## FRES-NOTES

**MILESTONE IN REACH:** Fresno's current success against Stockton fits a larger trend that has carried over multiple seasons. The Grizzlies are 98-43 against the Ports since 2021 and have gone 51-27 against Stockton at Chukchansi Park in that span. Fresno has never lost the season series to the Ports.

**SWING-AND-MISS DEPTH:** The Grizzlies pitching staff has shown depth against Stockton beyond just one arm, with multiple pitchers generating strikeouts in limited work. Seth Clausen (2 K in 0.2 IP), Austin Emener (4 K in 2.0 IP) and Zach Harris (2 K in 2.0 IP) have all delivered high strikeout rates in their appearances, contributing to Fresno's overall swing-and-miss success in the series.

**BERNARD CONTINUES TO PRODUCE:** Derek Bernard has been a consistent presence at the top of the lineup against Stockton, going 4-for-10 (.400) with three walks in three games this season. He also owns a .405 career average against the Ports across 84 at-bats, the highest mark among current Grizzlies hitters with significant history in the matchup.

**COOLED OFF:** Not only did Stockton snap Fresno's win streak on Thursday, but the Ports held Fresno to its lowest offensive totals in both runs and hits. But Roldy Brito's 7th inning double extended the Grizzlies streak with at least one extra-base hit to six games. Fresno has 17 extra-base hits in 6 games so far. Nine different Grizzlies hitters have registered at least one XBH this season.
