LAST OUTING: Ashby went a season-high 5.1 innings, allowing five hits, two earned runs and striking out three.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Ashby's fourth career appearance versus Memphis. Two outings came in 2021with him allowing one earned run across 3.2 combined innings. His most recent outing was on April 13 where he allowed seven earned runs in 2.1 innings of work.
