LAST TIME OUT

Moosic, PA (May 14, 2023) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders dropped 6-3 to the Omaha Storm Chasers on a Sunday matinee contest. In Major League rehab, Oswald Peraza had a home run in the first inning. Billy McKinney had one as well in the eighth but it was not enough to mount a comeback against Omaha.

The Railriders picked up right where they left off. They wrapped up Saturday afternoon's contest with a homer and led off Sunday's clash with a similar result. On a rehab assignment with Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Oswald Peraza laced a solo home run to the home bullpen to give the team a 1-0 lead in the bottom of the first.

CJ Alexander answered back for the Storm Chasers with his second homer in as many games to tie the game back up at one. In the same inning, a wild pitch allowed Jackson Reetz to reach on a strikeout. A double off the bat of Brewer Hicklen and an error allowed Reetz to come home, giving Omaha a 2-1 lead in the top of the second. In the top of the fourth, Alexander ripped a triple down the first base line and scored following an RBI double from Reetz, further damage was threatened but Mitch Spence fanned Clay Dungan to work out of a jam, Omaha led 3-1 at the top of the fourth.

Franchy Cordero led the bottom of the fourth with a double and Rodolfo Durán hit a singled to reach. Billy McKinney worked a walk to load the bases. Jesús Bastidas fought through an at-bat to garner a walk as well scoring Cordero and the Railriders cut the Stormchasers lead to 3-2.

Back and forth scoreless innings were exchanged for three straight, until McKinney broke it up with a solo deep ball to right to tie the game up at three a piece in the eighth. After McKinney's fourth long ball of the season, Estevan Florial had a base hit but was left stranded, keeping the tie at 3-3.

In the top of the ninth, Hicklen shot a deep ball into left to give Omaha a 4-3 lead. Dairon Blanco recorded a walk and Samad Taylor smoked a two-run shot to pad the lead 6-3.

Mitch Spence went five frames allowing five hits, while giving up three runs, two of which were earned. Matt Krook pitched a quiet sixth, fanning three and walking one. Colten Brewer came on in relief of Krook and kept the Storm Chasers at bay, striking out two, and tallying a walk. DJ Snelten (L, 0-3) went two thirds of an inning allowing three runs on the two long balls in the top of the ninth. But, Barrett Loseke recorded a strike out to end the frame.

NEWS & NOTES

WHO'S ON FIRST - The RailRiders have had six different first basemen this season. Billy McKinney leads the way with fourteen starts, while Andres Chaparro has made eleven starts there. Mickey Gasper and Jake Bauers have also played their hands at first base this season. Last night, Rodolfo Duran played his first ever professional contest in the corner infield position. Every defensive player at first, except Gasper, has made at least one error in the position. Yesterday, Carlos Narvaez, in just his third Triple-A contest, got his initial start at first.

HOMESTAND HEROICS - The RailRiders recorded both their first and second walk-off victories of the season twice against the Omaha Storm Chasers last week. At PNC Field, fans got to see a pair of walk-off homers, one from Michael Hermosillo and the other from Ben Rortved, to rally victories in the bottom of the ninth. After spending back-to-back weeks at home, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre went 7-5 on the homestand.

FIELDING FAUX PAS - With one miscue last night, the RailRiders totalled 43 errors on the season as a team. This puts them first in the Triple-A in this category and tied for 11th in all of Minor League Baseball. Andres Chaparro has nine, seven at third base and two at first. The team has one game with five miscues committed. SWB has had 12 error-free games.

DURAN DIMES - Catcher Rodolfo Duran has been showing off his arm behind the plate this season. He's caught six runners trying to steal for a 35% caught stealing clip. Duran nabbed 16 runners last season for the Somerset Patriots. He has played in 14 games behind the plate and one game at first this season for SWB.

PERAZA REHAB - Oswald Peraza joined the RailRiders for a rehab assignment on Sunday to end the series against Omaha. He launched his first Triple-A home run of the season and looked good at short stop. Peraza was recalled by New York and played in 12 big league games. He recorded six hits before being placed on the 10-day Injured List with a right ankle sprain on May 9. Peraza is set to continue his rehab assignment as the team travels to Charlotte.

BULLPEN BLAST - The bullpen has given the RailRiders some strong ending innings this season. In total relievers have combined for a 3.67 earned run average, tossing just under half of the frames pitched. Matt Krook leads the way with a 1.42 ERA.

ANOTHER YEAR DOWN - On May 4, Andres Chaparro turned 24 years old and the RailRiders will celebrate five more birthdays to come this May. Mitch Spence turns 26 on 5/6. Deivi Garcia turns 24 on 5/19. DJ Snelten turns 31 on 5/29, while Elijah Dunham turns 25 the same day. Matt Bowman turns 32 on 5/31.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Elijah Dunham (#16 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Randy Vasquez (#12) and Sean Boyle (#28) are both set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

ATOP THE FARM: Sean Boyle stacks up well against the other pitchers in the Yankees Minor League system. Last season, he recorded the most games started (27), most wins (13), most innings (155.1), and most strikeouts (160) among the farm system.

PUZZLER PITCHER: Last season, Boyle brought back an old trend of solving a Rubik's Cube. After getting his teammates invested in Somerset, he brought one to the Major League clubhouse at Spring Training this season. It's become a go to distraction and a competitive outlet. His record solve time is 32 seconds, but he likes to practice before every start.

QUALITY & QUANTITY: Boyle's final ten games in Double-A (2022) were quality starts. Across the three starts prior to the streak, Boyle allowed 21 R (19 ER) over 13.1 IP, equaling an ERA of 12.83. In Boyle's first start vs. Binghamton (5/30), he allowed a career-high 10 runs. In his last non-quality start before the streak vs. the Rumble Ponies on 6/5 he gave up three home runs in the first three innings of the game, before proceeding to retire the final 7 batters he faced to earn his 2nd win of the season.

BOYLE'S NO-NO DUO: In his third career Triple-A start, Boyle threw a seven-inning no-hit against the Worcester Red Sox on August 19, 2021. It was the first no-hitter in the history of Polar Park. Max McDowell was behind the plate that night. Boyle was part of another no-hitter, tossing four no-hit innings in a combined no-no on July 10, 2021 with Hudson Valley (A+) against the Brooklyn Cyclones.

- Transferred to Dallas Baptist University for his junior and senior seasons (2017-18), where he posted a 3.60 ERA over 21 appearances his senior year.
- Did not start playing baseball until he reached the 10th grade
- Pitched a no-hitter in the Blue Chips Prospects 18U Northeast Elite Tournament in high school
