STRONG PITCHING NOT ENOUGH IN 2-0 LOSS: Despite a solid effort from the pitching staff, the New Hampshire Fisher Cats fell to the Harrisburg Senators (Washington Nationals) 2-0 on Wednesday night at FNB Field. The Fisher Cats (39-43) managed just six hits in the loss, with Chavez Young being the lone hitter who recorded multiple hits, finishing 2-for-4. Following a lengthy rain delay prior to the game, the Senators took the lead quickly in the first inning against Fisher Cats starter Jeremy Beasley (L, 0-1). Cole Freeman smacked a leadoff double and later moved to third on a Jackson Cluff fly out to center. Then, with Donovan Casey batting, Freeman scored on a wild pitch to put Harrisburg on top 1-0. Harrisburg added on another run in the third against reliever Connor Law (2.2 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 2 BB, 2 K). After Brady Lindsly singled with one out, Freeman followed with a ground-ball single to right to put runners at the corners. Jackson Cluff then hit a sacrifice fly to up the Senators lead to 2-0. Cade Cavalli (W, 3-3), who ranks as a top-100 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, dominated the Fisher Cats, holding them to just four hits while walking two and striking out six in seven innings. Carson Teel earned the save with two shutout innings.

SOUTHERN COMFORT: The Fisher Cats are now 5-3 against the Southwest division on the season. They took the first four games against Bowie and required a stellar outing from Grayson Rodriguez to break what was at that point a seven-game winning streak.

UP NEXT: Next week, the Fisher Cats will head to Hartford to conclude the season series with the Yard Goats. This is New Hampshire's second and final 12-game road trip of the year. The Fisher Cats have won or split ten of the last eleven series played. The Fisher Cats will face Harrisburg 10 more times this season to round out the season series with the Southwest division.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: August 12, 2016—The Fisher Cats slipped past Trenton 5-4 at ARM & HAMMER Park. Conner Greene went six hitless innings with six strikeouts, leaving with a 5-0 lead. New Hampshire took the no-hitter to the ninth. Dustin Fowler singled to start the inning. After an error and a walk, Billy McKinney hit a grand slam to make it 5-4. Chris Smith came out of the bullpen to notch the save. Five different New Hampshire players drove in runs.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays pounded the Angels 10-2 last night behind a strong effort by Alek Manoah. Manoah struck out 11 in 6.2 IP to improve to 5-1. George Springer homered twice, Teoscar Hernandez went deep, and Lourdes Gurriel had three hits including his 13th home run...Triple-A Buffalo won 5-0 over Rochester, scoring all five runs in the second inning. Nash Knight hit a three-run homer in the frame...Vancouver handled Everett 10-4 as Orelvis Martinez hit his third homer in his eighth game for the Canadians...St. Luice won 1-0 over Dunedin in a rain-shortened game...Blue Jays FCL squad dropped a doubleheader to Tigers West.

24-year old Luis Quinones makes his fourth start since being promoted from Adv. A Vanouver. He is still looking for his first win. Struck out 10 Yard Goats last Friday, but did not figure in the decision in a game New Hampshire would win 8-5. He is one of the top strikeout pitchers in the organization with 85 this season in 52 innings.

Harrisburg starter Jackson Tetreault is 2-0 in three starts since joining Harrisburg. Missed first two months of season, but has now made eight starts. Beat Erie last Friday with five innings of two-run ball in a game the Senators won 7-6. Nationals seventh round pick in 2017 (State JC of Florida).
