#### FIVE-RUN KNIGHTS SECOND DOOMS SHRIMP

Graham Pauley homered twice on Thursday but Charlotte scored five runs in the second to beat Jacksonville 10-5. After a Knights run in the first, Pauley tied the game in the top of the second. However, in the bottom of the frame, a Jacob Amaya home run and Tim Elko grand slam made it 6-1. Deyvison De Los Santos plated two runs with a base hit in the third and Pauley scored his second shot to make it 6-4 in the fourth. However, Charlotte added three in the bottom of the fourth to go up 9-4 en route to their 10-5 triumph.

#### WHEN YOU'RE HOT, YOU'RE HOT

Jacksonville has now won 15 of their last 21 games heading into play on Friday. Since this stretch began on June 10, the Jumbo Shrimp have outscored their opponents by a whopping 126-80 (+46) margin. The club has yielded the third-fewest runs (80) in Triple-A while also ranking third in both ERA (3.56) and fewest hits allowed (154) and fourth in BAA (.233). Offensively, Jacksonville ranks first in home runs (37), third in slugging (.503), fourth in both OPS (.859) and steals (36), tied for seventh in runs (126), ninth in hits (199) and batting average (.278).

## MARSEE-SAW

Heading into play on June 8, **Jakob Marsee** was hitting just .193 with a .651 OPS. Since that point, the Allen Park, Mich., native has registered hits in 18 of his 21 starts, including 11 contests with multiple hits. During this stretch, Marsee is 31-for-84 (.369)/.438/.762/1.200 at the plate with five doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 16 RBIs, 11 walks and 16 runs scored. On the season, Marsee leads the IL in steals (39) and walks (52) while sharing the league lead in triples (5). He also ranks 23rd in OBP (.374) and tied for 25th in hits (69).

## BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry mustered just a .126 batting average and .452 OPS with 35 strikeouts through his first 30 games on the season. The Queen Creek, Ariz., native has completely changed around his season since that point. Over his last 36 games, Berry has earned more walks (20) than strikeouts (18) while going 33-for-107 (.308/.423/.495/.918) at the plate with nine doubles, one triple, three home runs, 19 RBIs and 21 runs scored.

#### **CHARLOTTE'S WEB**

Jacksonville has dominated their season series with Charlotte, going 7-2 against the Knights thus far in 2025. That said, nearly every game between the two clubs has been a nail-biter. All but two of the contests has been decided by three runs or fewer, including four by just one run. Interestingly, despite these razor-thin margins, the Jumbo Shrimp have hit significantly better against Knights pitching than the other way around. In these nine games, Jacksonville is slashing .280/.376/.490/.866 compared to a .210/.298/.345/.643 line for Charlotte.

#### THE MORE. THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/ Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 84 games this season, the Shrimp have already used 24 different starting pitchers. Of the three lid-lifters to register double-digit starts for Jacksonville in 2025, only one is still in the rotation (Adam Mazur). Freddy Tarnok is now a member of the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen while Robinson Piña is a member of the Toronto Blue Jays' organization. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 323.0 innings (3.8 per start) this season, the fourth-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.71 starters' ERA ranks third at the level.

## **MACK TRUCK**

In 30 games from May 10-June 21, **Joe Mack** went just 18-for-113 (.159) at the plate, totaling just a .428 OPS. The East Amherst, N.Y., native has been on an absolute tear over his last nine games, however. During this stretch, Mack is a whopping 18-for-36 (.500/.526/1.028/1.554) with four doubles, five home runs, nine RBIs, two walks and 10 runs scored. Mack is also the first Jumbo Shrimp to be selected for the MLB All-Star Futures Game since right-handed pitcher **Sixto Sánchez** in 2019.

## SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp scored at least four runs in 18 of its last 21 games, including 16 contests with five tallies or more... At 52-32, Jacksonville is off to its best start since the 2006 Jacksonville Suns started 54-30... **Graham Pauley** recorded his fifth career multi-homer game on Wednesday.
