YESTERDAY... Brett Wisely led the charge in Bowling Green's 15-4 win over Winston-Salem. The leadoff man went 4-for-5 with a career-high five RBIs thanks two a double and his second two-homer performance with Bowling Green and third of the season. Osleivis Basabe, Addison Moss, and Gianti Turner all made their debuts with BG while Grant Witherspoon, Evan Edwards, Jordan Qsar, and Logan Driscoll turned in multi-hit efforts. BG hit four homers en route to a big victory in the penultimate game of the series.

HOME RUN CLUB... Jordan Qsar hit his 21 st homer of the season after Grant Witherspoon crushed his 21 st bomb in Friday's win over the Dash. The two are in second on the team while Evan Edwards who has 22. Edwards is tied for the franchise record for single-season homers with Derek Dietrich, who hit 22 in 2011.

MAGIC NUMBER SZN... The Hot Rods clinched a postseason berth on Thursday with a win in game one of the doubleheader, but their work isn't done. BG can clinch home field advantage as the one-seed with a magic number of one.

ON THE ROAD... Sunday marks the final game the Bowling Green's road schedule for the 2021 regular season. BG is 37-22 away from home, batting .263 with 99 homers. The pitching staff has a 4.40 ERA through 59 games with 539 strikeouts to 162 walks over 499.0 innings of work. Jordan Qsar played the most road games on the team (51) but Hill Alexander led the team in road batting average for players of 20+ games with a .386 BA. Qsar has led the team with 14 road homers and 43 RBIs while he and Grant Witherspoon lead the team with 36 runs scored. Carlos Garcia tied Jayden Murray with four road wins for the pitching staff while Chris Gau appeared in 16 games iwth a 2.38 ERA, the lowest on the team. Jacob Lopez and Zack Trageton each led the way with 44 strikeouts.

YESTERDAY'S NOTES... Wisely sent a career-high with five RBIs... He tied his career-high of four hits... It's the second time he's reached the mark, with the other taking place on July 30 of this season... It had been exactly one month (August 11) since Wisely's last two-homer game... Wisely had his óth multi-hit game with BG... It was the Hot Rods seventh four-hit game of the year... He also logged his óth multi-RBI game of 2021... It was also the ninth game for a Hot Rods hitter with five or more RBIs... All nine games belong to different players... Witherspoon had his team-leading 25th multi-hit effort of the year... Qsar had his 15th... It was also his 15th multi-RBI game... Driscoll logged his fourth multi-hit game of the season... His two RBIs make Saturday his second multi-RBI game this season... This was Bowling Green's first game with more than 10 runs since August 17 in a 17-8 win over Greensboro... BG is 9-3 in September... They're 35-17 in games decided by four or more runs this season... The team is 9-2 against Winston-Salem this season...

NOW PITCHING: JOHN DOXAKIS... Doxakis makes his second start of the series on Sunday in the series finale and the final game of the Hot Rods 2021 road schedule. He makes his third start against Winston-Salem this season on Sunday, having held the Dash to nine hits and three runs over 10.0 innings with 12 strikeouts. "Dox" has a K/9 of 9.0 with BG this season and is inducing ground balls 51% of the time when hitters put the ball in play. He's dealing 54.5% first pitch strikes while 15.5% of his strikes are called and 14.4% are swinging. He's striking out righties and lefties at similar rates, but lefthanders are working nearly double the walks per nine innings (2.0 to 1.2 for righties). He's also seen a jump in BABIP since pitching for Charleston, with oppoenents in the High-A East enjoying a BABIP of .319 compared to the .246 they had in the Low-A East.
