**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds start a six-game series against the Gwinnett Stripers tonight at First Horizon Park. Nashville is coming off a series split against St. Paul. Gwinnett dropped four of six to Charlotte last week. Left-hander Thomas Pannone gets the start for the Sounds, facing Gwinnett's Dylan Dodd.

**Thomas Pannone:** 29-year-old Thomas Pannone gets his second start of 2023 for the Sounds tonight. The left-hander is 0-0 with a 2.35 ERA (7.2 IP/2 ER) through three outings. He took a no decision in his last outing, a start on May 3 at St. Paul. Pannone allowed a couple of runs (2 ER) on three hits and a walk in 3.0 innings. He began the season on the development list before being activated on April 22. The Rhode Island native went 5-3 with a 4.57 ERA across 14 appearances (12 starts) for Triple-A Worcester last season. He spent parts of two seasons with Toronto in 2018 and 2019. Pannone was selected in the ninth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft by Cleveland out of the Community College of Southern Nevada.

**Dylan Dodd:** 24-year-old Dylan Dodd makes his fourth start with Gwinnett and seventh start of the season. The left-hander is 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (14.2 IP/8 ER) with the Stripers. He's also made three starts for Atlanta, posting a 2-1 record with a 6.46 ERA (15.1 IP/11 ER) in 2023. Dodd last pitched for Atlanta on May 4 at Miami, getting the win after 6.0 three-run innings. He struck out one and scattered eight hits for his second win in the Majors. The Elk Grove, Ill. native was drafted by Atlanta in the third round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Southeast Missouri State University.

**2023 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 6, Third: 2, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 18, Sixth: 2, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Gone Fishing:** Gwinnett enters the series with the second-worst record in the International League, ahead of dead last Rochester by half a game. Though they are 6-5 in road contests, they have just six wins in 21 games in Georgia. The Stripers rank in the bottom half of the league in most offensive categories, including batting average (.253), runs scored (158), home runs (26, 19th) and RBI (148). Gwinnett currently has four players that rank as Atlanta's Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline, including LHP Jared Shuster (1), LHP Dylan Dodd (10), RHP Roddery Muñoz (21) and RHP Tanner Gordon (28).

**Toro Tearing it Up:** Infielder Abraham Toro extended his on-base streak to 26 games after reaching in both games of a doubleheader on Sunday at St. Paul. The 26-game streak is the second-longest on-base streak in all of Minor League Baseball, trailing only Salt Lake hitter Michael Stefanic's 29-game streak. Toro is batting .313 (30-for-96) with nine doubles, 14 RBI, 15 walks and nine runs during the streak.

**Walk the Line:** First baseman Jon Singleton extended his on-base streak to 25 games, also reaching both times in the doubleheader on Sunday. Singleton has drawn 24 walks and posted a .404 on-base percentage during the streak. It's the third-longest streak in MiLB, also trailing Toro and Salt Lake's Stefanic.

**Pitcher Perfect:** The Sounds pitching staff boasts the second-best ERA in the league at 3.87, trailing only Norfolk's mark of 3.46. Nashville hurlers also boast the best WHIP at 1.33 and the third-most strikeouts with 308. The bullpen has the lowest ERA among relievers at 3.32 (160.0 IP/59 ER). On Sunday, Nashville's bullpen became the first in the league to reach the 200-strikeout threshold.

**Welcome to Hit City:** Left-hander Darrell Thompson became the third Shucker to get the move from Biloxi to Nashville yesterday. The 29-year-old southpaw is in his first season of affiliated baseball after spending parts of the last six seasons in independent ball. After getting promoted last week, infielder Isaac Collins and reliever Ryan Middendorf are set to make their debuts at First Horizon Park.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville currently has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 9 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 13 prospect and right-hander Gus Varland is the No. 25 prospect, currently on MLB rehab assignment.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 617-533 record during an eight-season span.

**LAST OUTING:** Pannone's previous appearance came on May 3 at St. Paul. In his first start of 2023, the southpaw allowed two earned runs on three hits over 3.0 innings. He walked one and did not strike out anyone. Pannone did not factor into the decision as the Sounds fell 5-3.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** This is Pannone's first career appearance against Gwinnett.

### 2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began season on development list...activated on April 22.
- Made first appearance of season on April 23, coming out of the bullpen.
- Made first start on May 3, allowing two runs (both earned) in 3.0 innings.

### 2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 5-3 with a 4.57 ERA in 14 games (12 starts) with Triple-A Worcester...walked just 3.1% of hitters faced, the 2nd lowest in International League (min. 60 IP).
- After being released by Boston on June 27, made 14 starts for the Kia Tigers of the Korea Baseball Organization...went 3-4 with a 2.72 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 82.2 innings.

### 2021 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 5-11 with a 7.07 ERA in 24 games (21 starts) with Triple-A Salt Lake (Los Angeles-AL)...posted highest ERA in Minor League Baseball (min. 100 IP).
- Led the Triple-A West in innings pitched...was one of just seven qualifying pitchers in the league.

### CAREER NOTES:

- Made Toronto's Opening Day roster in 2019.
- Threw an "immaculate" inning on April 14, 2019 vs. Tampa Bay, striking out Avisail Garcia, Brandon Lowe and Daniel Robertson in order on nine pitches in the fifth...was the third such inning in Blue Jays history...went on to retire all nine batters faced (4 K) in that outing.
- Named International League Pitcher of the Week for June 30, 2019 after going 2-0 with a 1.63 ERA (11.0 IP/2 ER) and 14 strikeouts.
- Carried a no-hitter into the seventh inning of his first Major League start on August 22, 2018 vs. Baltimore...only hit was Trey Mancini's single to start seventh.
- In 2017, went 9-3 with a 2.36 ERA in 25 starts with Double-A Akron, Double-A New Hampshire and Advanced-A Lynchburg.
- Named an Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star in 2017...led the Eastern League in BAA (.227) and WHIP (1.09)...ranked among Eastern League leaders in ERA (2nd, 2.92), winning percentage (3rd, .700) and strikeouts (10th, 110).
- Did not allow an earned run (1 R) through first six starts of 2017 between Lynchburg (5 GS) and Akron (1 GS)...streak of 33.1 innings without an earned run was the second longest in the full season minor leagues by a starting pitcher.
- Traded to Toronto on July 31 alongside 2B Samad Taylor in exchange for RHP Joe Smith
- Named a Midwest League Mid-Season All-Star in 2016.
- Drafted by Cleveland in the ninth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft.

### COLLEGE/PREP NOTES:

- Graduated from Bishop Hendricken High School (RI).
- Initially drafted by Chicago-NL in the 33rd round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft, but did not sign.
