Last Night: Lugnuts 8, Whitecaps 1. A night after collected 17 hits in a 15-9 victory, the Whitecaps were held to five singles by Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang and Jake Garland and the Nuts' offense scored in each of the first six innings in cruising to the victory in two hours and two minutes, ending an eight-game losing streak.

#### Lug•Notes

Streaking: Euribiel Ángeles went 2-for-3 with a walk last night, extending his team-high hitting streak to 11 games.

Spreading the Wealth: The Nuts notched 11 hits on Tuesday and 12 hits yesterday, but no hitter collected more than two hits either night. Euribiel Ángeles, Jonny Butler and Casey Yamauchi each collected two hits in each game.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.261), runs (375), total bases (944), triples (31), on-base percentage (.351), slugging percentage (.404) and OPS (.755), and is tied for 1st in base hits (609) and doubles (123).

Three's a Charm: Leadoff hitter Jonny Butler entered the series with only one triple all season, but tripled to lead off the bottom of the first inning on Tuesday and then drilled a two-run triple and an RBI triple last night, tying the single-game franchise triples record and becoming the first Lugnut to have two triples in a game since... himself, on April 15, 2023. The Lugnuts' 31 triples overall for the year is tied with the Aberdeen Ironbirds for third in all of Minor League Baseball, trailing MiLB-leading Albuquerque by four. In contrast, the MLB-leading Detroit Tigers have 23 triples.

Big Willie Style: Jacob Wilson, a Nuts star last year and the A's No. 1 prospect, has returned from the IL with two multi-hit games, giving him a .406 avg. in eight games in Triple-A (13-32) and a .455 average (61-134) in 35 games overall this year.

Prospecting: Lansing has five MLB Pipeline Top 30 Athletics prospects: pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2), outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 10), first baseman Will Simpson (No. 24), southpaw Will Johnston (No. 27) and outfielder Brayan Buelvas (No. 29).

Nothing but Goose Eggs: 2022-23 Lugnuts pitcher Grant Holman has pitched 30 scoreless innings between Double-A and Triple-A this season, 19 1/3 with Midland and 10 2/3 innings with Las Vegas, the most scoreless innings for any MiLB pitcher. Holman tossed 1 1/3 scoreless innings last night, fanning two.

#### **TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY**

**2010:** Lugnuts starter Ryan Shopshire brought a 4-0 lead over Dayton to the 9th at Cooley Law School Stadium, looking for a CG shutout. After two hit-by-pitches and a single loaded the bases with one out, Shopshire struck out Josh Garton... and then gave up a two-out game-tying grand slam to Cameron Satterwhite. Shopshire was taken out, having pitched 8 2/3 innings to a no-decision. In the bottom of the 11th, though, Mike Konstanty walked Chris Hopkins with the bases loaded to force in the winning run, giving the Lugnuts a 5-4 victory.

**2015:** Tim Locastro hit his second inside-the-park home run of the season, a solo shot down the third-base line in the third inning (aided by LF Ross Kivett slipping), and Shane Dawson struck out nine West Michigan Whitecaps in 7 2/3 innings in a 5-1 win on Saturday night at Cooley Law School Stadium. Locastro was also hit by a pitch for the 20th time, tying the franchise single-season record. He broke the record the next day (though it has since been surpassed by Nick "Ball Magnet" Sinay's 39 HBPs in 2017).

In a Nutshell: Pitched in 2023 with the Nuts, returning to the Midwest League this season... spent the offseason training in Alabama with Tyler Baum... opened the season in a tandem with Opening Day starter James González... González was promoted on May 8, so Myers made the next four starts without a piggybacker... joined a tandem with Chen Zhang-Ao Zhuang beginning June 2... now with Grant Judkins, following a rainout last week in Beloit... notable splits:

**Respect:** Mitch posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Monkey Ball...* he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

**Hometown Hero:** Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

**The Buc Starts Here:** Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

**Onward to Pitt:** Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five... the last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016 and spent 2022 with the Cincinnati Reds.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.
