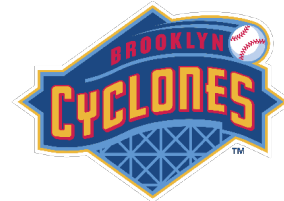

**ABOUT SUNDAY:** Brooklyn broke out the power bats, hitting five home runs in a doubleheader sweep of the Hudson Valley Renegades to nail down four of the six games in the series against the New York Yankees affiliate. In game one, a 5-4 Brooklyn win, INF **Shervyen Newton**, INF **Jose Peroza**, and OF **Jaylen Palmer** each homered. In game two, a 3-1 Cyclones win, Newton and Palmer went deep again. RHP **Nolan Clenney** turned in his best professional outing in game two, striking out eight over five innings of one-run ball, including five strikeouts in a row in the middle of his outing.

**FLY ME TO THE MOON:** Brooklyn took its first-ever flight on Monday en route to Bowling Green, Ky. for the first-ever series at Bowling Green Ballpark, flying into Nashville and driving north. The Cyclones have also never played at Greensboro, Rome, Hickory, or Winston-Salem -- all new Brooklyn opponents since the shift to High-A in 2021.

**ARM ASSISTANCE:** RHP **Mike Vasil** and RHP **Carson Seymour** have joined the team in Bowling Green after earning their respective promotions from Low-A St. Lucie. Vasil, the No. 21 prospect in the Mets system, according to *MLB Pipeline*, was drafted out of Virginia in the 8th round last season, while Seymour was selected in the 6th round out of Kansas State last year.

**ASCENSION:** RHP **Jesus Vargas** was promoted to Double-A Binghamton on Saturday before the game, earning the promotion after posting a 2.03 ERA over seven games and one start with Brooklyn. In a corresponding move, RHP **Grant Hartwig**, a reliever, earned a promotion from Low-A St. Lucie and joined the bullpen.

**WHO ARE THESE GUYS?:** The Cyclones entered Sunday's doubleheader with seven home runs in 34 games which ranked at the fewest in Minor League Baseball. The Cyclones hit a whopping five home

**vs. BOWLING GREEN:** The Tampa Bay Rays affiliate currently leads the South Division of the South Atlantic League with a 23-15 record. Brooklyn and Bowling Green have split the first six games of the season series, coming in Coney Island. The Rays have four of their Top 30 prospects, including RHP Seth Johnson (8), OF Heriberto Hernandez (16), 1B Kyle Manzardo (26), and SS Osleivis Basabe (28).

runs over the doubleheader with Hudson Valley, receiving two from both OF **Jaylen Palmer** and INF **Shervyen Newton** and one from INF **Jose Peroza** for his first blast of the year. Currently, the Cyclones have hit 12 home runs, which is now the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball.

**CHANGES:** There were many changes throughout the Brooklyn Cyclones and the Mets organization on Sunday, including the releases of RHP **Colby Morris** and RHP **Evy Ruibal** who were both in their second season with the Cyclones. At Double-A Binghamton, 2019 NYPL Champion OF **Jake Mangum** was promoted to Triple-A Syracuse, while OF **Antoine Duplantis**, who was also a league champion in 2019 with Brooklyn, was released.

**METRIC MATT:** C **Matt O'Neill** leads the team with a 124 wRC+ and a .374 wOBA, according to Fangraphs. O'Neill has 12 walks and just 13 hits, reaching base on walks at a 18.1% clip which ranks highest on the team. For his career, O'Neill has 65 hits and 81 walks, batting .223 with a .403 OBP.

**ROUGH N' ROWDEY:** OF **Rowdey Jordan**, the Mets' 11th-round selection out of Mississippi State, ranks tied for third in the South Atlantic League with 12 doubles, sitting five behind the league leader Luis Mieses of Winston-Salem. The Brooklyn outfielder leads the team with 45 total bases and is tied for the team lead with INF **Wilmer Reyes** who have both collected 13 RBIs.

**BACK AT IT:** Oscar Rojas makes his sixth start of the 2022 campaign and second one against Bowling Green.

**GB RATE:** Rojas has a 51.3% ground ball rate, the highest of his career. This year, Rojas' fly-ball rate is 25%. Last season, Rojas' ground ball rate was 35.6% and his fly ball rate was 37.9%. The reduction in fly ball has meant a reduction in home runs. Last year, Rojas allowed 18% of his fly balls to leave the yard, while just 5.3% of his fly balls have left the yard this season.

**LEAGUE LEADERS:** Rojas leads the South Atlantic League in FIP with a 3.03 mark and has the second-lowest ERA in the league (2.45), the fourth-lowest WHIP (1.06), and the sixth-lowest opponents' average (.215).

**OSCAR THE GROUCH:** Rojas' 2021 campaign with Low-A St. Lucie was impressive, collecting two shutouts and three complete games with the Baby Mets.

**METS CAREER:** Rojas has pitched 41 times over a Mets minor league career that began in 2017. The Mexican missed 2019 due to injury, but pitched in the Mexican Winter League the following season -- during the 2020 shutdown of the Minor League season -- tossing 35.1 innings over 13 appearances for Guasave.
