OFFENSE QUIET IN 4-1 LOSS

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp mustered just one run on three hits on Wednesday in a 4-1 loss to the Norfolk Tides. In the third, RBI singles from Mayerick Handley and Emmanuel Rivera put the Tides in front, José Barrero's tworun shot in the seventh made it 4-0. The lone Jumbo Shrimp run in the game came on Joey Wiemer's RBI double in the bottom of the seventh. Robby Snelling struck out nine and yielded just two unearned runs in 6.0 innings, lowering his ERA to 1.34 on the season. He has fanned 38 against three walks in his last four starts (24.2 innings).

THE MORE. THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/ Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 115 games this season, the Jumbo Shrimp have already tied that record by using 28 different starting pitchers. Perhaps unsurprisingly. Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 452.0 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the fourth-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.58 starters' ERA ranks second at the level.

IT GETS LATE EARLY

Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have worked 552.1, or 55.0 percent, of the club's 1,004.1 innings this season. Despite the huge workload, which marks the third-most innings of any bullpen in Triple-A, Jacksonville relievers have posted the level's best ERA (3.58) and BAA (.208). Over the last 20 games, the club's bullpen has worked 97.1 innings (4.9 per game), yielding only 31 runs, 28 earned, on 53 hits (4.9 H/9) for a 2.59 ERA (113 K, 10.4 K/9, 35 BB, 3.2 BB/9).

Over the last three seasons, Jacksonville ranked 23rd, 21st and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A in stolen bases. The club's 229 this season not only lead the entire level, but they rank eighth in all of Minor League Baseball. Of the top 25 MiLB teams in steals, only two are Triple-A or Double-A teams (Jacksonville & Nashville, 223, 9th). The Jumbo Shrimp's 229 steals are the most in a campaign for any Jacksonville team in the club's Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present). No Jacksonville club has finished in the top five in their respective level in steals since at least 2005.

GUNS AND SHIPS, AND SO THE BALANCE SHIFTS

Dating back to their July 27 contest at Durham, Jacksonville has won 12 of the last 15 games in mostly dominant fashion. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp have out-hit their opponents 127-93, out-homered them 16-14 and earned 74 walks and hit-by-pitches compared to 47 for their opponents. It has added up to a massive 83-47 advantage in run differential over these 15 games.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Over the first 63 games of the season, Jacksonville cracked only 52 home runs, tied for the 26th-most in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp have blasted 72 round-trippers over the last 52 games since June 10, the eighth-most in Triple-A during this span. Jacksonville has plated at least four runs in 36 of these 52 games, a rate of 69.2 percent. In comparison, the Jumbo Shrimp had plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent).

SO, BABY, PULL ME CLOSER

The Jumbo Shrimp are a remarkable 46-22 (.672) in games decided by three runs or fewer this season, by far the most such wins in Triple-A. Thus, of the club's Triple-A-leading 71 victories, 64.8 percent have come by no more than three runs. In one-run affairs in particular, Jacksonville has excelled, going 24-9, tied for the most such wins in Triple-A and just one behind Montgomery's 25 for the most in MiLB.

WIEMER SCHNITZEL

Joey Wiemer began his season with Triple-A Omaha, but struggled with the Storm Chasers, batting just .182 with a .603 OPS in 72 games. After being claimed off waivers from Kansas City by Miami, Wiemer has excelled. Over his first seven games, the Temperance, Mich., native is 11-for-25, slashing .440/.548/.880/1.428 with five doubles, two home runs, 10 RBIs and six runs scored. Wiemer became the first Jumbo Shrimp to earn International League Player of the Week honors this season.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has not lost three games in a row since getting swept at Durham from April 29-May 4... The Jumbo Shrimp's 86 strikeouts in their last 10 games since August 5 rank third in Triple-A.

ABOUT ADAM

-Mazur was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Iowa. He made his major league debut for the Padres on June 4, 2024, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at the Los Angeles Angels. Mazur was later included in the July 30 trade along with left-hander Robby Snelling and infielders Graham Pauley and Jay Beshears in exchange for left-hander Tanner Scott and right-hander Bryan Hoeing.

- -Mazur began his collegiate career at South Dakota State University before transferring to Iowa. He made 15 starts for the Hawkeyes in 2022, going 7-3 with a 3.07 ERA. Over 93.2 innings, he yielded only 60 hits and 30 walks while striking out 98 to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors. His 98 strikeouts ranks as the fourthmost in a single-season in program history, and he ranked eighth nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (5.8).
- -When he made his MLB debut on June 4, 2024, Mazur became the fourth former Hawkeye to pitch in a big league game since 2000, joining Wes Obermueller (2002), Matt Dermody (2016) and Nick Allgeyer (2021).
- -As a second-round pick (53rd overall), Mazur was the highest-drafted Hawkeye since Tim Costo was picked eighth overall by Cleveland in 1990.
- -Mazur is an alumnus of Woodbury High School in Woodbury, Minn, where he was a finalist for the Minnesota Mr. Baseball Award. He was high school teammates with former Jacksonville and current Miami Marlins right-hander Max Meyer.

In addition to his baseball prowess growing up, Mazur earned four letters in basketball and two in football.

-The youngest of three boys, Adam's older brother Brandon played college baseball at $Grand\ View$.

2024 SEASON

-Mazur began the season with Double-A San Antonio before earning a promotion to Triple-A El Paso. He had his contract selected by San Diego on June 4 and made his major league debut that night against the Angels.

-Mazur was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for August 20-25 after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with one hit and one walk against four strikeouts in a 5-0 victory over Nashville on August 21.

2023 SEASON

-In 174 plate appearances, Mazur held right-handed hitters to a .208/.236/.286/.522 line compared to a .298/.332/.418/.750 batting line in 220 plate appearances for left-handed hitters.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-As a senior at Woodbury High School, Mazur compiled a 0.58 ERA with 112 strikeouts and only 12 walks in 72.1 innings. He also played shortstop, batting .377 with five doubles, one home run and 40 RBIs.
