FRES-NOTES

SUN IS SHINING AND THE OFFENSE IS SWEET: The Grizzlies have posted the best record in the California League over their last 10 games, going 7-3 during that stretch. Fresno's success has been driven by a pitching staff that owns the league's best June ERA (4.45), WHIP (1.35) and opponent batting average (.243). The offense has complemented that effort by reaching the 200-hit mark in June, while the Grizzlies have also swiped 32 bases this month—second-most in the California League. As the calendar winds down on June, Fresno has emerged as one of the league's hottest clubs by combining timely offense with the circuit's most effective pitching.

FOSSUM FUEL: Kyle Fossum has been Fresno's hottest bat in June, hitting .367 with six homers, 20 RBI and a 1.176 OPS in 16 games this month. Fossum has raised his season OPS to .868, adding 13 doubles, seven homers and 29 RBI over 45 games. He has also driven in 20 of his 29 runs in June, giving Fresno another middle-of-the-order force behind Tanner Thach and Roldy Brito.

STORM WATCH: Fresno has taken control of the season series against Lake Elsinore, improving to 6-4 against the Storm after back-to-back road wins on Thursday and Friday. The Grizzlies have scored 24 runs over the first four games of this week's series, including eight runs on Thursday and 10 more on Friday. Fresno's offense has also stolen 15 bases in the last two games against Lake Elsinore, turning the series into one of its most aggressive stretches on the bases all season.

ROAD BEARS: Fresno has played some of its best baseball away from Chukchansi Park, going 21-16 on the road compared to 19-17 at home. The Grizzlies have also produced more offense away from home, scoring 258 runs on the road and posting 54 stolen bases away from Fresno. The current Lake Elsinore trip has continued that trend, with Fresno winning three of the first four games and outscoring the Storm 26-19.
