CAREER NOTES

2025: Assigned to Altoona to begin the season... Matched his career-high with 3 HR allowed on 4/26 at Chesapeake... Finished 5.0 innings for the first time in his 7th start of the season on 5/14 (G1) vs. Harrisburg...

2024: Spent the entire season at High-A Greensboro, swinging between the bullpen and rotation... His 93 strikeouts were 9th-most among all Pirates farmhands... Reduced his walk rate from 4.3/9 innings in 2023 to 2.9/9 innings in 2024... Recorded a 1.17 ERA in four April outings (2 ER / 15.1 IP)... Bounced back from a difficult month of May (18 runs in 15.0 innings) to record a 3.48 ERA in 10.1 innings in June, 17 of 28 earned runs he allowed during the season came in the calendar month... Held opponents to a .173 batting average against in 15 outings, two starts, from June 1 through the end of the season... Picked up 58 strikeouts in his final 46.1 innings of the season... Recorded a 1.46 ERA in the second half of the season...

Picked up baseball at age six after a friend of his enrolled in the sport, noting in an interview with MLB. com's Michael Clair in 2024 that seeing stadiums filled with screaming fans in the U.S. caught his eye ... Suited up for Italy's U15 National Team ... Got his Italian passport at age 12 so that he could participate in the Italian National Team's development programs... Was Listed on Team Italy's provisional roster for the 2023 World Baseball Classic, but did not appear in the tournament... Was mentored by former Dodgers Minor Leaguer and German National Team Pitcher Markus Solbach and Italian Pitcher turned Pitching Coach Alessandro Maestri... In 2013, he made USA Baseball's 12-and-Under national team as an infielder... Shared the field with 10 others that were drafted into pro ball including Anthony Volpe (NYY), Anthony Hall (NYY), Justin Campbell (CLE), Andrew Pintar (MIA), Yohandy Morales (WSH) and Joe Naranjo (WSH)... Team USA won Gold and outscored their opponents 96-6 in the tournament... Attended Hillcrest High School, the same school as 2019 AL batting champion infielder Tim Anderson... Spent two seasons at Shelton State CC before joining the Crimson Tide in 2022... Was the Friday night starter for the Tide in his first season... Was limited to 10 appearances and 32.1 innings in his final season at Alabama and recorded a 4.89 ERA, helping the Tide to an appearance in the Super Regionals... Missed time early in his 2023 season with a shoulder injury suffered in spring practice... <u>Told Jeff Mills of the Greensboro Grasshoppers about hitter-friendly FNB Park</u> "Yeah, it's a hitter's park. But you know what? It's kind of like pitching in the SEC, to be honest," McMillan says. "With the metal bats and short fences, those college ballparks played pretty small. I'm used to it, and I'm not intimidated at all. You push that stuff out of your mind and think about pitching."... "I zero in on one batter at a time," McMillan says. "You have to do it that way, because an inning can get away from you in a hurry. I learned that in the SEC. One minute you're cruising along, everything's going good. Then all of a sudden there's two outs but three men on base. You give up a hit there, and you're in trouble. So you really have to focus in and pay attention, making sure you make quality pitches to every batter."


