On the Road Again

The Fightin Phils are back on the road for the final time in the season's first half, as they make the trip North to face the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. It is the second-of-18 meetings between the teams this season and second-of-six at Mirabito Stadium in Binghamton. After this week, Binghamton returns to Reading from July 28-August 2 and from August 25-30. The Rumble Ponies won last year's season-series 12-5 and Reading holds the 1-0 edge in 2026 after Tuesday night's series opening win.

Back In the Win Column

Braydon Tucker was the headliner on Tuesday night as the Fightin Phils rolled to a 3-0 win over Binghamton, good for Reading's second-shutout win of the season. Tucker picked up his fifth win and lowered his league-best ERA to 1.24. Daniel Harper followed with two strikeouts in a perfect eighth inning in his first start back with Reading, then Alex McFarlane struck out a hitter in a 1-2-3 ninth inning to secure his fifth save of the season. Reading struck with two runs in the sixth inning, then another tally in the top of the ninth. Bryson Ware lifted his ninth home run of the season to open the scoring. Kehden Hettiger drove in Reading's other two runs on the night, with one scored by each of Bryan Rincon and Dylan Campbell. Rincon led Reading with two hits, a run scored and double. Reading's pitching staff issued just one walk and allowed two hits on the night, good for three-total baserunners in the shutout victory.

King Tucker

Braydon Tucker's red-hot start to the 2026 season continued on Tuesday with seven-shutout innings, marking his second-straight seven-inning outings, matching both a season and career high. Through nine starts this season, Tucker has a 1.24 ERA (7 ER, 51.0 IP). Tucker has tossed five innings or more in seven-of-nine outings and six-plus frames five times, all of which were quality starts (6.0 + IP & < 3 runs). Tucker has allowed not more than two-earned runs in a start this season and has allowed one-or-less in eight-of-nine appearances. Entering play on Wednesday, Tucker leads the Eastern League in ERA (1.24), T-2nd wins (5), 3rd IP (51.0), is fifth in BAA (.205) and third in WHIP (1.02). Tucker now leads all of Double-A in ERA and has the lowest ERA amongst all full-season minor leaguers. He has even a lower ERA than MLB's leader, also a Phillie in Cristopher Sanchez (1.47).

May Flowers

Despite finishing in the middle of the pack offensively in May (7th with a .247 team average), the Fightin Phils turned in a strong month of May on the pitching and defense side of the ball. Reading finished fourth in the Eastern League with a 4.33 team ERA and was tops in the league with a 3.32 ERA from May 8 through the end of the month. The R-Phils were tied for fifth in the league with a .976 fielding percentage and led the league with 30 double plays turned.

Rincon Raked

Despite missing a week on the injured list, Bryan Rincon turned in a very impressive May across 20 games. The 22-year old shortstop slashed .301/.400/.630 (1.030 OPS), along with 19 runs, 11 extra-base hits (4 2B, 1 3B, 6 HR), 17 RBI and was 5-5 in stolen bases. For the month of May, Rincon held the following Eastern League ranks: 6th OBP (.400), 5th SLG (.630), 4th OPS (1.030) and T-6th runs (19).

Money McFarlane

Alex McFarlane continued his excellent season with a scoreless inning on Tuesday, along with his fifth save of the season. On the season, the Phillies No. 17 prospect has a 0.46 ERA (1 ER, 19.2 IP). McFarlane has not allowed an earned run in 14-straight outings and has not allowed one in 19-of-20 appearances on the season. Amongst Eastern League pitchers that have fired at least 19.0 IP this season, McFarlane has the lowest ERA at 0.46.

Packed the Park

The Fightin Phils welcomed an Eastern League, and Double-A, best 44,010 fans to FirstEnergy Stadium last week, good for an average of 7,335. This also included a season-high in attendance of 8,950. Reading's total attendance for the week also ranked second amongst the 60 minor league teams that were home last week. The week featured two Education Day games, Gage Wood's home debut, fireworks and an appearance from Joey Chestnut. For the season, the Fightin Phils have welcomed 127,154 fans to America's Classic Ballpark.

On The Move

Prior to Tuesday night's game, the Phillies announced a trio of moves to the Fightin Phils roster. Daniel Harper will re-join the bullpen after being assigned from Lehigh Valley (AAA) and to make room Cristhian Tortosa was released. 18-year old Gabriel Flores joins the catching room from the FCL-Phillies (ROK).

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 3, 2016: At Reading, the Fightin Phils use solo home runs by Dylan Cozens and Christian Marrero in the 9th inning to rally by New Hampshire, 5-4. Marrero had entered the game after starting 3B Angelo Mora was ejected in the 4th inning. It was Marrero's 3rd straight game with a HR.

Rumblin' Into Binghamton

After winning the Eastern League Championship last season, it has been a tough year for the Rumble Ponies in 2026, as they sit at 18-34, which is the worst record in the league. Binghamton dropped four-of-six games against Portland last week and continue their two-week home stand with Reading this week. Next week, Binghamton is back on the road at Somerset. The Rumble Ponies' roster features eight of the Mets' top-30 prospects: Jacob Reimer (4), Jonathan Santucci (8), Will Watson (9), Eli Serrano III (12), Chris Suero (14), RJ Gordon (18), Marco Vargas (19) and Brendan Girton (28).

Ponies Pitcher

Righty, and Mets' No. 18 prospect, RJ Gordon makes his fifth start of the season this morning for Binghamton. Gordon is 0-2, with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER, 9.2 IP), along with 10 strikeouts. Gordon last pitched on May 28 against Portland, allowed two runs, but none earned, over three innings, with four strikeouts. He began the season on the 7-day IL, making a rehab appearance with St. Lucie (A). Gordon split his first pro season in 2025 between Brooklyn (A+) and Binghamton, going 11-3, with a 3.36 ERA over 26 appearances and 21 starts. The 24-year old was drafted by the Mets in the 13th round in 2024 out of Oregon.
