FIVE-RUN FOURTH LIFTS JACKSONVILLE TO WIN

Heriberto Hernandez went yard on Tuesday during a five-run fourth inning as Jacksonville bested Memphis 6-3. The five-run fourth opened up the scoring, with Hernandez's solo home run and a pair of two-run doubles by **Jack Winkler** and **Jacob Berry**. **Ryan Vilade** hit a two-run shot to put the Redbirds on the board in the fifth, and Memphis added another run in the sixth to cut things to 5-3. **Maximo Acosta** registered an RBI single in the seventh to cap the scoring at 6-3. **George Soriano** and **Josh Simpson** each threw 2.0 scoreless innings of relief.

BIG, BEAUTIFUL INNINGS

Over the season's first 39 games, Jacksonville mustered at least four runs in an inning six times. However, over their last seven contests, the Jumbo Shrimp put up four runs or more in an inning seven times. Relatedly, over these last seven games, Jacksonville has piled up 49 runs (7.0 per game). Over the previous 12 contests, the Jumbo Shrimp had plated only 36 runs (3.0 per game - second-fewest in Triple-A).

PINTAREST

Jacksonville outfielder **Andrew Pinter** got off to a slow start to the season, slashing just .240/.296/.280/.576 with two doubles, three RBIs, six runs and two stolen bases in his first 12 games. The Provo, Utah native has been on a tear in the 28 games since. During this stretch, Pinter is hitting .370/.411/.500/.911 with five doubles, one triple, two home runs, 13 RBIs, six walks, 11 runs and 10 stolen bases. On the season, Pinter ranks tied for seventh in the IL in average (.333), 10th in hits (46), tied for 12th in steals (11) and 24th in OBP (.383).

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp are an extraordinary 20-5 at home this season, tied for the most home wins of any MiLB team while outscoring their opponents by a 108-74 margin at VyStar Ballpark. The road for Jacksonville, however, has been a different story. The Jumbo Shrimp are 9-12 on the road, getting outscored by an 115-103 margin. Jacksonville has hit similarly at home (.724 OPS) versus on the road (.710 OPS). However, their team ERA is 2.33 at home (1st, also 2nd in MiLB) compared to 5.41 on the road (23rd).

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded a stolen base in 37 of their last 46 games, with multiple steals in 28 contests. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have seven games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp currently rank first in Triple-A and fifth in the minor leagues with 107 stolen bases.

EXIT (VELOCITY) STRATEGY

Jacksonville's biggest strength in 2025, along with stealing bases, has been its pitching. The club ranks third in Triple-A with a 3.69 ERA, and their 189 runs allowed are the fourth-fewest at the level. Jumbo Shrimp pitchers have also limited walks (159, tied for the third-fewest in Triple-A). Interestingly, Jacksonville's staff has only 411 strikeouts, 11th at the level and also the third-fewest hits allowed. Opponents have mustered an average exit velocity of 87.4 against the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff, the sixth-lowest such mark in Triple-A.

SO, BABY, PULL ME CLOSER

Of the Jumbo Shrimp's last 37 games, a whopping 28 have been decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 19-9 (.679) in these closely-decided affairs during this stretch. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 21-10 (.677) in games decided by no more than three runs, including a 11-6 (.647) mark in one-run games. Those 11 one-run victories are tied for the most in the International League and tied for third in the minor leagues.

SHRIMP BITES

At 28-17, Jacksonville is off to its best start since the 2010 Jacksonville Suns also started the campaign 29-17. A win on Wednesday will get Jacksonville to 30-17, their best 47-game start in recorded club history (2005-present)... Jumbo Shrimp players make up five of the top 15 in the IL in stolen bases... **Adam Mazur** posted a 1.44 ERA in his first five games (25.0 IP, 18 H, 3 BB, 24 K, .205 BAA). Over his last three outings, he is 0-2 with a 7.07 ERA (14.0 IP, 20 H, 6 BB, 8 K, .339 BAA).

ABOUT ADAM

-Mazur was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Iowa. He made his major league debut for the Padres on June 4, 2024, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at the Los Angeles Angels. Mazur was later included in the July 30 trade along with left-hander Robby Snelling and infielders Graham Pauley and Jay Beshears in exchange for left-hander Tanner Scott and right-hander Bryan Hoeting.

-Mazur began his collegiate career at South Dakota State University before transferring to Iowa. He made 15 starts for the Hawkeyes in 2022, going 7-3 with a 3.07 ERA. Over 93.2 innings, he yielded only 60 hits and 30 walks while striking out 98 to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors. His 98 strikeouts ranks as the fourth-most in a single-season in program history, and he ranked eighth nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (5.8).

-When he made his MLB debut on June 4, 2024, Mazur became the fourth former Hawkeye to pitch in a big league game since 2000, joining Wes Obermueller (2002), Matt Dermody (2016) and Nick Allgeyer (2021).

-As a second-round pick (53rd overall), Mazur was the highest-drafted Hawkeye since Tim Costo was picked eighth overall by Cleveland in 1990.

-Mazur is an alumnus of Woodbury High School in Woodbury, Minn, where he was a finalist for the Minnesota Mr. Baseball Award. He was high school teammates with former Jacksonville and current Miami Marlins right-hander Max Meyer.

In addition to his baseball prowess growing up, Mazur earned four letters in basketball and two in football.

-The youngest of three boys, Adam's older brother Brandon played college baseball at Grand View.

2024 SEASON

-Mazur began the season with Double-A San Antonio before earning a promotion to Triple-A El Paso. He had his contract selected by San Diego on June 4 and made his major league debut that night against the Angels.

-Mazur was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for August 20-25 after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with one hit and one walk against four strikeouts in a 5-0 victory over Nashville on August 21.

2023 SEASON

-In 174 plate appearances, Mazur held right-handed hitters to a .208/.236/.286/.522 line compared to a .298/.332/.418/.750 batting line in 220 plate appearances for left-handed hitters.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-As a senior at Woodbury High School, Mazur compiled a 0.58 ERA with 112 strikeouts and only 12 walks in 72.1 innings. He also played shortstop, batting .377 with five doubles, one home run and 40 RBIs.
