THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On April 15, 1978, the Sounds played the first game in franchise history. The game resulted in a 4-2 loss to the Memphis Chicks at Tim McCarver Stadium in Memphis. Scott Anderson was the winning pitcher and Bill Dawley was tagged with the loss. Felipe Alou was the visiting manager.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Gwinnett Stripers play game four of a six-game series tonight at Coolray Field. Nashville has a 2-1 series lead after taking a 5-4 win in last night's contest. Right-hander Josh Lindblom starts for the Sounds as he faces spot-starter Nick Vincent for Gwinnett.

Josh Lindblom: 34-year-old Josh Lindblom will start for Nashville in game four of the series. The right-hander is making his second start of the season after taking the win on April 9 vs. Durham. He tossed 5.0 scoreless inning, allowing just two hits and two walks with four strikeouts in his first start. The Lafayette, Ind. native was a MiLB.com Organization All-Star last season after going 5-4 with a 3.10 ERA in 22 games (20 starts) with the Sounds last year. He also pitched in eight games (all relief) with the Brewers last season. He pitched in the Korea Baseball Organization from 2015-19, winning two Choi Dong-Won Awards (KBO Cy Young) in 2018 and 2019. He was originally drafted in the second round of the 2009 MLB First-Year Player Draft by the Dodgers out of Purdue University.

Nick Vincent: 35-year-old Nick Vincent makes his first start of the season for Gwinnett tonight. He has made three appearances for the Stripers this season, allowing a total of three runs (all earned) in 3.0 innings. He pitched in relief on April 12 against Nashville, tossing a scoreless inning with no hits and a strikeout. Vincent pitched in the Rangers and Twins organizations in 2021. He combined to go 3-1 with a 4.40 ERA in 39 appearances between Triple-A St. Paul (24) and Round Rock (15). He also went 1-0 with a 0.71 ERA in 7 relief outings with Minnesota. The Poway, Calif. native has pitched in the Majors since 2012 with San Diego, Seattle, San Francisco, Philadelphia, Miami and Minnesota.

Sweeter in 9th: Sounds Manager Rick Sweet is tied for 9th-most all-time among minor league managers with Jack Dunn. His 2,107 wins is the 2nd-most among active managers, with only Buddy Bailey of Low-A Myrtle Beach holding more wins.

Weston Wilson Winning: Infielder Weston Wilson is on a tear at the plate after yesterday's two-hit, two-RBI performance. He is 6-for-11 over his current three-game hitting streak with two runs and three RBI in the series at Gwinnett.

Answering the Call: Sounds relievers have allowed just two runs over 12.1 innings pitched at Gwinnett this series, including nine consecutive scoreless frames from the eighth inning on Tuesday through eight innings last night.

The Outing: Jason Alexander picked up his second win in as many starts last night at Gwinnett. He's allowed three runs (all earned) over 10.0 innings pitched. It's the first time in his professional career that he has earned the win in his first two starts of the season.

Hold the Line: Nashville relievers have amassed 14 holds this season, far-and-away the most in Triple-A baseball (Albuquerque has the second-most with 8).

I got 99 Problems: Wednesday night's go-ahead two-run blast by David Dahl was his 99th career home run in professional baseball. Dahl has 57 minor league home runs and 42 in the big leagues. 4 of his 99 career blasts have come with Nashville.

Down But Not Out: In the six games the Sounds have won in 2022, two have come when they trailed after six innings, including last night's come-from-behind win. On April 10 vs. Durham, Nashville trailed 2-0 after six frames and won 4-3.

Big Inning: Of Nashville's 15 runs scored in the series at Gwinnett, 13 have come in multi-run innings. The Sounds exploded for seven runs in the eighth inning on Wednesday. They also tallied four runs in the first inning last night.

Bandits: Nashville is a perfect 8-for-8 on stolen base attempts in 2022 which is tied for the 9th-most in the International League. Jonathan Davis and Corey Ray pace the team with two steals ap

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 515-463 record during this span.

LAST OUTING: Lindblom made his 2022 debut on April 9 against Durham at First Horizon Park. The right-hander went 5.0 innings and shut out the Bulls on the way to a 2-1 Sounds win. He yielded only 2 hits and 2 walks while recording 4 strikeouts. Lindblom threw 81 pitches, 51 for strikes.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Lindblom faced Gwinnett five times in 2021, including four starts. He went 2-2 with a 3.38 ERA (24.0 IP/9 ER), walked 5 batters and struck out 26. He also pitched against Gwinnett twice during the 2017 season with Indianapolis and went 0-0 with a 2.08 ERA (4.1 IP/1 ER).
