- Clearwater smashed seven home runs to route Dunedin 12-3 on Independence Day at TD Ballpark.
- The Threshers opened the scoring with a Bryson Ware 3-run home run in the top of the third.
- Jared Thomas, Yemal Flores and Avery Owusu-Asiedu hit back-to-back-to-back home runs to highlight a five-run fifth.
- Bryson Ware and Nikau Pouaka-Gregory went back-to-back in the eighth.
- Dunedin was shutout through seven innings, but rallied for three runs in the bottom of the eighth. Arjun Nimmala tripled to open the inning, and Nic Deschamps drove him home on an RBI groundout. With two outs, Tucker Toman and Manuel Beltre punched back-to-back RBI doubles.
- Clearwater's 16 hits were the most by a Jays opponent this season, beating the previous high of 14, also achieved by Clearwater on April 17.

## NOT SO LUCKY SEVEN

Dunedin surrendered a season-high seven home runs last night - their most since surrendering seven against Bradenton on July 31, 2021. The seven bombs are the most in a single-game by any Single-A team this season. The Blue Jays hadn't allowed more than three in a single game this season.

## FEELING LOPSIDED

Last night's nine run defeat was the largest margin of defeat for the Blue Jays since they lost 12-2 against Fort Myers on May 11. The Blue Jays have lost by six or more runs just nine times this season.

## 4,000 ON THE 4TH

Last night's home crowd of 4,522 was the D-Jays largest home attendance of the season.

## HITTERS PARK

TD Ballpark has proved to be the second-most home run friendly park in the Florida State League this season, as the Blue Jays and their opponents have combined for 66 home runs at the Venue. Bradenton's LECOM Park has seen the most homers with 74, while BayCare Ballpark is third with 64. The Blue Jays lead the league with 37 home runs allowed at home.

## THE HOME COOKING TASTES BAD

Blue Jays pitching has struggled at TD Ballpark, posting a 4.50 ERA in 39 home games; the second-worst in the Florida State League. On the road, the Jays 3.63 ERA is the third-best.

## TUCKER TOMAN'S TURNAROUND

After going 61 games without one, Tucker Toman collected back-to-back three-hit outings for Dunedin on Tuesday and Wednesday. Toman has ripped an extra base hit in three straight games, after going eight straight without one.

## NICE TO SEE YOU, NIMMALA

In five games since his return to Dunedin from the FCL Blue Jays, Arjun Nimmala is 8-23 (.347) with five extra base hits. Nimmala was placed on Dunedin's development list on May 14, and then was assigned to the FCL Blue Jays on June 3. Nimmala was the Blue Jays first round draft pick last season, and is the organization's third-ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

## JOEY VOTTO STILL BANGS

After opening his minor league rehab assignment 0-12, Joey Votto has reached base in three straight games, including a three-hit performance on Tuesday at Clearwater. Votto stole a base on Monday, his first stolen base since June 18, 2021.

## FERNANDO IS THE FUTURE

It was announced Tuesday that Blue Jays RHP Fernando Perez would represent Toronto in the All-Star Futures game on Saturday July 13 in Arlington. In 13 starts this season, Perez ranks among the Florida State League leaders in ERA (3.60), Ks (76), innings (70), and WHIP (1.04). Perez is the first active member of the Dunedin roster to be selected since Francisco Rios in 2016.

## REHAB CITY, USA

Including Wednesday night's starter Ricky Tiedemann, Dunedin has hosted 14 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Joey Votto's rehab assignment from AAA-Buffalo continues tonight. Other notable rehabs include Alek Manoah, Damiano Palmegiani (AAA), and Riley Tirota (AAA).

## SERIES SUCCESS STYMIED

Last week's four-games to two series loss to Lakeland snapped a streak of six straight sets with at least a split for the D-Jays. The team's last series loss came on the road at Fort Myers, May 7-12. Dunedin can get back in the series win column with a win tonight.
