TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! Tonight, your Quakes host the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres) in the fifth game of a six-game series. Tonight is post-game Fireworks Night, thanks to Amazon Fresh! Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: Today's game is the 17th of 24 head-to-head games and the 14th of 15 here at LoanMart Field. Thanks to winning thee of four in the current series, the Quakes are 13-3 against the Storm with an 11-2 record here at home. Last season, the Quakes went just 10-20 against the Storm, 7-8 at home.

LAST GAME: Logan Tabeling took a perfect game into the sixth and matched a career-best with eight strikeouts, as the Quakes won for a second straight game at LoanMart Field, 9-3 on Friday night over the Lake Elsinore Storm. Tabeling walked the opening batter of the sixth and later gave up a pair of hits to load the bases with two outs, before Cody Morse came on to end the sixth, giving Tabeling (5-3) 5.2 innings of scoreless ball. Mairo Martinus and Angel Diaz each drove in three runs, with Diaz leading Rancho with three of their eight hits overall. Storm starter Maikel Miralles (2-2) was rocked for six runs over just three innings in the loss.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS: The Quakes made a roster move Friday, sending RHP Ryan Brown to Great Lakes of the High-A Midwest League. Rancho will receive 22-year-old RHP Will Maynard from the ACL to take Brown's place. **ELKINS TAKES OVER RBI LEAD:** One day after RBI-leader Samuel Munoz was promoted to High-A, Jaron Elkins moved into a tie for the team lead with 65 RBIs, driving in a run in Tuesday's 6-1 win over the Storm. On Wednesday night, Elkins took over the top spot all to himself with another RBI hit, giving him 66 on the year. That number is tied with Inland Empire's Raudi Rodriguez for second in the league, trailing only San Jose's Dakota Jordan (82). Elkins also leads the team and the California League, with 61 stolen bases in just 66 attempts.

WELCOME BACK TO JOENDRY VARGAS: 19-year-old infielder Joendry Vargas has spent a significant amount of time on the Injured List this year, with two different stints. Vargas homered on Wednesday night, giving him his first hit since being activated from his latest injury stint. Vargas is hitting .248 in 25 total games, with three homers, 20 RBIs and 17 steals in 19 attempts. He's ranked by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 11th-best prospect overall.

TWO WINS, NOT MUCH HITTING: The Quakes have enjoyed a solid offense this year with a .256 average for third in the league and 82 homer, behind only San Jose's 92. Despite taking two of three in this current series, Rancho hasn't exactly piled up the hits though, with hit totals of five, seven and six, respectively over the three combined games. Ironically, the only game they've lost was Wednesday, when they posted a series-high seven hits.

MARLON NIEVES: 20-year-old right-hander Marlon Nieves makes his fourth start overall and first against the Storm, after being called up from the Arizona Complex League Dodgers just over two weeks ago. In his last outing, he allowed just three hits over four scoreless innings in a no-decision at Fresno on August 3. In the ACL this year, he went 4-0 with a 3.23 ERA over 12 games (eight starts) and 47.1 innings pitched. Nieves signed with the Dodgers out of the Dominican Republic in May of 2023.

BRYAN BALZER: Righty Bryan Balzer makes his 14th appearance and 11th start of the year, his third start against the Quakes. Balzer is 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA in two games against the Quakes, allowing three earned runs on four hits over six frames. In his last outing overall, he allowed four runs on five hits over two frames in a loss vs the 66ers on August 2. Balzer was signed by the Padres as an international free agent in January of 2023, out of Yokosuka, Japan. **BROADCAST HOME:** Catch all the 2025 action with the "Voice of the Quakes" Mike Lindskog from the ease of your phone, smart device or computer.
