LRST TIME OUT...

MOOSIC, Pa. (September 26, 2021) – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders split a doubleheader with the Syracuse Mets on Saturday at PNC Field. The RailRiders won game one 4-0, while they fell in the second game 6-3.

RailRiders left-hander JP Sears led the team to victory with a tremendous performance in the opener, tying a career-high with 10 strikeouts in 6.1 innings of work. Sears (6-0) scattered four hits in the outing and did not walk a batter. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre gave him some support in the bottom of the second when Andrew Velazquez banged a two-run double off the right field wall against MLB rehabber Robert Gsellman. Oswaldo Cabrera added a solo home run in the fourth and Greg Allen contributed an RBI single in the sixth to pad the lead to 4-0.

After Sears, Nick Nelson retired the final two batters of the game to close out the win. The RailRiders stole four bases in the game to run their season total to 140 in 120 games. That mark set a new franchise record for stolen bases in a single season, surpassing the 2000 Red Barons who stole 139 over 145 games.

Estevan Florial hit a home run off Vance Worley in the bottom of the third in the night cap to take a 1-0 lead. It was the first of two home runs in the game for Florial, his second two-homer game of the year. Meanwhile, Sean Boyle retired the first 11 batters he faced before allowing a single to Khalil Lee in the top of the fourth. Syracuse broke through in the fifth, when Drew Jackson connected for a two-run home run off Boyle to give the Mets a 2-1 lead.

In the bottom of the fifth Florial launched his second home run against Worley to tie the game at 2-2. Oswaldo Cabrera followed with a triple, but reliever Eric Orze was able to strand him on third to keep the score even. The Mets rallied for four runs on four hits against Adam Warren in the top of the sixth to take a 6-2 lead. In the bottom of the seventh the RailRiders brought in a run when Ryan LaMarre walked with the bases loaded to bring the winning run to the plate with one out. However, Tom Hackimer was able to get the final two outs and earn his fifth save of the season.

NEWS & NOTES

RECORDS ARE MEANT TO BE BROKEN: When Greg Allen stole second base in the sixth inning of game one of the doubleheader on September 25 with Syracuse, he recorded the 140th stolen base of the season for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, setting a new franchise record. In only 120 games, the team surpassed the previous record of 139 held by the 2000 SWB Red Barons, who needed 145 games to set the mark. Through 121 games, the RailRiders have stolen 141 bases in 178 attempts in the 2021 season (79.2% success). The pace of thievery has ticked up in September, with SWB currently 34-for-39 in steal attempts in 21 games during the month (1.61 steals/game). Andrew Velazquez leads the team with 29 stolen bases in 77 games, and Socrates Brito (23) and Greg Allen (21) have also recorded 20-or-more steals. With one more steal, Velazquez can become the first SWB player with 30 steals in a season since Brett Gardner stole 37 with the 2008 SWB Yankees.

NEW FACES: With both the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades and Double-A Somerset Patriots narrowly missing out on the playoffs in their respective leagues, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders have received three of the Yankees Top 20 prospects heading into *The Final Stretch*. Infielders Oswald Peraza (#3) and Oswaldo Cabrera (#16) pack a powerful punch as a double play combination, and right-handed pitcher Hayden Wesneski (#15) finished second among Yankees minor leaguers (and t-22nd in all of MLB) with 139 strikeouts (Ken Waldichuk, 163 K).

OFFENSIVE MARKS: At the end of the 2021 regular season, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders had a combined team on-base percentage of .352, which is the best mark in franchise history. It narrowly beats out the .351 OBP posted by the 2019 RailRiders, despite the team's batting average being 23-points lower in 2021. This is only the fourth time in the 31-year history of the franchise that SWB has posted a team OBP of greater than .345. Amazingly, despite playing only 121 games, the team's 140 home runs are the fourth-most in a season hit by the team, with only the 2019 (121), 1998 (164), and 2017 (153) clubs hitting more. For each home run hit this season by the RailRiders, Highmark Blue Cross Blue Shield has pledged a \$10 donation to the Harry and Jeanette Weinberg Northeast Regional Food Bank in Pittston.

HOMERS THAT HELP: As part of *The Final Stretch™*, Minor League Baseball has announced that it will be donating \$50 for each home run hit by each club to a charity within that club's local community. The RailRiders are hitting home runs to benefit the Wyoming Valley Challenger Baseball. Through two games, the RailRiders have hit six home runs for a total donation thus far of \$300. The Triple-A team which hits the most home runs during the final stretch will receive a \$5,000 bonus for their designated organization.

CLOSE CALLS & BLOWOUTS: The RailRiders have played an extraordinary number of close games this season, with 58 of SWB's 121 games being decided by one or two runs (47.9%). Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has performed approximately average in these close contests, going 15-16 (.484) in one-run games and 15-12 (.555) in two-run games. However, the RailRiders have also participated in their share of extreme blowout games, decided by eight-or-more runs. In 13 such contests, SWB is 11-2 (.846) on the season, and is part of the reason why the team is +136 in run differential this season.

ONE OF THE BEST: Throughout the 2021 season, the RailRiders bullpen has been the backbone of the pitching staff, posting a 3.16 ERA as a unit and racking up 47 of SWB's 70 wins. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre own the fourth-best bullpen ERA in full season baseball (minors and majors), trailing only Buffalo (.287), Somerset (2.89) and Gwinnett (3.11). The bullpen is posting impressive rates of 11.01 K/9, 4.01 BB/9, and has limited opposing batters to just a .207 AVG this season. No team in Triple-A East has asked for more innings out of the bullpen than SWB's 572.0 this season.

EYES ON THE FINAL STRETCH™ PRIZE...WHATEVER IT IS: Unlike all other classifications, Triple-A does not have playoffs this year, with instead every team playing 10 extra games in the *Triple-A Final Stretch*. The *Triple-A Final Stretch* is a 10-game, 2-week "postseason tournament" which sees SWB playing a home series with Syracuse and a road series at Rochester. The team with the best overall record over the 10-game period will be dubbed the Final Stretch Champion and receive a prize that MLB has unbelievably still not announced despite the fact that Triple-A's *Final Stretch* began on Tuesday. Team and individual statistics achieved during the *Triple-A Final Stretch* will be counted toward regular season numbers, as confirmed by MLB's statistics team, making *The Final Stretch* a Schrödinger's Cat paradox where it is both the postseason and the regular season at the same time.

LAST TIME OUT: Wesneski made his Triple-A debut on Wednesday pitching in relief in a piggyback role on MLB rehabber Jameson Taillon. He struck out two and allowed a single to Wilfredo Tovar in his outing, which was interrupted twice by the lights going out at PNC Field. After the first delay, Wesneski returned and retired two batters on four pitches, then the lights went out again and the game was suspended. He was ultimately named the winning pitcher when the game finished, as the RailRiders took the lead for good while he was in the game.

2021 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season with the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades... promoted to Double-A Somerset Patriots on June 15... promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on September 21.
- Threw a complete game on 9/11 (G2) vs Hartford, falling one hit shy of a perfect game. Wesneski retired the final 11 batters he faced and struck out 11 of the final 12 hitters against him.
- Has a 24:0 K:BB ratio in his last three games, and 34:2 in his last four.

- Pitched three seasons (2017-19) at Sam Houston State (Tex.)... Was a 2017 Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American.
