#### **ACOSTA LEADS SHRIMP TO 5-3 WIN**

Maximo Acosta homered and matched a career-high with four RBIs on Thursday to lead Jacksonville to a 5-3 win over Columbus, Acosta drove in a pair with a two-run single in the first and Jacob Berry added an RBI single in the third. Acosta smashed a two-run homer in the third to make it 5-0. Jhonkensy Noel went deep in the fourth and Will Wilson added another homer in a two-run fifth to get things to 5-3. The Clippers failed to get a hit the rest of the way after the fifth inning, as the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen cmbined for 4.2 scoreless innings of relief.

#### I DON'T KNOW ABOUT YOU. BUT WE'RE FEELING 22

With one more victory over the weekend against the Clippers, the Jumbo Shrimp would snap a drought of five consecutive sets without a series win - the club's longest since going eight sets in a row from May 9-July 3 of the 2023 campaign. The Jumbo Shrimp's recent four-game winning streak has pushed the club 22 games over .500, matching the club's high-water mark this season. Should Jacksonville win on Friday against Columbus, the club would be 23 games over .500 for the first time since their 82-58 mark that closed out the 2009 season.

#### THE CHICKS DIG IT

Over the first 63 games of the season, Jacksonville cracked only 52 home runs, tied for the 26th-most in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp have blasted 66 round-trippers over the last 41 games since June 10, the most in Triple-A during this span. Jacksonville has plated at least four runs in 29 of these 41 games, a rate of 70.7 percent. In comparison, the Jumbo Shrimp had plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent).

#### THE MORE, THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/ Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 104 games this season, the Jumbo Shrimp have already used 27 different starting pitchers. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 404.0 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.72 starters' ERA ranks third at the level.

#### IT GFTS LATE FARLY

With their starters working such a small amount of innings, Jacksonville's bullpen has been forced to shoulder the load throughout the 2025 campaign, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have worked 500.1, or 55.3 percent, of the club's 904.1 innings this season. Despite the huge workload, which marks the fourth-most innings of any bullpen in Triple-A, Jacksonville relievers have posted the level's best ERA (3.69) and BAA (.213). Over the last nine games, the club's bullpen has worked 45.1 innings, yielding only 14 runs, 13 earned, on 26 hits (5.2 H/9) for a 2.58 ERA. They have combined for 59 strikeouts (11.7 K/9) and 15 walks (3.0 BB/9).

#### SNELLING BEE

Jacksonville starter Robby Snelling is coming off a career performance on Saturday at Durham. The 21-year-old lefthander struck out a career-high 11 batters in 6.2 innings just one out shy of matching a career-high. The 11 strikeouts were the most for a Jumbo Shrimp pitcher since Trevor Rogers notched 12 on August 25, 2022 against Norfolk. On Saturday at Durham, Snelling recorded a 44.2 percent whiff rate, including 54.0 percent on his fastball.

#### PARTY LIKE IT'S 1968

Tuesday's series opener between the Jumbo Shrimp and Clippers was the first visit for Columbus to Jacksonville since September 18, 1968, the final game of the 1968 Governors' Cup Finals. The Jacksonville Suns/Mets swept the Columbus Jets by scores of 6-1, 6-4, 2-1 (11 innings) and 3-1, with the final two games played at Wolfson Park. That 1968 title marks the city's lone Triple-A championship.

#### **BERRY BLAST**

Jacob Berry mustered a .126 batting average and .452 OPS with 35 strikeouts through his first 33 games this year. The former LSU Tiger has completely changed around his season since that point. Over his last 56 games, Berry has nearly drawn more walks (27) than strikeouts (29) while going 53for-173 (.306/.403/.497/.900) at the plate with 13 doubles, one triple, six home runs, 30 RBIs and 29 runs scored.

#### **SHRIMP BITES**

The Jumbo Shrimp have 17 extra-base hits in the last four games for a .607 slugging percentage (second in Triple-A).

#### ABOUT ROBBY

-Snelling was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the supplemental first round (39th overall) of the 2022 draft.

On July 30, 2024, the Padres traded Snelling, infielders Jay Beshears and Graham Pauley and right-handed pitcher Adam Mazur to the Miami Marlins in exchange for right-handed pitcher Bryan Hoeing and left-handed pitcher Tanner Scott.

-As a senior at Robert McQueen High School in Nevada, Snelling set a Nevada record for strikeouts in a seven-inning game with 20 strikeouts and posted a state large-class record with 145 strikeouts in 62.1 innings. He posted a 0.56 ERA.

-Snelling was a star high school quarterback and linebacker, and as a 4-star linebacker recruit, had offers to be a two-sport athlete in college. He likely would have committed to Arizona to play both sports, but when then-U of A baseball coach Jay Johnson accepted the same position at LSU, Snelling committed there to only play baseball. He passed on that commitment to sign with the Padres.

-During the summer of 2021, he participated in the High School All-American Game as well as in the All-Star High School Home Run Derby at Coors Field where he hit 21 home runs.

#### 2025 SEASON

-Snelling was promoted to Jacksonville on July 9 from Double-A Pensacola.

-At the time of his promotion, Snelling ranked tied for fourth in the Southern League in strikeouts (85), seventh in WHIP (1.22), 11th in ERA (3.61), 13th in batting average against (.238), tied for 13th in games started (14) and 14th in innings pitched (72.1).

-With Pensacola, opposing right-handed hitters batted just .202/.251/.301/.552 in 195 plate appearances. In comparison, left-handed batters hit .309/.387/.436/.823 against him in 104 plate appearances.

#### 2024 SEASON

-Snelling was transferred to Jacksonville on September 20 from Double-A Pensacola.

With both Double-A San Antonio and Pensacola, held opponents to a .254/.335/.457/.792 batting line in 257 plate appearances. With runners on, that swelled to .322/.376/.503/.879 in 223 plate appearances.

#### 2023 SEASON

Earned Baseball America's Minor League Pitcher of the Year award.

-Between three levels, Snelling went 11-3 this season with a 1.82 ERA. He struck out 118 and walked 34 in 103.2 innings. He allowed just four home runs in 22 starts. Since 2000, just seven teenage minor league pitchers have recorded a sub-2.00 ERA in 100 innings or more. Snelling is joined on the list by Cole Hamels (2003), Will Inman (2006), Madison Bumgarner (2008), Michael Piñeda (2008), Jose Fernandez (2012) and Andrew Painter (2022). Painter and Snelling were the only two to reach Double-A.
