NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- Of 12 series played this season, Omaha has won 5, lost 6 and split 1 ... the Storm Chasers have lost their last 3 series, with a 7-16 record over their last 23 games.
- Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... with a 13-14 record in May, the Storm Chasers were one win away from having a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
- Omaha has been under .500 following 47 of their last 48 games (since April 24) and the Storm Chasers have spent just 18 days at or above .500.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Storm Chasers have 19 comeback wins this season, while Omaha also has blown a lead in 22 losses.

- 19 comeback wins are tied for 7th-most in the International League, tied 11th in Triple-A ... 22 blown leads are tied for 2nd-most in the league, tied 5th in Triple-A.
- The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 10 of their last 16 losses, including 3 games where the team led for over half the game.
- In the last 38 games (since May 9), Omaha is 17-21 ... they have trailed at some point in 12 of 17 wins and led at some point in 12 of 21 losses, meaning 24 of Omaha's last 38 games have been a comeback win for one of the two teams ... in this stretch, 11 of 17 wins have been decided by 3 runs or less, while 15 of 21 losses have been decided by 3 runs or less ... 14 of the 38 games have been decided by 1 run ... Omaha's 15 losses by 1 run are the most in Triple-A.

HERE WE GO AGAIN

Omaha's last series win came at CHS Field, taking 4 of 6 from St. Paul from May 19 to 24 ... the Chasers' 10 steals that week remain a season-best for a series, though the bullpen's 8.26 ERA (26 ER/28.1 IP) is the highest in any series this year.

- All four top performers from the May series remain active ... **Brett Squires** led the club that week with 17 total bases (7-for-22, .318 AVG, 5 XBH, 6 RBI) ... **Gavin Cross** hit .381 (8-for-21, 4 XBH, 4 RBI) ... **Luca Tresh** went 8-for-20 (.400) with 5 RBI ... **Josh Rojas** matched Squires with 6 RBI, going 7-for-21 (.333) with 4 XBH.
- This is Omaha's 12th series at CHS Field since 2021 and the 4th time in 6 seasons making multiple road trips to St. Paul ... the Chasers have 3 series wins, 2 series losses and 5 splits in the previous 10 weeklong series ... this also marks just the 4th time since joining the IL in 2021 that Omaha has visited the same road city twice within 30 days (of 79 total road trips), the 3rd time they've done so with St. Paul.

WEEKEND WARRIORS

Omaha's weekend success against St. Paul since 2023 represents some of the most dominant weekend baseball in the Minors over the last few seasons.

- Since 2023, the Storm Chasers are 17-4 in 21 games played between Saturday and Sunday against the Saints ... an .810 winning percentage in these games is the best of any Minor League team against an individual opponent between Saturday and Sunday in this span (min. 20 games).
- Prior to yesterday, the Chasers' last weekend loss to St. Paul came on September 1, 2024 ... since July 2023, Omaha is 17-2 against the Saints on the weekend.

JUNE BUGS

Matthew Lugo has been Omaha's best hitter in June since joining the Storm Chasers at the start of the month, but he's had good company in the lineup.

- Since the Royals claimed Lugo off waivers from the Angels on June 2, he has hit .357 (20-for-56) with 12 extra-base hits and 18 RBI ... his 1.133 OPS since June 2 (min. 50 PA) ranks 6th in the International League ... his 16 RBI in 10 games since June 9 are tied for the 4th-most in the International League in that stretch. ... Lugo has hits in 12 of 14 games with Omaha - including an extra-base hit in 9 of 14 - and has reached base in 13 of 14 ... he's driven in a run in 8 of 14 games, with 5 multi-RBI games (4 coming last week alone).
- Peyton Wilson** has hits in 11 of 14 games this month, batting .333 (19-for-57) this month with 8 doubles, 5 RBI and 7 walks for a .880 OPS, this month ... **Abraham Toro** has hits in 13 of 15 games, hitting .304 (17-for-56) with 3 doubles, 2 triples, 3 homers and 12 RBI for a .960 OPS ... **Josh Rojas** has hits in 8 of his 10 games in June, batting .316 (12-for-38) with 2 doubles, 2 homers and 9 RBI for an .883 OPS.

- ✓ Sanchez has faced the Saints three in his career, including a pair of starts earlier this season in St. Paul ... he pitched in the Twins organization between 2022 and 2023, including 28 games for the Saints.

THE SANCH FACTOR

- ✓ **TIME TO REST:** Sanchez led the Storm Chasers in games started for the first 2 months of the season until recently when **Ryan Ramsey** overtook him ... Sanchez started 10 of the team's first 48 games of the season, but didn't pitch in any of Omaha's 16 games between his starts on May 22 and June 11.
