teams with two). Tolentino is tied for the 2nd most HR in the IL since the start of the 2025 season (35; 1HR off LHP).

Rosario on the Rise

Alfonsin Rosario enters tonight having hit safely in each of his last 6G (8x21, .381), after starting his Triple-A career hitting .118 (4x34) in his first 10G. Rosario scored in six straight games until last night and been successful in all three steal attempts with Columbus (one of six in MiLB with at least 15SB and 0CS). When the Clippers are leading, Rosario is hitting .333 (11x33; 1x22 when trailing or tied).

Problems on the Back End

Since allowing 7ER in 4.1IP at Lehigh Valley on 7/12, the Clipper bullpen has registered an IL-worst 7.97ERA in 20G (79.0IP, 70ER). Clipper relievers have surrendered 18HR in that time (+2 on all other teams), allowing a line of .276/.397/.519. The bullpen has not put together a scoreless outing since back to back games vs. Louisville from 7/4-7/5 (84ER in 25G since; 50ER in 25G prior).

This Date in Clipper History

8/8/1996

For the second consecutive night, **Ivan Cruz** hit a grand slam off of Syracuse. Cruz was 2x4 with a HR and 4RBI in a 6-0 win the previous night and on 8/8 he went 3x3 with 2HR and 5RBI as the Clippers won 12-4. He would finish the season as an IL All-Star at first base, pounding out 28HR (tied for 11th in Clipper history) to go along with 96RBI (tied for 7th). All-time, Cruz ranks 5th in HR (65) and 8th in RBI (227).

First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,469 to 1,414).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 164-127 (.564) in pitch reviews, with batters going 84-78 (.519) and pitchers/catchers going 80-49 (.620). They have run out of challenges in 44G and have not challenged in 5G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 826, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 127 through 111G (on pace for 170SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 37CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 2nd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (50; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Crazy Eighthths

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 159 runs while crafting an .889OPS (nearly 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 102 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +57 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 256-160 from innings 5-7).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 79 grand slams and 1,977RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.38 through 111G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). Additionally, the staff is pacing to give up 197HR (average of 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 8th in the IL this year (.980), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 60G this season (36-24, .600), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Good Baseball

CJ Kayfus bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers have the 4th most last at bat wins this year (14, four off the lead) while playing in the 7th most games decided in the last at bat (27, Memphis has 31). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 101G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 48-53 (.475, 16th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 445-458 (.493), 415-412 with Columbus (.502).

June Swoon:

In his first 10G of the year (March-May), Maltrud gave up 15ER in 50.2IP (2.66ERA), holding the opposition to a .195 average (38x186, 4HR). He gave up multiple runs in each of 5G in June (17.1IP, 15ER) and struggled in July also (22.0IP, 12ER), as he posted a 6.18ERA (39.1IP, 27ER) over the two months. Opposing hitters batted .294 (48x163) with 10HR in 10G from June-July (9HR to last 107BF).

Undecided:

Through the month of June, Maltrud was the only pitcher in the IL with at least 10GS that had not taken a loss and his lone win (4/11 at Worcester) made him the only starter with a single decision. He was 2-1 through 5GS in July, winning back to back starts to begin the month and suffering his first loss of the year in his 17th start (7/22 at St. Paul). Despite a 3.93ERA as a starter and run support of 5.5 per game, Maltrud has left with the lead only nine times because the offense is averaging 2.5 runs while he is the pitcher of record, including 11G with two runs or fewer (5G with zero runs).

Efficiency is Key:

Through 99 innings started in 21G, Maltrud has retired the side with fewer than 10 pitches on 13 occasions, including a 4-pitch inning on 4/3 vs. Indianapolis, while turning in 21 innings of more than 20. He has hit 30+ three times, thanks to an 11-pitch battle vs. Iowa's **Pedro Ramirez** on 4/17 (walk, 34 in the inning) and a 14-pitch skirmish with Buffalo's **Yohendrick Pinango** on 4/23 (groundout, 30 total). He ranks 4th in the IL with 15.6 pitches per inning (16.6 per in last 11G).

Among the Leader Beans:

Entering today's game, Maltrud is 7th in the IL with a 4.02ERA (18 qualifiers, was in the top five prior to allowing 7ER in 3.2IP at St. Paul on 7/22). From his quality start win on 4/11 at Worcester through his quality start on 5/25 at Toledo, he crafted the 2nd best ERA in the IL, at 2.14ERA (42.0IP, 10ER). Additionally, Maltrud's 0.95WHIP in that time ranked 2nd best (1.29WHIP on the season places 6th).

Stepping Up:

With runners in scoring position this season, Maltrud has held the opposition to a line of .163/.258/.225, surrendering just 1HR in 80AB. With a runner at first base, he has struggled to a line of .292/.354/.514 while allowing 4HR (72AB) and with the bases empty, the bad guys have hit .256/.315/.434 with 10HR in 219AB.

Pitch to Contact:

Maltrud's Triple-A debut on 3/28 at Iowa was the 44th game of his career and marked his 37th consecutive start (reached 41GS before relief appearance on 4/30 vs. Toledo, all 7G in relief of career have come on starter's rest and been at least 3.0IP). He did not punch out any Cubs in that game (15BF), marking his second straight game without a strikeout (37BFwith 0K from, 9/10/25-4/3/26; had at least 1K in all 42G prior). Among 102 pitchers in the IL that have at least 220BF this year, Maltrud has the 30th best walk rate (8.3%; 34BB to 410BF) and the 64th best strikeout rate (20.2%, 83K; had worst rate, 11.9%, through first month of the year).

In Relief:

Maltrud has pitched twice in relief this season (previous 5G out of the bullpen came among first 7G as a pro), piggybacking **Trenton Denholm** on 4/30 vs. Toledo (3.0IP, 40 pitches) and **Daniel Espino** on 6/2 vs. Omaha (4.0IP, 81 pitches). He has registered a 5.14ERA out of the bullpen (7.0IP, 11H, 4R, 4ER, 2BB, 13K),
