LRST TIME OUT...

ALLENTOWN, Pa. (September 18, 2021) – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders took two games from the Lehigh Valley IronPigs on Saturday at Coca-Cola Park in Allentown, winning 6-2 in the completion of a suspended game and 4-1 in a seven-inning version of the scheduled game. The wins clinched the 2021 IronRail Rivalry Series for the RailRiders with one game left to play.

On Wednesday, the IronPigs plated a run against RailRiders starter Brody Koerner in the bottom of the first on a pair of singles, including a run-scoring knock by TJ Rivera, for a 1-0 lead. Rain halted play, however, in the bottom of the second inning. Play resumed on Saturday afternoon and Lehigh Valley tallied a run in the top of the third against Matt Krook. A Luke Williams sac fly plated Charlie Tilson to extend the lead to 2-0.

The RailRiders could not square up a base hit off of Josh Hendrickson, who was making his Triple-A debut. The southpaw walked two batters in the third and the fifth but kept the RailRiders at bay until the seventh. Max Burt doubled to left and Hendrickson walked Estevan Florial and Andrew Velazquez to load the bases with one out in the top of the seventh. Chris Gittens hit a grand slam right-center to give SWB a 4-2 lead.

The RailRiders added a run in the eighth when Kyle Holder was balked in from third base by Taylor Guerreri. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre capped the scoring in the ninth when Trey Amburgey singled home Jonathan Davis for a 6-2 RailRiders advantage. Krook (5-5) allowed one run on three hits over 6.2 relief innings in back of Wednesday's starter Brody Koerner, striking out seven and walking one. Hendrickson (0-1) took the loss despite allowing just one hit, walking six and striking out three.

Brady Lail and Sean Boyle made spot starts in the seven-inning nightcap. Lail, the former RailRider, blanked his old club on one hit with three strikeouts over three innings. Boyle held Lehigh Valley in check over four scoreless, walking two and striking out one. In the sixth, Appel walked Jonathan Davis and gave up a double to Donny Sands; the catcher's third hit of the game. Lehigh Valley walked Greg Allen to load the bases. Trey Amburgey pinch-hit for Holder and double to the left-field corner to clear the bases for a 3-0 RailRiders lead. Matt Pita singled home Amburgey to extend the edge. Domingo German (1-0) garnered the win, allowing one run on two hits with two walks and three strikeouts over two innings.

NEWS & NOTES

CERTIFIED STRIKEOUT BOYS: RailRiders pitchers have posted high strikeout totals throughout the season, but in the month of September have kicked it into another gear. SWB hurlers have recorded 174 strikeouts in 134.0 innings, and are posting gaudy rates of 11.69 K/9 and 29.5 K%. In a small sample size, those rates are by far the best monthly strikeout rates posted by the RailRiders staff this season. In Tuesday's series opener with Lehigh Valley, SWB pitchers struck out 16 batters, and have struck out 113 batters in 91.0 IP over their last 11 games.

YOU DIDN'T KNOW? YOU BETTER CALL SOMEBODY: This season, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders have been the best road team in Triple-A East. Entering the regular season finale, the RailRiders are 36-21 (.631) away from home, the best road record in the league (Durham & Jacksonville, 36-23, .610). The RailRiders and the Reno Aces (ARI) are tied for the fewest road losses among Triple-A clubs, and are tied for sixth-fewest road losses among full-season minor league teams. Amazingly, Fresno (Low-A, COL) is 38-17 (.691) away from home to sport the best road record in the minors.

RACING CLOSE TO A NEW RECORD: Through 116 games, the RailRiders have stolen 131 bases in 166 attempts in the 2021 season (78.9% success). The all-time Scranton/Wilkes-Barre franchise record for most stolen bases in a season belongs to the 2000 Red Barons, who stole 139 bases, meaning that the 2021 RailRiders are 8 steals shy of setting a new franchise record with 11 games to play. The team has stolen an average of 1.12 bases per game this year, which puts them on pace to break the record during the *Final Stretch*. The thievery has ticked up in September, with SWB currently 24-for-27 in steal attempts in 16 games during the month (1.50 steals/game). **Andrew Velazquez** leads the team with 29 stolen bases in 74 games, and with one more can become the first SWB player with 30 steals in a season since **Brett Gardner** stole 37 with the 2008 SWB Yankees.

CLOSE CALLS & BLOWOUTS: The RailRiders have played an extraordinary number of close games this season, with 57 of SWB's 116 games being decided by one or two runs (49.1%). Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has performed approximately average in these close contests, going 15-16 (.484) in one-run games and 14-12 (.538) in two-run games. However, the RailRiders have also participated in their share of extreme blowout games, decided by eight-or-more runs. In 13 such contests, SWB is 11-2 (.846) on the season, and is part of the reason why the team is +133 in run differential this season, third-best in Triple-A East.

SANDS STORM: After beginning the last homestand on a 1-for-17 (.058) slide, RailRiders catcher **Donny Sands** has been on a tear over his last eight games played. Since September 5, Sands is batting .444/.416/.815 (12-for-27) with 4 2B, 2 HR, and 10 RBIs. The streak has raised his season OPS by 120 points, and 35.7% (10-of-28) of his season RBIs with SWB have come during it.

STOP THE STEAL: The Lehigh Valley IronPigs are 11-for-14 on stolen base attempts through two games in this series, continuing a troubling trend of teams running wild on the RailRiders. Opponents are a combined 26-for-30 in stolen base attempts against SWB in the month of September. Since the beginning of August, RailRiders opponents are a stunning 45-for-53 (84.9% success rate) when trying to steal against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. That is approximately the career success rate of Jayson Werth, who ranks fifth all-time in success rate.

ONE OF THE BEST: Throughout the 2021 season, the RailRiders bullpen has been the backbone of the pitching staff, posting a 3.11 ERA as a unit and racking up 46 of SWB's 67 wins. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has the second-best bullpen ERA in full season baseball (minors and majors), trailing only Somerset (2.83) and Buffalo (2.92). The bullpen is posting impressive rates of 11.00 K/9, 4.02 BB/9, and has limited opposing batters to just a .206 AVG this season. No team in Triple-A East has asked for more innings out of the bullpen than SWB's 558.0 this season.

EYES ON THE FINAL STRETCH PRIZE...WHATEVER THAT IS: Sunday continues the final series of the regular season across Minor League Baseball, as the RailRiders finish on the road at Lehigh Valley. Unlike all other classifications, Triple-A does not have playoffs this year, instead every team plays 10 extra games in the *Triple-A Final Stretch*. The *Triple-A Final Stretch* is a 10-game, 2-week "postseason tournament" which sees SWB playing a home series with Syracuse and a road series at Rochester. The team with the best overall record over the 10-game period will be dubbed the *Final Stretch* Champion and receive a prize which is inexplicably still TBA. Team and individual stats and records achieved during the *Triple-A Final Stretch* will be counted toward regular season numbers, as confirmed by MLB's statistics team.

LAST TIME OUT: Sears tied a season and career high with 10 strikeouts in his last start on Tuesday at Lehigh Valley. The lefty threw 6.0 innings for the second straight start and scattered seven hits and allowed only two runs while not walking a single batter. The IronPigs got to Sears for two runs on four hits in the second inning, but the southpaw allowed only two hits afterward.

SEARS ON SEARS: Sears was featured along with Somerset lefty **Ken Waldchuk** in a July 2 article on FanGraphs. Here is what he told David Laurila about how he has changed since being acquired by New York: "It's been a while — it's been four years — so I'm definitely different, and that's in a good way. I still have an above-average fastball with ride, and all that, but I've learned to pitch better. My secondary stuff is better, and I also spent all of 2020 cleaning up my delivery." On what he looks for in analytics: "I don't look at spin rate as much as I look at my break-z and my z-deception. Those numbers went down in 2018 and 2019, and they're starting to come back up in 2021." - <https://blogs.fangraphs.com/lets-hear-from-a-pair-of-yankees-prospects/>

MISTAKEN IDENTITY: RailRiders pitcher JP Sears is not to be confused with YouTube personality and comedian JP Sears, despite the other dominating the front page of a Google search for "JP Sears". It is easy to tell the two apart by sight, as the other Sears sports both long hair and a beard, neither of which are allowed by the New York Yankees.

2021 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season with the Double-A Somerset Patriots break camp roster.
- Started season out of the bullpen and as a spot-starter, but moved into the rotation full-time on June 24, making his final six appearances with Somerset as a starter.
- Struck out 10 batters in 5.0 innings of relief vs Reading on 6/1.
- Often utilized as a multi-inning piggyback with RHP **Janson Junk** in his time with Somerset.
- Allowed leadoff home runs on the second pitch of the game in back-to-back games vs Buffalo (Otto Lopez) and Rochester (Victor Robles) on 9/4 (1) and 9/9 (1), respectively.

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- Full name is John Patrick Sears Jr.
- Acquired by the Yankees from the Seattle Mariners along with RHP **Juan Then** in exchange for RHP **Nick Rumbelow** on 11/18/17.
- Was originally selected by Seattle in the 11th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft.
- His 2018 season with Charleston was cut short due to a shoulder injury thought at first to be a torn labrum, but turned out to not serious damage.
- In three seasons at The Citadel (S.C.), had a 17-15 record and 3.98 ERA (253.0IP, 232H, 125R/112ER, 87BB, 317K) in 46 career appearances (42 starts)...as a junior in 2017, was named the Southern Conference Pitcher of the Year and a Golden Spikes Award semifinalist after going 7-3 with a 2.64 ERA (95.1IP, 69H, 28ER, 27BB, 142K) in 14 starts.
- Ranked fifth in the nation in strikeouts and third in K/9.0IP ratio (13.41).
- Earned 2017 All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball (second team), Baseball America (third team), the ABCA (third team), the NCBWA (third team) and D1Baseball.com (third team)...on 3/24/17 vs. VMI, tied a school record with 20K in a two-hit shutout.
- Graduated from Wilson Hall H.S. (S.C.) in 2014, was named the 2014 SCISA Class 3A Player of the Year.
- Also starred as a defensive back on Wilson Hall's 2013 SCISA Class 3A State Championship football team.
