

Today: It's the first Coors Light Thirsty Thursday of the year, with \$3 domestics (cans/drafts), \$5 seltzers, and \$3 16oz soft drink specials, as the Lansing Lugnuts, the Athletics' High-A affiliate, play the third in a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, the Dodgers' High-A affiliate. APRIL 10TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2018: The Lugnuts came back from 2-0, 4-2 and 5-4 deficits, taking a 6-5 victory at Fort Wayne on Ryan Noda's go-ahead two-run single in the seventh off eventual All-Star Travis Radke. The game ended on a brilliant game-saving catch by right fielder Chavez Young with the tying run aboard, hauling in a Gabriel Arias drive on the warning track, falling to his left, crashing into the wall, and ending up on the ground – with the ball secured.

2022: Tyler Soderstrom's first Lugnuts hit was an RBI double, and the Nuts beat the Captains at home, 6-5, for Phil Pohl's first career managerial victory. In the Majors, Jordan Romano (2016 Lugnu breaks Tom Henke's Toronto Blue Jays franchise record with his 26th consecutive save.

In a Nutshell: Robinson is one of five 2024 draft picks on the Lugnuts' 2025 Opening Day roster, joining Tommy White (2nd round), Gage Jump (2nd round compensatory), Joshua Kuroda-Grauer (3rd round) and Rodney Green, Jr. (4th round)... he made his Lugnuts debut on Sunday at Fort Wayne, tossing two scoreless innings with three strikeouts to earn the win in Lansing's 5-3 victory... today is Robinson's first Midwest League start.

High School: Played four years on varsity for George C. Marshall High School (Falls Church, Virginia)... named All-Conference First Team as sophomore, junior and senior... named Conference Pitcher of the Year and Conference Player of the Year as a senior: 66 2/3 IP, 1.49 ERA, 60 K... George C. Marshall is best known for the Marshall Plan, which saw the United States give \$13.3 billion to help rebuild Western European economies; it earned Marshall the 1953 Nobel Peace Prize... Marshall's nickname is the Statesmen... other notable Marshall alumni include the first woman to officially run the Boston Marathon, Kathrine Switzer; safety and current Dallas Cowboys special teams coordinator Nick Sorensen; defensive end Michael McCrary; table tennis legend Sean O'Neill; and pitcher Pete Schourek.
