

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On July 20, 2006, the Cyclones and the Oneonta Tigers played the longest game in New York-Penn League history...The 26-inning, six-hour, and 40-minute contest ends with Oneonta scoring five runs in the top of the 26th off of Brooklyn OF Mark Wright, who was called in to toss when the Cyclones ran out of pitchers in the 6-I defeat...In 2014, RHP Corey Oswalt (7.0 IP) and RHP Scarlyn Reyes (2.0) combined on a two-hit shutout in a 6-0 win vs. Williamsport...In 2015, after C Brandon Brosher tied the game in the eighth with a three-run home run, DH Jeff Diehl provided the walk-off sacrifice fly in the bottom of the ninth in a 5-4 win vs. Vermont...In 2023, in a 4-3 win at Hudson Valley, RHP Blade Tidwell struck out four batters over 6.1 innings to break the Cyclones' single-season strikeout record with 107, surpassing RHP Junior Santos' previous mark of 105 from a year prior...Tidwell would finish with 112 K's before joining Double-A Binghamton on July 31.

SO, YOU'RE TELLING ME THERE'S A CHANCE?: Brooklyn used an unlikely five-run top half of the ninth inning to tie and eventually walked off Jersey Shore on Friday night... After CF Nick Morabito led off the frame with a single, RHP Estibenzon Jiménez retired the next two batters to get the 'Clones down to their final out...3B Junior Tilien drew a two-out walk before 1B Kellum Clark spoiled the shutout on a bloop single to right field...Following a run-scoring wild pitch, LF Karell Paz kept the line moving, with an RBI single on a grounder through the left side to trim Brooklyn's deficit to two runs... RF Omar De Los Santos smashed a game-tying two-run shot that stayed fair down the left field line...Entering play on Friday, Brooklyn had only scored 19 runs in the ninth inning all season...The five-run frame marked the Cyclones' biggest ninth inning offensively since scoring six in the top of the ninth on June 4, 2022, to erase a 4-2 deficit in an 8-4 win at Jersey Shore...The walk-off win was the Cyclones' second of the season and first since Nick Lorusso's game-ending home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Asheville on April 14. 'TALK 2 'EM: RHP Kade Morris has started to find his stride at the High-A level...Since his start on June 21 vs. Jersey Shore, the 22-year-old holds a 2-1 record with a sparkling 1.85 ERA (5 ER in 24.1P) in four appearances (three starts)...He has yielded just 15 hits and 10 walks (10.2 BBs)) while striking out 21 (21.4 K%)...Since June 20, Morris and RHP Jonah Tong have been two of the best arms in the South Atlantic League...In that span, Tong is fourth in the circuit in ERA (1.75) and Morris (1.85) is fifth...Additionally, Kade is fourth in battling average against (174), seventh in innings pitched (24.1), and eighth in WHIP (1.03)... Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is third in the league in innings pitched (48.0), fifth in battling average against (.219), eighth in WHIP (1.21), and 10th in ERA (3.56).

SHUT IT: Brooklyn is no stranger to tossing shutouts as of late...The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season in last Sunday's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record... The 11 shutouts are two behind Rome (13) for the most in the South Atlantic League... The Cyclones are also tied for third in all of Minor League Baseball in shutouts...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Over his last five starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-1 with a 1.75 ERA (5 ER in 25.2 IP), allowing only 14 hits and seven walks, while striking out 36 ...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native has led the circuit in strikeouts (74)...He is also second in batting average against (.203), third in ERA (3.14) and WHIP (1.19), and seventh in innings pitched (57.1)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.10), fourth in strikeout rate (35.4%), and sixth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.0%) and strikeouts (110).

IAKING KELLUM 123: OF Kellum Clark snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since... The 23-year-old had a four-game multi-hit streak snapped last Saturday but has five multi-hit efforts in his last six games...Since July 6, he is 11-for-22 (.500) with four runs scored, a double, two RBI, and two walks...Clark had just one multi-hit game in the first 48 contests...In 10 games during July, the Brandon, Miss. native is hitting 375/.487/.406 with a .893 OPS...His .487 on-base percentage is third in the South Atlantic League during the month. TAKING KELLUM 123: OF Kellum Clark snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn opens a nine-game homestand with three contests against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws boast three of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF Aidan Miller (2), INF William Bergolla (11), OF Emaarion Boyd (16), OF Hendry Mendez (22), and RHP George Klassen (28)... INF Bryan Rincon (7) is on the 7-day injured list...The Cyclones split both series played in 2024 at ShoreTown Rallbark, going 6-6 in 12 contests. Brooklyn does not re-Ballpark, going 6-6 in 12 contests... Brooklyn does not return to Jersey Shore in the 2024 regular season, hosting the final 15 meetings...Through six games, Jersey Shore leads the series at Maimonides Park, 4-2... Dating back to 2021, Brooklyn leads the all-time series, 55-47 (.539).

WIZARD OF PAZ: OF Karell Paz is in the midst of one of his best offensive stretches of the 2024 season...Since clubbing a go-ahead two-run home run in the ninth inning on June 30 at Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is hitting .359/.457/.564 with a 1.021 OPS in 13 games...Paz has scored five runs and picked up three doubles, a home run, six runs batted in, six walks, and seven stolen bases...Since that date, Paz is tied for third in the South Atlantic League in stolen bases (7), fourth in onbase percentage (.457), fifth in batting average (.359), and eighth in OPS (1.021).

TRAVELING CIRCUS: Starting with the June 25 game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones have just six home games in 28 days...Brooklyn's next full six-game home series will take place from July 23-28 vs. Rome...So far, Brooklyn is 5-12 in the stretch... The Cyclones played three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and will play another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 1-9-21 immediately following the All-Star break...The stretch also includes a 12-day run without a day off (June 25-July 6), the longest of the season for Brooklyn.

MORABITO FUEL: OF Nick Morabito has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 21-year-old is 12th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (38)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito is tied for the league lead in hits (64), tied for third in stolen bases (27), and tied for fifth in runs scored (40)...On the year, the former second-round selection is tied for eighth in the SAL in stolen bases (27)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.309) and stolen bases (38)...He is also first in on-base percentage (.406), second in hits (95) and runs scored (54), and tied for fourth in triples (3).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF Omar De Los Santos rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The speedster clobbered a game-tying two-run home run in the ninth inning with Brooklyn down to its final out to help complete a 5-0 comeback vs. Jersey Shore...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League with 31 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT Jaylen Palmer's (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (68) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (68) and is fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (140).

LOCATION, LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...OF Nick Morabito loves his time on the road...He is hitting .302/.385/.396 with a .781 OPS, adding two home runs, nine RBI, and 25 stolen bases in 36 road contests...He is seventh in the circuit in road batting average (.302) and, since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits (45) and stolen bases (25) in the circuit...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .238/.307/.275 line with a .582 OPS, three extra-base hits, two RBI, and two stolen bases over 19 games...INF Junior Tillen has thrived at Maimonides Park, posting a .310/.370/.451 mark with a .821 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 32 games... On the road, Tilien is hitting .171/.272/.243 with a .515 OPS, a home run, and nine runs batted in over 38 contests...C Chris Suero is hitting .246/.403/.421 with a .824 OPS, three home runs, and 12 RBI in 17 games on Coney Island...The 20-year-old is batting .170/.284/.250 with a .534 OPS, a home run, and 15 RBI in 33 affairs in visiting ballparks.

ONE-TWO MISSTEP: The Cyclones have struggled in games decided by one or two runs...Brooklyn is 6-15 in one-run games and 5-6 in two-run games for a combined record of 11-21 (.344)...The Cyclones hold a record 30-26 (.536) in games decided by three runs or more.

WALK-OFF WOES: Brooklyn's 3-2 loss at Wilmington last Friday night marked the team's seventh walk-off defeat of the season...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 17 walk-off losses, accumulating 15.32% of all defeats...Brooklyn has two walk-off wins this year on Chris Suero's RBI single in the 10th on Friday and Nick Lorusso's game-winning home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Asheville on April 14.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF Jesús Báez (9), RHP Jonah Tong (15), RHP Kade Morris (23), RHP Jack Wenninger (26), and Calvin Ziegler (29)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), Wilfredo Lara (24), and OF Nick Morabito (26).

2024: Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 20...Made seven appearances (six starts) in the Florida State League...Posted an 0-3 record with a 3.63 ERA (14 ER in 34.2 IP), 11 walks, and 38 strikeouts...Struck out a career-high nine over five innings in a loss at Bradenton on May 9...Tallied a career-best 7.0-shutout innings of work in his final start on May 15 at Palm Beach...Punched out 27 (28.13 K%) and walked five (5.21 BB%) in his final 22.0 innings in the circuit.

2023: Signed with the Mets as a third-round selection on July 15 for \$666,500... Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 17...Made one start on August 17 at the FCL Marlins...Allowed one unearned run on one hit in 1.0 inning...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 6...Made one start on September 7 vs. Daytona...Permitted one run on one hit over 2.1 innings...Walked two and struck out three...Returned to the FCL on September 8.
