LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones earned a series split with a 7-0 victory at Jersey Shore on Sunday afternoon...RHPs Kade Morris (4.1IP), Jake Stevenson (1.2), Jimmy Loper (2.0), and Brett Banks (1.0) combined on a two-hit shutout...The Cyclones did not allow a hit from two out in the fourth inning on... Brooklyn blasted a trio of solo home runs...DH Wilfredo Lara, CF Stanley Consuegra, and 2B Mateo Gil powered round-trippers in the fourth, fifth, and sixth innings, respectively...Consuegra, Lara, C Christian Pregent, and RF Karell Paz all tallied multi-hit games...Consuegra and SS William Lugo provided multi-RBI efforts...All nine in Brooklyn's starting lineup reached base at least once with eight of the nine collecting at least one hit.

NECK AND NECK DOWN THE STRETCH: Including Tuesday, 15 games remain in the First Half of the South Atlantic League season...The Cyclones are currently in sole possession of third in the North Division...Brooklyn is 2.5 games back of first-place Greensboro...The Grasshoppers hold the lead in the division even though they will not play an in-division opponent until this week when the Jersey Shore BlueClaws travel to North Carolina...So far, Greensboro has played just six games against teams with a record of .500 or better, holding a 2-4 mark.

EL TROLL RETURNS: C Francisco Alvarez joins Brooklyn on Tuesday to continue his Major League rehab assignment...The 22-year-old joined Double-A Binghamton last week and appeared in three contests for the Rumble Ponies, going 2-for-8 at the plate with two runs scored, a home run, and three RBI... Alvarez has been on the New York Mets' 10-day injured list since April 20 with a left thumb sprain...As a member of the Cyclones in 2021, he set a then-franchise record with 22 home runs in 84 games...That mark is second-most in a single season in Brooklyn franchise history behind OF Stanley Consuegra's 23 in 2023...His 58 RBI in 2021 is the third-most in a single season behind Consuegra (63) in 2023 and INF Ronny Mauricio in 2021...Alvarez's .538 slugging percentage and .889 OPS rank fourth and sixth in Cyclones' single-season history...With the Mets in 2023, Alvarez (25) joined former Brooklyn IB Pete Alonso (53, 2019) and OF Darryl Strawberry (26, 1983) as the only rookies in franchise history to hit 20+ home runs in a season...C Austin Allen has also joined Brooklyn from the Florida Complex League on a minor league rehab assignment...The 30-year-old signed with New York as a minor league free agent on January 16 and has appeared in 57 Major League games between the San Diego Padres and Oakland Athletics, hitting .195 (23-118) with two home runs.

SHUT OUT THE LIGHTS: The Cyclones' pitching staff earned its sixth shutout victory of the season in Sunday's 7-0 triumph at Jersey Shore...Brooklyn's blanking of the BlueClaws marked the team's first shutout since May 4's 4-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones also shut out the IronBirds, 2-0, on May 3 for back-to-back scoreless efforts...The six shutouts are tied for second most in the South Atlantic League and seventh most in Minor League Baseball...In 2023, the Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts.

MARVELOUS MORABITO: OF Nick Morabito has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The 21-year-old tied a career-high with four hits and matched a season-best with three runs batted in during last Tuesday's series opener at Jersey Shore, and followed it up with a home run to lead off the ballgame on Wednesday...Morabito is the first Cyclone to accrue a four-hit night since 3B Jacob Reimer went 4-for-5 on August 17, 2023, vs. Hudson Valley...The feat occurred six times for the Cyclones in 2023, including 2B Chase Estep's 4-for-5 day on June 4 at Jersey Shore...Morabito is the first Cyclone to register 4+ hits, 3+ RBI, and at least one home run in a single game 3B William Lugo was 4-for-6 with four runs scored, four RBI, and a three-run homer on August 28, 2022, at Jersey Shore...The last three Brooklyn players to achieve that line in one game have accomplished it at ShoreTown Ballpark... CF Alex Ramirez (4x5, 1 HR, 5 RBI) did it, as well, on July 22, 2022...Morabito is fifth in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.472)...He is also tied for sixth in batting average (.350) and tied for 10th in stolen bases (25)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is third in the league lead in steals (14) and runs scored (20).

CROWN HIMI: In last Wednesday's win over Jersey Shore, OF Stanley Consuegra's RBI double in the fourth inning made him the new Cyclones all-time hits leader (171), breaking a tie with OF Alex Ramírez...The 23-year-old is atop the Cyclones' ranks in numerous other offensive categories as well, including extra-base hits (78), home runs (35), and RBI (113)...He is also one double (37) from matching Ramírez's franchise mark (38)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C Francisco Alvarez for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.

SUPER STANLEY: Not only did OF Stanley Consuegra set the franchise hit record last Wednesday afternoon, the 23-year-old is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...Consuegra is on a six-game hitting streak and has a hit in 13 of his last 14 games since May 17 at Bowling Green. During that time, he's hitting .327/.441/.796 with a 1.237 OPS during that time...The Dominican native has scored 12 runs and added five doubles, six home runs, and 12 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 50 points (.171 to .221) and his OPS by 230 points (.519 to .749) during the stretch.

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn returns home for a six-game series against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...Aberdeen possess six of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. (5), INF Mac Horvath (11), LHP Luis De León (17), RHP Jackson Baumeister (18), RHP Carter Baumler (28), and C Creed Willems (29)...The Cyclones captured the first meeting at Maimonides Park, winning 4-of-6...In 2023, Brooklyn went 7-5 against Aberdeen on Coney Island and 3-3 at Leidos Field...Dating back to 2002, Brooklyn leads the all-time series since 2021, 130-115 (.531).

BUZZIN' ON THE BOARDWALK: INF Wilfredo Lara and C Chris Suero are heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...In his last 13 games since May 19, Lara is hitting .304/.385/.500 with an .885 OPS, adding a double, a triple, two home runs, and seven RBI...Suero enters Tuesday on a 11-game on-base streak since May 17...The 20-year-old has posted a .270/.413/.351 line with an .764 OPS, adding 10 runs scored, a home run, five RBI and eight walks.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF Nick Lorusso has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...Amongst South Atlantic League batters, Lorusso tied for third in triples (3), eighth in slugging (.500) and RBI (27), tied for ninth in extra-base hits (19), and 10th in OPS (.859)...The Connecticut native saw his season high II-game hitting streak come to an end in last Friday's loss...During the streak the ninth-round selection slashed .318/.423/.659/1.082... In that time, Lorusso added a double, a triple, four home runs, and eight RBI...The II-game hit streak was the longest for a Cyclone in 2024 and the best since INF Jett Williams hit in 12-straight contests from August 12-25, 2023.

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.88...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.48 runs better than the next team (Aberdeen; 3.36)...That ERA is also third at the High-A level and sixth among full-season MiLB squads...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro holds the best mark in the minors and the level (2.28).

HOME COOKING: The Cyclones enter play on Saturday with a 16-8 record at Maimonides Park, but a 11-16 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn is a perfect 4-0 in home series...The 'Clones haven't lost a home series since Hudson Valley took four of six from August 15-20, 2023...Brooklyn holds the sixthebest home ERA (2.62) in Minor League Baseball...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro (2.27) has the lowest mark at the High-A level, while Texas' Single-A Down East leads MILB (2.16)...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.80.

CLEAN SWEEP: Brooklyn dominated the weekly South Atlantic League Awards, taking home a pair of accolades thanks to two individual performances against Hudson Valley...LHP Felipe De La Cruz grabbed SAL Pitcher of the Week, while INF Nick Lorusso was named the SAL Player of the Week for the Week of May 21-26...De La Cruz, who just celebrated his 23rd birthday on Sunday, logged a career-high 13 strikeouts over six shutout innings...He walked only one batter while surrendering only two hits...He is the first Brooklyn pitcher to receive the honor since RHP Luis Moreno from July 26-31, 2022...On the other hand, Lorusso logged multi-hit games in three of four games played in the series...The 23-year-old slashed a stellar .500/.588/1.286 with a whopping 1.874 OPS...He clobbered a triple and three home runs, two of which came last Thursday...Lorusso is the first Cyclone to win Player of the Week since OF Stanley Consuegra from April 10-16, 2023...The sweep of weekly league awards is the first for the Cyclones since moving to the full-season level in 2021...LHP Gunnar Kines and OF José Miguel Medina were the last to accomplish the feat, winning New York-Penn League Pitcher and Player of the Week, respectively, for July 10-16, 2017.

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 11 marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has recorded a mark of 1,009-852 (,542) in 1,861 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 211-221 (,488) in 432 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP Josh Hejka earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with Hunter Parsons (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 56 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.46 ERA (25 ER in 91.1 IP) and 5 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 79.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: Kade Morris (21), Jonah Tong (22) and Calvin Ziegler (29)... Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), Wilfredo Lara (24), and OF Nick Morabito (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in his first professional start last Wednesday afternoon at Jersey Shore...Surrendered two runs on four hits over a career-high-tying 4.0 innings...Surrendered two runs on three hits through his first three batters faced...Did not allow a run on one hit over final 14 hitters...Walked one and matched a career-best with five strikeouts...Tossed a career-high 54 pitches and 38 strikes (70.37%)...Relieved by RHP **Jeffrey Colón** to start the bottom of the fifth with Brooklyn leading 4-2...Cyclones went on to defeat the BlueClaws, 5-2.

BIRDMAN BIRDMAN: Prior to joining the rotation, Hawkins impressed in a relief role...Among South Atlantic League relievers, the 24-year-old was sixth in strikeouts (34) and tied for sixth in innings pitched (24.2) prior to his first start...He was also first in ground ball rate (62.1%) and swinging strike rate (19.7%), second in strikeout rate (33.0%) and FIP (1.88), fourth in strikeout-to-walk rate (24.3%), seventh in walk rate (8.7%).

**2023:** Signed with the New York Mets as an undrafted free agent out of Washington State University on July 19, 2023...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 11...Made a pair of scoreless relief appearances before being transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 26...Did not allow a run on two hits over 6.0 innings with the Mets...Struck out seven without issuing a walk.

I REMEMBER YOU!: Playing collegiate summer ball in 2021 with the St. Cloud (Minn.) Rox of the Northwoods League, Hawkins was a teammate of Jersey Shore infielder Otto Kemp...The Rox won the Great Plains West Division with a 50-18 record and reached the Northwoods League Finals before falling to the Traverse City (Mich.) Pit Spitters...Other members of the St. Cloud squad included former BlueClaws C Caleb Ricketts (2023), former Wilmington Blue Rocks OF Andrew Pinckney (2023), as well as current Asheville Tourists INF Brice Matthews and Blue Rocks RHP Riley Cornelio.

**WAZZOU WIZARD:** The Chehalis, Wash. native had an outstanding career at Washington State University...After starting his collegiate tenure with two years at Lower Columbia College (Longview, Wash.), Hawkins went on to be named All-PAC 12 Honorable Mention in 2023...In 14 starts, he accrued a 5-3 record with a 4.32 ERA (35 ER in 73.0 IP) with 27 walks and 92 strikeouts... His 92 K's were fourth in the conference and ninthmost in a single-season at Washington State.
