LAST GAME

The Baysox walked-off the Richmond Flying Squirrels for the second consecutive game Saturday night, via a 4-3 final in 10 innings. Joseph Rosa delivered a pinch-hit single to win the game in the bottom of the 10th for Bowie, who was inspired early by the dominant pitching from right-handed starter Chayce McDermott. The right-hander matched a career-high with 10 strikeouts through 5.2 innings of one-run baseball, allowing just three hits and two walks in the process. Cesar Prieto and Anthony Servideo each tallied three hits, including an RBI single from Prieto that plated Servideo and got the Baysox on the board in the third inning. Coby Mayo also extended his on-base streak to 31 games with a colossal two-run home run off the top of the video board in left field in the fifth to give the Baysox a 3-1 lead. Richmond would tie the game in the top of the seventh off a two-run shot from Brandon Martorano, but Bowie's bullpen would hold serve from there, including John Rhodes throwing out a potential go-ahead run at the plate in the ninth from left field to help the Baysox clinch their first series win at home this season.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter today with a record of 27-35 - last place in the Southwest division. Since entering their series in Bowie against the Baysox in late April atop the division standings, the Flying Squirrels are 14-28, having now lost four of their last seven series, while splitting the other three, and dropping six games out of first place in the process. Richmond has the third-fewest errors (42) in the Eastern League and the second-fewest home runs hit away from home (25) in the league, but are going against a Baysox team with the third-most errors (57) and second-most home runs allowed at home (52) in the league. The Flying Squirrels roster includes 10 of the Giants' top 30 prospects (via MLB Pipeline) - INF Marco Luciano (No. 2 SF/No. 18 overall), OF Vaun Brown (No. 5 SF), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8 SF), RHP Mason Black (No. 10 SF), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 13 SF), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 17 SF), RHP Randy Rodriguez (No. 25 SF), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26 SF), RHP Jose Cruz (No. 29 SF), and OF Wade Meckler (No. 30 SF).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Will Jensen is set to make his first start of the season this afternoon for Richmond. Jensen has previously made 14 relief appearances thus far in 2023, allowing just 12 runs in 36.1 innings, but has allowed five home runs in that stretch. The right-hander does have starting experience in the past, as 17 of his 23 appearances in 2022 were starts, including five of his eight with the Flying Squirrels. Jensen has also worked in bulk plenty this season, despite being used primarily as a reliever, with seven outings of at least three innings under his belt this season. Jensen has only allowed one earned run across six innings in his two appearances against the Baysox this season - a solo home run to Billy Cook on Wednesday. He's struck out six, walked one, and allowed three hits in his outings against Bowie this season. Jensen's five winning decisions in 2023 are tied for second-most in the Eastern League.

DOUBLE THE MAYO!

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo sits second at the Double-A level with 21 doubles, while his 34 extra-base hits are tied for the most at the Double-A level and fourth-most in all of Minor League Baseball. The No. 8 Orioles/No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, has hits in 11 of 12 games, including home runs in three-straight contests for the first time in his professional career. In that 12-game stretch, Mayo is batting .341 (15-for-44) with nine extra-base hits. Mayo also leads the Baysox with 37 walks, 34 RBI, a .413 OBP, and a .976 OPS. Mayo has crushed Richmond pitching particularly well in 2023, hitting .371 (13-for-35), with 10 of his hits going for extra bases (six doubles, one triple, three home runs). Mayo's two-run home run last night extended his on-base streak to 31 games - second-longest in the Eastern League this season.

HAIL CESAR

Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League this season with 81 hits and a .358 batting average. Another three-hit game for Prieto on Saturday night gives him 10 games with at least three knocks, and 22 multi-hit games, through his first 57 contests of 2023. Prieto is hitting a career-best .382 in the month of June, with 12 RBI in 14 games.

STARTING STRONG

After a couple of rocky games in Erie last week, Bowie starting pitching has found its footing again this week at Prince George's Stadium. Baysox starters have gone 24.2 innings over the past four games, allowing just five earned runs (1.82 ERA) on 12 hits, while striking out 32 batters in the process. Bowie's 3.64 ERA from starting pitching this season is best in the Eastern League and second-best in all of Double-A.

FREE PASS AND BLAST

Most damage done by the Richmond bats this week against Bowie have come from walks and the home run ball. Despite Richmond entering this week with just 19 home runs hit on the road this season - the lowest total of any team in Double-A, the Flying Squirrels have hit six long balls in the series against a Baysox staff that allows the second most home runs (52) at their home ballpark in the Eastern League. Bowie has also issued 28 walks to a Richmond lineup who had walked the fewest times in the league this season. In total, 15 of Richmond's 19 runs in this series have either reached base or scored via a walk or home run.

CAREER NOTES

- 2022: Had a stellar month of May, where he pitched to a 0.49 ERA and held opponents to a .098 average - was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month.
- Struggled in the two months afterward, moving on-and-off the 7-day injured list while posting a 6.57 ERA through June and July, before being placed on the injured list for the remainder of the season on August 4. Control issues also resurfaced in June in July with twice as many walks in each month as he had in April or May.
- College: Transferred to UT-Arlington from Weatherford College in 2020, after pitching at Weatherford for two seasons.

- 4/12 Pitched in relief of Chayce McDermott, allowed a solo home run in his third inning of work after striking out two batters to start the frame.
- 4/19 First start. Struck out the first four batters faced, and retired the first nine. Did not allow a hit until the fifth inning, where he allowed two runs.
- 4/26 Pitched in relief of Connor Gillispie. Retired the first two batters faced, but still allowed a run in the same inning. Third inning of work struggled, allowing a walk and two doubles with one out.

Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.	Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Herrmann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Herrmann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.	Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time in 2021.
