TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Las Vegas Aviators will get set for game five of the series on Friday night. Express RHP Shaun Anderson is slated to start against Aviators RHP J.T. Ginn. First pitch at Dell Diamond is set for 7:15 p.m. CT.

Express Manager, PR & Broadcasting Rylan Kobre will handle play-by-play duties.

SUBLIME SHOWING

The Express earned a 8-2 win on Friday night over the Aviators at Dell Diamond. The E-Train celebrated All Things Pink Night with a sublime showing, taking a commanding 3-1 lead in the six-game series. Round Rock opened the scoring in the bottom of the fifth inning thanks to an RBI single by 3B Alex De Goti which plated 2B Jax Biggers. DH Andrew Knapp provided a sacrifice fly to double the lead at 2-0. E-Train CF Jose Barrero increased the lead to 3-0 in the sixth after a sacrifice fly to the warning track brought home 1B Blaine Crim. In the top of the seventh, Las Vegas got on the board for two runs to cut the Round Rock lead to 3-2. CF Daz Cameron drove in LF Logan Davidson on a fielder's choice followed by an RBI single by SS Jacob Wilson, scoring 2B Max Muncy. The Express broke it open in the bottom of the seventh as they plated five runs to make it 8-2. Knapp brought home LF Dustin Harris with an RBI single. Crim drove in SS Jonathan Ornelas and Knapp with another single. RF Sandro Fabian rounded out the scoring in the inning with an RBI double that scored C Sam Huff and Crim as the E-Train rumbled to the victory. Round Rock has taken three of the first four games in the series and is 8-2 in their last 10 games.

ANDERSON ON THE BUMP

Express RHP Shaun Anderson takes the baseball on Friday. Anderson is coming off his third consecutive victory in which he pitched 7.0 innings of one run baseball while striking out a career-high 10 hitters. He is 3-0 with a 2.12 ERA (4 ER/17.0 IP) with 18 strikeouts on the season.

KEEPING THE LEAD

The E-Train improved to 16-0 when leading after seven innings and 17-0 when leading after eight frames. Round Rock's bullpen shut the door on Las Vegas with 4.2 innings of scoreless baseball.

GERSON IS THAT GUY

Express RHP Gerson Garabito went 4.1 innings and allowed one hit with two walks and seven strikeouts last night. His one hit allowed marked the fewest hits he has allowed in a start since April 8, 2018 when he allowed one hit over 6.0 innings with High-A Wilmington.

TEAM EFFORT

Three Round Rock hitters recorded multi-RBI games on Friday. DH Andrew Knapp went 2-for-3 with two RBI, a walk and a run scored. 1B Blaine Crim went 3-for-5 with a double, two RBI and a run scored. RF Sandro Fabian went 1-for-3 with two RBI and a double.

FABIAN IS FEASTING

Round Rock OF Sandro Fabian recorded two RBI in Friday night's win over Las Vegas and he has 26 on the season. He leads the team in RBI while he is tied for first on the team in batting average (.342) with OF Derek Hill. Both Fabian and Hill are tied for third in batting average in the PCL behind Albuquerque's Drew Romo (.349) and El Paso's Tim Locastro (.345).

CATCHING FIRE

Since losing seven consecutive games, the Express are 13-5 in their last 18 games which is the best record in all of Triple-A in that span.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
