**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, open a season-ending six-game series against the West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The Nuts are 8-10 against West Michigan this season, 3-3 at LMCU Ballpark, with all 24 of the scheduled matchups taking place in the second half. Lansing is coming off losing four of six games at home to Fort Wayne, while West Michigan split a six-game series in Dayton. The Whitecaps were eliminated from postseason contention yesterday by a Dragons 1-0 Labor Day victory at Great Lakes.

**On the Air:** Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa have the call via StreamGuys, while Dan Hasty and Nate Wangler deliver the action on MiLB TV and Bally Live.

**Last Game:** Fort Wayne TinCaps 8, Lansing Lugnuts 4. In a game featuring eight errors, four by each team, the TinCaps rode a six-pitcher bullpen effort to the Sunday finale victory thanks to crucial two-run singles from Rosman Verdugo and Jacob Campbell.

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts play the Whitecaps through Sunday, closing out their 28th season in the Midwest League.

**A's Dominate Weekly Honors:** Lugnuts lefty **Will Johnston** was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week for August 26-September 1, blanking Fort Wayne over five two-hit innings with eight strikeouts (on 58 pitches, 45 strikes) in Game 2 of a doubleheader win last Wednesday. Additionally, former Lugnut **David Leal** was named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week, picking up a pair of wins with 6 1/3 combined hitless innings for Midland, and Las Vegas infielder **Logan Davidson** was named the Pacific Coast League's Player of the Week after slashing .524/.524/1.000 with two doubles, one triple, two homers and 10 RBIs on 10 hits, hitting for the cycle on August 30.

**Who's Hot:** **Luke Mann** homered in both games over the weekend, his 7th and 8th Midwest League home runs and his 15th and 16th home runs overall in his first full pro season... **Danny Bautista, Jr.** is hitting .414 (12-for-29) in his last eight games with two doubles and a triple... **Ryan Lasko** has exactly two hits in four of his last six games... **Nate Nankil**, who was honored by the Lugnuts' Booster Club as their Player of the Month for August, is hitting .423 (22-for-52) in his last 14 games.

**Alumni Watch:** 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** ranks 3rd in the Major Leagues in batting average (.324), 3rd in base hits (170); 4th in on-base percentage (.397), 5th in doubles (38), 6th in extra-base hits (66) and OPS (.951), 7th in total bases (291), and 9th in slugging percentage (.554). Vladdy slashed .375/.454/.673 during a white-hot month of August.

**Challenging the Hit Man:** In 2017, Lugnuts outfielder **Nick Sinay** was hit by 38 pitches (in 79 games) to set the Midwest League single season record. That record has been tied this season by Wisconsin infielder **Luke Adams** (in 98 games), who needs to get bruised once more in the final six games of 2024 to have the record all to himself.

**Prospecting:** Lugnuts among MLB Pipeline's updated Top 30 A's Prospects include **Luis Morales** at No. 3, **Josh Kuroda-Grayer** at No. 13, **Kade Morris** at No. 19, **Jared Dickey** at No. 27 and **Ryan Lasko** at No. 30.

**Tools:** In a vote of California League managers, the Lugnuts' **Ryan Lasko** was named the outfielder with the best throwing arm in the Single-A circuit in Baseball America's recent "Best Tools" issue.

**Team Effort:** The Lugnuts' offense ranks 1st in the MWL in batting average (.248), base hits (1030), total bases (1550) and triples (38); 2nd in doubles (204), at-bats (4154), runs (603) and OPS (.711); and 3rd in on-base percentage (.338) and slugging percentage (.373)

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2011:** It was 96 degrees in Dayton as Dragons SS Billy Hamilton went 2-for-3 with a sacrifice, stealing three bases to reach the 100-steal mark. The Lugnuts lost, 4-2.

**2012:** In the final game of the regular season, the Lugnuts finished with an 82-55 record after scoring six runs in the 3rd – and then blowing the lead in absurd fashion, allowing Lake County to score three in the 4th, three in the 5th and then nine runs in the 7th inning. The Nuts lost, 15-6.

**2016:** Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., joined the Lugnuts on the road in Lake County, taking batting practice with the team but not getting added to the roster.

**2022:** Cooper Bowman hit a grand slam and Sahid Valenzuela stole home, helping the Lugnuts win at South Bend, 10-8. Mason Miller started the game, firing two innings, followed by two innings apiece from TJ Czyz, Mac Lardner and Brock Whittlesey before Calvin Coker wrapped up the ninth, striking out Pete Crow-Armstrong to end the game. Crow-Armstrong shattered his bat over his knee in frustration, upset by a strike call earlier in the at-bat.

**In a Nutshell:** Excelled in his Lugnuts debut on May 2 vs. South Bend, becoming the club's 11th different starting pitcher this year and the 939th all-time player to put on the Lansing uniform... replaced the demoted Eduardo Rivera and tossed five scoreless two-hit innings, striking out six Cubs... followed up with eight strikeouts in three hitless innings with his mother in attendance at Great Lakes, May 8... grew up idolizing Max Scherzer... enjoys the great outdoors... loves The Office... notable splits:

**Prospecting:** Fell out of MLB Pipeline's most recent reranking of the A's system; they had previously graded him: fastball 50, slider 45, splitter 55, control 50, overall 40... they write, "With low expectations, Johnston began his first full season of pro ball at age 23 with Single-A Stockton, but he threw so well out of the gate he earned a quick promotion up to High-A Lansing at the end of April... Johnston has shown a better feel for his three-pitch arsenal than some expected given his college numbers. He adds and subtracts from his fastball, throwing it typically in the 89-94 mph range, though he's shown in the past the ability to reach back for a 95 or 96-mph heater on occasion. The pitch has played up a bit because he can pitch north and south with it. His best pitch is now his split-changeup, which flashes plus and can be a true out pitch at times. His low-80s breaking ball can be on the slurve side, but it can be effective."

**Stockton Sensation:** Opened 2024 with the Class A Ports... made two relief appearances and two starts, facing 46 batters and whiffing 26 of them ... debuted with 4 2/3 hitless innings with eight strikeouts on April 6... followed up with three perfect innings with 7 K on 4/12.

**Gig 'Em:** Majored in finance at Texas A&M... pitched primarily out of Aggies' bullpen; career stats: 6-4, 5.77 ERA, 66 G, 8 GS, 8 SV, 98 1/3 IP, 57 BB, 132 K... finest year at College Station was in 2022: 3.25 ERA, 23 G, 2 GS, 4 SV, 36 IP, 2 HR, 18 BB, 49 K... struggled in 2023 to 5.89 ERA due to 9 HR and 31 BB in 47 1/3 IP, though he struck out 70 batters... drafted following his fourth season at A&M... joined fellow Aggies Micah Dallas (8th round, 2022) and Nathan Dettmer (5th round, 2023) as Aggies drafted by the A's, and one of seven Aggies drafted overall in 2023... signed for \$150,000... notable Aggies in the pros include Chuck Knoblauch, Davey Johnson, Wally Moon, Michael Wacha, Ross Stripling and A.J. Minter.

**Back Home:** Batted .413 with seven homers during senior year at Keller High School; ascended from closer as a sophomore (posting 11-0 record with 11 saves) to ace as senior; compiled three-year record of 21-2... Keller High School also produced Shea Langeliers and Max Muncy 1.0.
