Atop the Midwest League: Center fielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** is tied for the league lead with two home runs and is two off the lead with five runs scored. Right fielder **Nate Nankil**'s 5-RBI game launched him into a tied for the 3rd-most runs batted in, with his 6 RBIs ranking three off the league lead.

Atop the Minors: 2024 A's first-rounder **Nick Kurtz** jumped over Lansing on his way up the ladder and is excelling with Triple-A Las Vegas. Kurtz leads all of Minor League Baseball with 6 home runs, 11 extra-base hits, 40 total bases and 17 RBIs.

Atop the Majors: 2022 Lugnut **Tyler Soderstrom** is tied with the Yankees' Aaron Judge for the most home runs in MLB (6). Soderstrom ranks 2nd in slugging percentage (.771), 4th in OPS (1.197) and tied for 3rd in total bases (37). 2023 Lugnut **Jacob Wilson** is tied for 1st in the Majors with 19 hits and ranks 2nd with a .396 batting average.

Prospecting: The Nuts boast the A's second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman **Tommy White** (40th overall), southpaw starter **Gage Jump** (73rd), shortstop **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (75th) and outfielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 14 and Green is No. 20. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria**, rated No. 12, and outfielder **Nate Nankil**, who is No. 30.

Welcome Back: The Lugnuts' roster features 17 returning players, from position players **Jonny Butler**, **Cole Conn**, **Jared Dickey**, **Clark Elliott**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Nate Nankil**, **CJ Rodriguez**, **T.J. Schofield-Sam** and **Casey Yamauchi** to pitchers **Mark Adamiak**, **Hunter Breault**, **Jake Garland**, **Garrett Irvin**, **Grant Judkins**, **Blaze Pontes** and **Yehizon Sanchez**.

Transaction: **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (hamstring) was placed on the 7-day Injured List on Monday, with no corresponding move.

DK at the Helm: The 19th manager in Lugnuts history is **Darryl Kennedy**, entering his second year in the A's organization. Kennedy distinguished himself as a catcher at Manatee Community College before starring at the University of North Florida and was named an NCAA All-American in 1991 en route to North Florida's Hall of Fame, inducted in 2017. Kennedy played in the Minor Leagues for seven seasons, including parts of four seasons in Triple-A. Following his 1997 retirement, he immediately began managing, leading the Gulf Coast League Rangers to the 1998 GCL Championship. Kennedy won a second title with the GCL Rangers in 2000, moving on to stops in the Florida State League, Northwest League and Texas League through 2006. Upon joining the Royals' organization, Kennedy managed in the Appalachian League, Carolina League, Pioneer League, Arizona League and Texas League through 2020. He served as bench coach for the KBO's Hanwha Eagles from 2021 through 2023 before joining the A's as Double-A Midland's assistant hitting coach in 2024.

Filling Out the Staff: **Dave Burba**, the Lugnuts' new pitching coach, walked on at Ohio State, pitched in the Big Ten Championship game as a freshman, was drafted by the Mariners one round after Ken Griffey, Jr. in 1987, and won 115 games in 15 MLB seasons before spending 13 seasons as a pitching coach in the Colorado Rockies' organization. **Rubén Escalera**, returns for a second year as assistant hitting coach and enters his 30th season in the A's organization; Escalera simultaneously serves as a scout for the A's in addition to coaching. And the pride of Yuba City, Calif., **Cooper Goldby** comes to the Lugnuts after two seasons serving as the Dominican Summer League A's manager. The catcher/utilityman was drafted out of Lewis-Clark State in the 35th round in 2017 and played three years in the A's org.

APRIL 10TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2018: The Lugnuts came back from 2-0, 4-2 and 5-4 deficits, taking a 6-5 victory at Fort Wayne on Ryan Noda's go-ahead two-run single in the seventh off eventual All-Star Travis Radke. The game ended on a brilliant game-saving catch by right fielder Chavez Young with the tying run aboard, hauling in a Gabriel Arias drive on the warning track, falling to his left, crashing into the wall, and ending up on the ground – with the ball secured.

2022: Tyler Soderstrom's first Lugnuts hit was an RBI double, and the Nuts beat the Captains at home, 6-5, for Phil Pohl's first career managerial victory. In the Majors, Jordan Romano (2016 Lugnu breaks Tom Henke's Toronto Blue Jays franchise record with his 26th consecutive save.

In a Nutshell: Robinson is one of five 2024 draft picks on the Lugnuts' 2025 Opening Day roster, joining Tommy White (2nd round), Gage Jump (2nd round compensatory), Joshua Kuroda-Grauer (3rd round) and Rodney Green, Jr. (4th round)... he made his Lugnuts debut on Sunday at Fort Wayne, tossing two scoreless innings with three strikeouts to earn the win in Lansing's 5-3 victory... today is Robinson's first Midwest League start.

High School: Played four years on varsity for George C. Marshall High School (Falls Church, Virginia)... named All-Conference First Team as sophomore, junior and senior... named Conference Pitcher of the Year and Conference Player of the Year as a senior: 66 2/3 IP, 1.49 ERA, 60 K... George C. Marshall is best known for the Marshall Plan, which saw the United States give \$13.3 billion to help rebuild Western European economies; it earned Marshall the 1953 Nobel Peace Prize... Marshall's nickname is the Statesmen... other notable Marshall alumni include the first woman to officially run the Boston Marathon, Kathrine Switzer; safety and current Dallas Cowboys special teams coordinator Nick Sorensen; defensive end Michael McCrary; table tennis legend Sean O'Neill; and pitcher Pete Schourek.

Texas Tech: Robinson opened up his time in Lubbock as a reliever in 2022, appearing in 12 games (including nine appearances without allowing an earned run)... as a sophomore, was named to the 2023 Collegiate National Team; posted 5.36 ERA in 45 1/3 innings before finishing strong, posting five scoreless innings with eight strikeouts in the Big 12 Tournament against Oklahoma State to earn a nod on the All-Tournament Team, then limited No. 2 Florida to two ER in five innings in the NCAA Tournament... as a junior, led the Red Raiders with 76 IP in 15 starts, with a 5.09 ERA; struck out 11 in six innings at Oklahoma State on May 11, 2024... drafted following junior year... notable Texas Tech pros include Josh Tomlin, Danny Coulombe, Josh Jung, and the inimitable Dallas Braden.

Welcome to Pro Ball: Signed for \$150,000 after being selected with the first pick of Day 3 by the A's... made pro debut for Stockton on August 23, 2024 (2 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 2 K)... made three starts in total before Stockton's season ended, allowing exactly two earned runs in each outing... lefties hit .333 (6-for-18) with 1 BB / 6 K, while righties hit .273 (3-for-11) with 2 BB, 3 K... base-stealers went 2-for-2... pitched in the 2025 Crosstown Showdown, tossing two scoreless innings against Michigan State in relief of Yuniur Tur.
