**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn collected its second-consecutive shutout with a 4-0 triumph over Aberdeen on Saturday afternoon. RHP **Nolan McLean** set a new career-high with eight strikeouts over a career-high-tying five innings of work. RHP **Victor Castañeda** and RHP **Ben Simon** each tossed a pair of scoreless frames out of the bullpen to complete the five-hitter. The Cyclones scored the contest's only runs in the fifth on a bases-loaded hit-pitch of C **Christian Pregent** and a three-run triple by 3B **Wilfredo Lara**. 2B **Junior Tilién** extended his hitting streak to seven with a multi-hit game.

**COPA DE LA DIVERSIÓN:** In honor of Cinco de Mayo, the Cyclones will celebrate its first Copa de la Diversión (Fun Cup) game of the 2024 season. As part of the festivities, Brooklyn will play as an alternate identity: Los Jefes de Brooklyn. Jefes translates to "Bosses" in Spanish. In addition, the first 1,000 fans through the gates on Sunday will receive a Sugar Skull Bobblehead courtesy of Verizon.

**GOING BACK TO BACK:** The Cyclones shut out the IronBirds for the second-straight day with a 4-0 win on Saturday. RHP **Nolan McLean** (5.0 IP), RHP **Victor Castañeda** (2.0), and RHP **Ben Simon** (2.0) combined on a five-hitter. On Friday, RHP **Brandon Sproat** (5.0), RHP **Jeffrey Colón** (2.2), and RHP **Joey Lancellotti** (1.1) united to one-hit Aberdeen, 2-0. The back-to-back shutouts are the first for the Cyclones at the full-season level and the first since Brooklyn blanked the Connecticut Tigers on the road in both ends of a doubleheader on August 23, 2019. RHP **Michel Otañez** (4.1), RHP **Mitch Ragan** (1.2), and RHP **Josh Hejka** (1.0) united on a 4-0 win in Game 1, while RHP **Dan Goggin** (2.0), RHP **Hunter Parsons** (2.0), and RHP **Jared Biddy** (3.0) led the charge to a 5-0 victory in Game 2. It is also the first for Brooklyn in consecutive nine-inning games since August 21-22, 2014, vs. Staten Island and Tri-City. RHP **Daisuke Matsuzaka** (5.0), LHP **Brad Wieck** (2.0), LHP **Kelly Secrest** (1.0), and LHP **Shane Bay** (1.0) twirled the Clones to a 2-0 win over Staten Island in the first leg. RHP **Martines Arias** (5.0), RHP **Gaither Bumgardner** (2.0), and RHP **Cameron Griffin** (2.0) provided the zeroes in a 7-0 rout of Tri-City on the back end. Saturday's blanking marked the fifth of the season for Brooklyn's pitching staff. The five shutouts are the most in the South Atlantic League and tied for the most in all of Minor League Baseball. The Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts in 2023.

**YIPPEE KI-YAY:** TWP **Nolan McLean** continued his incredible start to his career on Saturday afternoon. The 22-year-old extended his scoreless inning streak to 13.0 straight by tossing five spotless frames on Saturday vs. Aberdeen, en route to his second victory. Over his last three starts, McLean is 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 13.0 IP), allowing just six hits and three walks (6.82 BB%), adding 16 strikeouts (36.36 K%). In addition to his success on the mound, McLean enters play on Sunday tied for 15th in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits with eight. However, the Willow Springs, N.C. has registered 25 fewer plate appearances (44) than any other player with 8+ extra-base knocks.

**COUNTDOWN TO 1K:** After Saturday's 4-0 win over Aberdeen, the Brooklyn Cyclones are now four wins shy of their 1,000th in franchise history. Brooklyn holds a record of 996-840 (542) in 1,836 games since 2001. Brooklyn captured its 900th victory in franchise history with a 6-5 triumph vs. Wilmington on August 14, 2022. Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown. Since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021, the Cyclones are 198-209 (.486) in 407 games.

**SWIPING THE TOP SPOT:** With a pair of stolen bases off the bench on Thursday afternoon, OF **Omar De Los Santos** (52) became the Cyclones' all-time stolen base king, breaking a tie with UT **Jaylen Palmer** (50). In 2023, the 24-year-old eclipsed INF **Walter Rasquín**'s (32) single-season stolen base record with 37 swipes. De Los Santos enters Saturday's contest 15-for-16 stealing bases to start the season. The 15 swipes are tied for second in the South Atlantic League and tied for eighth throughout the minors. Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is tied for sixth across the Minors for steals (122).

**THE TONG SONG:** RHP **Jonah Tong** joined Brooklyn's roster from Single-A St. Lucie on Monday and punched out seven batters against Aberdeen in his High-A debut on Thursday. In five appearances (three starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old was 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 23.2 IP). No pitcher in Minor League Baseball has thrown more innings this year without allowing an earned run. Entering play on Sunday, the Markham, Ont. native is second among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in strikeout rate (48.9%). Single-A Lynchburg's LHP **Matt Wilkinson** (50.5%) is first. Tong's 39.8% strikeout-to-walk rate is also second in MiLB to Wilkinson (40.7%). Tong's 43 strikeouts are good for fourth-most in the minors.

**GREAT SCOTT!** RHP **Christian Scott** made his Major League debut for the New York Mets on Saturday night at Tropicana Field against the Tampa Bay Rays. The 24-year-old became the 99th former Brooklyn Cyclone to appear in the big leagues and the first to debut in 2024. Scott went 6.2 innings and allowed one run on five hits, walking one, and striking out six. He is the fourth Met to toss 6.2+ innings and allow no more than one walk and one run in his Major League debut, joining RHP **Collin McHugh** (8/23/12), RHP **Masato Yoshii** (4/5/98), and LHP **Dick Rusteck** (6/10/66). In 12 outings (11 starts) with the Cyclones, the Florida native accrued a 1-0 record with a 3.00 ERA (15 ER in 45.0 IP) with 14 walks (7.53 BB%) and 52 strikeouts (27.96 K%).

**DOOGIE HOWSER:** RHP **Douglas Orellana** celebrated his 22nd birthday on Wednesday and continued his impressive pitching to start the year on Tuesday, hurling 4.1 scoreless innings in his first start of 2024, extending his scoreless innings streak to a season-high 9.1. Orellana began the year with 81 consecutive spotless frames out of the bullpen. Last Wednesday in relief, the 22-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced - striking out six - in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold. Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit. RHP **Benito Garcia** (8/12/23 vABD), RHP **Daison Acosta** (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP **Chris Schwinden** (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit.

**NICK THE STICK:** INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024. The Connecticut native reached base three times on Tuesday, adding a pair of extra-base hits and a career-high-tying three RBI. Lorusso is one of two Cyclones with a multi-extra-base hit contest in 2024 and the only one to accomplish the feat on multiple occasions. Coming into Saturday's contest, the 23-year-old is tied for second in the South At-

**vs. ABERDEEN:** Brooklyn continues its first two-week homestand of the season against the Orioles' High-A affiliate. The IronBirds possess six of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (6), INF **Mac Horvath** (11), RHP **Jackson Baumeister** (18), RHP **Juan Núñez** (26), RHP **Carter Baumler** (28), and C **Creed Willems** (29). In 18 meetings during the 2023 campaign, Brooklyn posted a 10-8 record against Aberdeen, including a 7-5 record at Maimonides Park. Since 2002, the Cyclones and IronBirds have met 244 times with Brooklyn leading the all-time series, 129-115 (.529).

lantic League in triples (2), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (10), doubles (6), and OPS (.925), tied for fifth in slugging (.537), eighth in batting average (.299), and tied for ninth in RBI (14).

**THE WIZARD OF OS:** C **Drake Osborn** has been unstoppable at the plate to start the 2024 season. The 25-year-old has collected an eye-popping .348 (16-46) with a .955 OPS, adding four doubles, a home run, and four RBI. Among players in the South Atlantic League with at least 55 plate appearances, the Corpus Christi, Texas native is tied for the circuit lead in on-base percentage (.455). He is also second in OPS (.955) and third in batting average (.348).

**FEAR THE HAWK:** RHP **Dakota Hawkins** continued his stellar start to his 2024 season on Thursday with four innings of shutout relief. Since one out in the bottom of the eighth on April 19 at Jersey Shore, the 24-year-old has not allowed a run. The 8.2-consecutive scoreless frames is the longest spotless stretch by a Brooklyn reliever this year. Among South Atlantic League relief arms, Hawkins is tied for fourth in strikeouts (23), seventh in strikeout-to-walk rate (1150), and tied for ninth in innings pitched (15.2).

**ATOP THE HEJ-ES:** With his scoreless relief outing on Wednesday night vs. Aberdeen, RHP **Josh Hejka** is now tied with RHP **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history. The 27-year-old broke a tie with LHP **Carlos Valdéz** (46) for second place on the all-time list in the contest. In his 47 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.74 ERA (23 ER in 75.2 IP) and three saves, walking just 17 and striking out 68.

**LONG ARM OF THE LAW:** RHP **Justin Lawson** has started his 2024 with a bang. The reliever yielded just one unearned run over 2.1 innings on Wednesday and notched a three-inning save in last Friday's shutout of Wilmington, good for his fourth of the season (and second that spanned three full innings). The former member of the NC. State Wolfpack is third in the circuit in saves (4). Among South Atlantic League relievers with at least 11.0 innings pitched, the 23-year-old has the lowest WHIP (0.35) and opposing OPS (.188) in the circuit and has permitted the fewest hits (2). He is also one of three relievers (Greenville's RHPs **Caleb Bolden** and **Jonathan Brand**) in the circuit to throw that many innings and not allow an earned run.

**KING STANLEY:** With his RBI double in the bottom of the first inning on Friday, OF **Stanley Consuegra** became the first player in Cyclones history to reach the century mark in RBI. The 23-year-old is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 67 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 100 RBI. On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23). Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville. The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

**SEVENTH HEAVEN:** The Cyclones' offense exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the first in Tuesday's 9-2 win vs. Aberdeen. They also accomplished the feat in the bottom of the third in a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington last Wednesday. Brooklyn had 10 consecutive batters reach base with one out in the inning. The seven-run frames are the largest for the Cyclones since they erupted for nine in the bottom of the second inning on July 27, 2023, vs. Wilmington, in an 11-7 triumph. The 13 runs for Brooklyn set a new season high. The Cyclones had not tallied that many in a single contest since a 13-12 win at Asheville in 10 innings on August 24, 2023. It was the first time Brooklyn scored 13+ in a nine-inning game dating back to an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022. Since 2005, the Cyclones' highwater mark for runs in a single inning is 10 in the top of the sixth of a 20-6 romp at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022. The 20 runs were also a franchise record.

**YOUTH IS SERVED:** **Gilbert Gómez** takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024. At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history. After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM). Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history. Gómez's younger brother, **Dariel**, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League. Older brother, **José**, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido. Older brother, **Héctor**, is a well-known baseball reporter. Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and *MLB Pipeline*. The Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 5), **Brandon Sproat** (11), **Nolan McLean** (15), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29). Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), and INF **Wilfredo Lara** (23). MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 87th-best farmhand in all of baseball.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took a no-decision in his first start of the season on Tuesday night vs. Aberdeen...Did not allow a run on three hits over 4.1 innings...Walked one and struck out three...Tossed a season-high 68 pitches and 46 strikes (67.6%)...Relieved by RHP **Jordany Ventura** with a runner at second and one out in the top of the fifth and Brooklyn leading 7-0...Bequeathed runner did not score...Aberdeen scored two in the ninth to break up the shutout, but the Cyclones emerged with a 9-2 win.

**CAN'T TOUCH THIS:** Orellana extended his scoreless innings streak to a season-high 9.1 innings with his shutout performance on Tuesday...He has surrendered just three hits and one walk, adding nine strikeouts, during the run... The 22-year-old started the season by tossing a bevy of zeroes too...The right-hander did not allow a run over his first two appearances and 8.1 innings...Orellana yielded only four hits and three walks in that span, while striking out eight.

**PIGGYBACK RIDE:** Orellana will make his second start of the 2024 season on Sunday after serving in a relief role through his first four appearances...The 21-year-old worked as a "piggybacker" off RHP **Noah Hall**...Hall was placed on Brooklyn's 7-day injured list on April 26.

**DOOGIE HOWSER:** Last Wednesday in relief, The 21-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced – striking out six – in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP **Benito García** (8/12/23 vABD), RHP **Daison Acosta** (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP **Chris Schwinden** (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit...Orellana is just the third Brooklyn pitcher in any capacity since 2005 to toss five or more innings without yielding a hit at all... However, the other two allowed a man to reach on a hit-by-pitch...LHP **Nelson Pereira** (5.0 IP) was the last to do it in a 2-1 win over 14 innings on August 15, 2010, at Williamsport.

**2023:** Orellana spent the entire 2023 season with current Brooklyn manager **Gilbert Gómez** and pitching coach **Dan McKinney** at Single-A St. Lucie...In his age 21 campaign, the right-hander made 23 appearances and 18 starts, tallying a 4-4 record and a 4.53 ERA (45 ER in 89.1 IP) with one save... Orellana issued 50 walks, but struck out 112 hitters...He finished fifth in the Florida State League in strikeouts and second on St. Lucie's roster behind LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** (114)...Orellana finished the season by being named the FSL's Pitcher of the Month for September...He permitted only two runs (one earned) on five hits in 10.2 innings, accruing two walks and 16 K's.
