TAYLOR HOMERS TWICE, MORENO ONCE IN FISHER CATS WIN: The Fisher Cats snapped a season-high five game losing streak in style, utilizing three home runs and excellent pitching to propel themselves to an 8-3 win. Gabriel Moreno homered off of the hotel in left-center field, becoming the first Fisher Cat to do so since Vlad Guerrero Jr. in 2018. Samad Taylor hit two home runs, retaking the team lead with six on the season, and becoming the second Fisher Cat to have a multi-home run game this season (LJ Talley, 5/20 vs Portland). Johnny Barbato went 5.1 innings in his Fisher Cats debut, allowing three runs on six hits with five strikeouts.

DON'T LET SAMAD GET HOT: With his two home runs last night, Samad Taylor now has six on the season. It was Taylor's second two-home run performance of his career after going yard twice with Dunedin on July 1st, 2019. His seasonal career high is nine, which he set in 121 games with Lansing in 2018. All six of his home runs have been at home, and all seven of his multi-hit games also came at Delta Dental Stadium, where he is hitting .400 on the year. He is currently on pace for a whopping 25 home runs over the course of a 119-game season.

MARTIN MAKING STRIDES: With just 106 plate appearances as a pro, Austin Martin has upped his batting average to .256 and has a .387 OBP. He has 22 hits in 24 games, with five doubles, a triple, and a homer. He also has walked 14 times to lead the team while being hit five times, and at present he carries a 10-game on base streak.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: June 6, 2016---In a 9-2 win over Erie at Delta Dental Stadium, Matt Newman homered twice – his first two after being promoted from Adv. A Dunedin. All nine Fisher Cats had a hit in the game. Austin Bibens-Dirkx allowed one run (unearned) in his five innings for the win, and Richard Bleier (3 IP) and Randy Boone (1 IP) also pitched in the game.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays beat Houston 6-2 yesterday, setting up the rubber game of the series today. Vlad went 3-for-4 with a home run, his 18th, and drove in a pair. Tim Mayza worked a scoreless innings in relief. Triple-A Buffalo lost 7-6 to Syracuse in Trenton with Kevin Smith and Riley Adams hitting back-to-back homers in the sixth. Eugene topped Vancouver 7-4 and Bradenton dispatched Dunedin 11-1.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats will head to Hadlock Field in Portland for their third meeting with the Sea Dogs (Red Sox) this coming week, before returning home to face the Hartford Yard Goats (Colorado Rockies) for the first time this year.

ROSTER MOVES: June 4: RHP Johnny Barbato signed to a minor league contract and assigned to the Fisher Cats. RHP Cre Finrock placed in IL. **June 3:** RHP Sean Rackoski activated from IL.

ON THE HILL: Texas native Kyle Johnston gets the start today, looking to avenge his first loss of the year in the series opener in which he was held to just three innings of work, tied for his season low. His counterpart will be Tony Dibrell, who picked up his first win of the year in a six inning, four hit performance on Tuesday. Dibrell was a fourth-round selection by the Mets in 2017 from Kennesaw State, and he went 0-8 in nine appearances (eight starts) with Binghamton in 2019.
