THAT WAS A WEIRD GAME: After dropping a wild back-and-forth game in the series opener in Columbia last night, the FredNats aim to bounce back against the Fireflies (Kansas City Royals) tonight in game two of this six-game series. Tonight, RHP Brayan Romero starts once again for the FredNats, aiming to build on a quality start last week against Fayetteville. The Fredericksburg offense was shut out in the game so Romero took a tough luck loss, but he allowed just one run on one hit in the start against the Woodpeckers, his best with Fredericksburg to date. He faces Columbia lefty David Shields, who is Kansas City's 5th-best prospect.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats pieced together a lineup to get to the end of the game, using 13 of the available 15 positions players in a 9-6 loss to the Fireflies in the series opener last night at Segra Park. Cristhian Vaquero and Elijah Green both had RBI triples and Green hit his first home run back with Fredericksburg. Kevin Bazzell was not retired in four trips to the plate, and Angel Feliz had a single, a walk and a stolen base in his FredNat debut. Victor Farias and Bryant Olson made their Fredericksburg debuts on the mound.

DON'T EVEN TRY IT: After picking up another CS last night, Fredericksburg's MiLB-leading caught stealing total is up to 75. Heading into play today, Kevin Bazzell leads MiLB by four with 47 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 400 innings this year, throwing out 41% of would-be base stealers. Bazzell has also had his best month of the season offensively in July, hitting .304 with a .744 OPS this month with an OBP of .396.

HE'S INEVITABLE: FredNat outfield prospect Cristhian Vaquero picked up his MiLB-leading fourth walk-off hit of the season Saturday night, and overall, he's enjoyed a very strong second half of the season offensively, pairing his hot bat with his exceptional outfield defense. In 26 second half games, Vaquero is hitting .340 (3rd in CL) with four home runs (3rd), and he leads the league with a .948 OPS in the half. He also leads the league in the second half in slugging (.563), total bases (58), and he's tied for second in hits (35). Since the All-Star break, Vaguero is 15-for-31 (.484) with a 1.112 OPS.

GREENY BOMB: Elijah Green hit his first home run since returning to Fredericksburg last night, traveling 414 feet to the deepest part of the cavernous Segra Park. Since returning to Fredericksburg, Green has cut his strikeout rate by 15%, and he has an OPS of .748. Green led the 2024 Carolina League championship squad with 14 home runs last season.

THIS BULLPEN IS INSANE: The FredNat bullpen has been central to the team's efforts all season, but the group has taken it to a new level since June 1. Since then, FBG's bullpen ERA is 2.65, which is currently number three in professional baseball (150 total teams). Fredericksburg is 34-1 when leading after seven innings this season, and 28-1 when leading after eight innings. Fredericksburg's 15 saves in that time frame is also tied for the fourth-most in Minor League Baseball.

ROSTER MOVEMENT: Yesterday, LHP Pablo Aldonis and C Nate Rombach were promoted to Wilmington, and MiLB rehabbers Brenner Cox and Elijah Nunez join the team. Cox was a two-year FredNat and a 2024 Carolina League champion, and Nunez was on the Opening Day roster this year before a mid-May promotion to Wilmington. Aldonis leaves the Carolina League as the owner of the longest active scoreless inning streak in the league (22.0), a number that is still the second best in all of MiLB among active pitchers. Rombach was part of a catching duo that continues to lead MiLB in caught stealings heading into this series.

THE STAFF: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

MEET HIM: Brayan David Romero...(pronounced: Bryan) was activated from the injured list and returned to Fredericksburg on 6/7 after completing a rehab assignment with the FCL Nationals.

NOT THE FIRST TIME: Romero is making his second stint with the FredNats after making seven regular season starts in FXBG last year. The righty posted a 5.52 ERA across 29.1 IP with 13 strikeouts to five walks. This is his third season in the Nationals organization.

LAST TIME OUT: Romero had his best start of the season last week against Fayetteville, pitching six one-hit, one-run innings with four strikeouts. Despite his performance, Romero got the loss, as the FredNats were shut out by the Woodpeckers 2-0.

FIRESTARTER: Romero started game one of the Carolina League Championship series in 2024 at Kannapolis. In an eventual FredNat win, he threw 4.1 innings, giving up three earned runs to the Cannon Ballers.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
