The Fightin Phils continue a two-week road trip on Wednesday night at the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. It is the 14th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and eighth-of-12 at Mirabito Stadium. Binghamton leads the season-series 7-6.

Dropping the Opener

The Fightin Phils snapped their three-game winning streak with a 4-2 loss at Binghamton on Tuesday night. Noah Skirrow allowed three runs over five innings, putting Reading in a 3-0 hole. Erick Brito tripled home Ethan Wilson in the top of the sixth to make it 3-1. Andrew Baker pitched a clean sixth inning, but allowed a run in the seventh to make it 4-1. Reading got one back when Justin Crawford scored Wilson on an RBI groundout in the eighth to make it 4-2. Carlos Francisco pitched a perfect 1.1 frames, while striking out two. Brito and Wilson had two hits, while Caleb Ricketts also added his first triple of the season. The Fightin Phils matched their season-high with two triples in the game, matching their total from May 11 against Hartford.

Like Jordan, Going Back-to-Back-to-Back

The Fightin Phils hit three-straight home runs in the bottom of the fifth inning in Saturday night's game against the Fisher Cats. Gabriel Rincones Jr. (10) launched a solo shot, then Otto Kemp (10) homered and Trevor Schwecke (5) followed with a blast to left. It was the first time Reading homered in three-straight at bats since June 7, 2016 at Akron. It was done by Jorge Alfaro, Dylan Cozens and Rhys Hoskins. Reading also homered for three times in an inning for the third time this season, with all of those instances coming after the All-Star Break.

Red-Hot Schwecke

Trevor Schwecke's red-hot week finished with two hits and a run scored on Sunday. Last week, Schwecke slashed .429/.429/.667, with a 1.096 OPS. He' added four runs, two doubles, a home run and seven RBI, while striking out just one time. Schwecke drove in multiple runs in three-straight games (8/14-16), as well. Schwecke was the fifth Fightin Phil to have a streak of three-or-more games with multiple RBI this season. It was the first time this season Schwecke has driven in multiple RBI in consecutive contests. He also matched his season-long six-game hitting streak, which was snapped on Tuesday night.

Rincones Rolling

Gabriel Rincones Jr.'s power surge continued with his 10th homer run of the season on Saturday night. He is now riding an 12-game on-base streak, dating back to Aug. 7. Over that streak, he's slashing .333/.423/.756, with a 1.179 OPS. Rincones has added 11 runs, four doubles, five home runs and 11 RBI.

Castellano Cruising

Eiberson Castellano turned in another impressive start on Sunday. He went six innings, allowing two runs on five hits, with one walk and 10 strikeouts. It was a Double-A high in punchouts for him and marked the third time in 2024 Castellano had 10+ strikeouts in a game. The last Fightin Phil to punch out exactly 10 hitters in a contest was Griff McGarry on July 21, 2023, at Altoona. Over his five starts with Reading thus far, Castellano had two quality starts, and has gone at least five innings in all five starts, while not allowing more than two runs in an appearance.

Mr. Otto-Matic

Otto Kemp extended his on-base streak to 19 games with a hit in Tuesday night's game. Over his 19-game on-base streak (dating back to July 27) Kemp is slashing .319/.427/.522 (.949 OPS). He's added four doubles, two triples, two home runs and eight RBI. Kemp's 19-game on-base streak is second in the Eastern League for longest on-base streak, trailing Hartford's Ryan Ritter (20) by one. Kemp is seeking to become the first R-Phil to surpass a 20-game on-base streak since Oliver Dunn (22) from 5/26-6/23, 2023; along with Carlos De La Cruz (38) from 5/12-6/25, 2023.

This Day in Baseballtown History

August 21, 2007: At Reading, Carlos Carrasco tosses a 6-inning no-hitter against Altoona as the Phillies win their second straight rain-shortened affair, 1-0. Carrasco fans eight and walks two Curve batters. Joey Hammond's RBI groundout to 3rd base scores Jason Hill with the game's only run in the 2nd inning.

Rumbling Into Binghamton

Binghamton enters tonight after finishing in second place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 35-32 record. They are fourth in the Northeast Division with a 23-22 record in the second half of the season. Binghamton most recently dropped five-of-six at home against Portland. Following this week, Binghamton goes to Hartford. Binghamton's roster features five players ranked amongst the New York Mets' top-30 prospects: Jett Williams (2), Ryan Clifford (4), Nolan McLean (9), Kevin Parada (25) and Alex Ramirez (26).

Ponies Pitcher

Righty Jordan Geber makes the start tonight for Binghamton. Geber has made 20 appearances (8 starts) between High-A Brooklyn, Triple-A Syracuse and Binghamton this season. He's combined to 4-5, with a 3.36 ERA. He suffered a loss vs Portland on Aug. 15, allowing four runs on seven hits over four innings. Geber split 2023 between the FCL-Mets (ROK), Single-A St. Lucie, Brooklyn and Binghamton, combininb to go 5-2, with a 4.21 ERA over 15 games (7 starts). He began his pro career in 2022 between St. Lucie and Binghamton. The Mets signed him in 2022 as an undrafted free agwnt out of Virginia Tech.
