Tonight's Game: The Sounds and Redbirds play game four of the series tonight. Memphis has won two of the first three games including a tight win last night that was aided by a go-ahead home run in the seventh inning. The game finished in 2:07 which was just six minutes shy of the shortest game of the season for Nashville. Tonight, left-hander Aaron Ashby will be on the bump for the Sounds. Memphis will use Giovanni Gallegos as the opener and then turn to Sem Robberse.

Aaron Ashby: The 26-year-old left-hander will make his 10th appearance (ninth start) for the Sounds this season. He is 0-3, with an 8.10 ERA (36.2 IP/33 ER) and a 38/35 K/BB ratio. In his last outing versus Charlotte on May 25, Ashby went 5.1 innings, allowing five hits, two earned runs and striking out three. He is second in Triple-A in walks behind Connor Phillips from Louisville (39). He had one start for the Brewers that came on April 8 at Cincinnati where he went 3.2 innings, allowing six hits and eight runs (four earned). He has walked at least two batters in every outing this season but has improved with a 17/9 K/BB ratio over his last three starts. His 5.1 innings pitched in his last start matched a season-high that he set on May 12 at Durham. Ashby has 41 appearances (24 starts) in his MLB career. He missed the end of the 2022 season and most of the 2023 season rehabbing a shoulder injury, totaling just 7.0 innings of work. His last win came against the Pirates on July 8, 2022. He was drafted in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft by the Brewers from Crowder College (MO).

Giovanni Gallegos: The 32-year-old right-hander will make his first career Triple-A start in a rehab appearance. He has 303 career outings in the MLB for the Yankees and Cardinals. This season for the Cardinals, Gallegos is 2-1 with a 12.00 ERA (9.0 IP/12 ER) and 13 strikeouts. He was placed on the 15-day injured list on May 6 with a right shoulder impingement.

Sem Robberse: The 22-year-old right-hander will make his 11th start for the Redbirds this season. He is 5-2, with a 3.28 ERA (60.1 IP/22 ER) with 59 strikeouts. He is tied with Carlos Rodriguez for ninth place in Triple-A strikeouts. In his last outing at Durham on May 25, he went 5.2 innings, allowing two earned runs, three walks and struck out six. He has at least four strikeouts in every outing this season. The Netherlands native currently ranks as the no. 12 prospect for the Cardinals according to MLB Pipeline. He was signed by the Blue Jays in 2019 but was acquired in a trade by the Cardinals along with Adam Kloffenstein for Jordan Hicks in July of 2023. He was a Futures Game Selection in 2023 for the New Hampshire Fisher Cats in the Blue Jays system shortly before being dealt. He grew up watching the Yankees in the Netherlands and his father taught him mechanics by looking at pitchers such as Roger Clemens and Nolan Ryan (Rob Terranova, MLB.com).

Streak is Dead: Isaac Collins' 17-game on-base streak came to an end last night with an 0-for-3 performance. His streak was the longest by a Sounds player this season. During the Streak, Collins hit .345 (20-for-58) with five doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI, 11 walks and 16 runs scored. Overall, Collins is first on the team in doubles (15), and walks (30), and is second in total bases (84). Additionally, he is tied for fifth in the International League in doubles and is tied for sixth in runs scored (38).

Quality over Quantity: Though being charged with the loss, Carlos Rodriguez dealt in last night's game. He went a season-high 6.2 innings, allowing five hits, two earned runs, two walks, and had four strikeouts. The 6.2 innings in an outing was the longest by a Nashville starter this season. Rodriguez has four consecutive quality starts and is now tied with Chad Patrick for the most this season on the Sounds (5). In five starts in May, he is 3-1, with a 3.03 ERA (29.2 IP/10 ER), with a 33/7 K/BB ratio. He threw a career-high 106 pitches which topped his previous best at 105 pitches which he did on September 1, 2023 at Tennessee while pitching for Biloxi.

Das Haase: Eric Haase had the only extra-base hit for the Sounds yesterday with a solo home run in the sixth inning to tie the game. His six home runs on the season are tied for third on the team and he is fourth in RBI with 24. He also threw out his fifth attempted base stealer last night. Base stealers are 6-for-11 while running on Haase this season. In comparison, runners attempting to steal on the other Nashville catchers are 35-for-40.

On and Off: Nashville is 6-4 in their last 10 games and has gone through ups and downs with the offensive production during the stretch. In the six wins, the Sounds are averaging six runs per game. In the four losses, they are averaging just 1.75 runs per game. They are 3-16 on the season when scoring three or fewer runs compared to 24-8 when scoring four or more runs.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 711-609 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,303-2,129 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

LAST OUTING: Ashby went a season-high 5.1 innings, allowing five hits, two earned runs and striking out three.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Ashby's fourth career appearance versus Memphis. Two outings came in 2021 with him allowing one earned run across 3.2 combined innings. His most recent outing was on April 13 where he allowed seven earned runs in 2.1 innings of work.
