FISHER CATS SWEEP IN DOUBLEHEADER: In the completion of Tuesday's suspended game, the Fisher Cats fell 6-4 despite multi-hit performances from Jordan Groshans, Otto Lopez, and Vinny Capra. Fitz Stadler and Mike Ellenbest worked three scoreless innings in relief, but the Fisher Cats were unable to push across the tying runs.

In game two, which was scheduled for seven innings, Hartford scored four runs in the top of the first, but the Fisher Cats responded with seven unanswered runs courtesy of a pair of Samad Taylor home runs. The Yard Goats would tie the game at seven in the top of the sixth, and the game went to extra innings. Hartford worked the eventual winning run home in the top of the ninth to complete the double-header sweep. Highlight performers from the day included Otto Lopez, who went 5-10 over the two games, and Jordan Groshans who went 4-7 with two doubles and three runs batted in.

MR. JUNE: Samad Taylor hit a double on the third pitch of game one, before socking a pair of homers in game two, extending his hit streak to a career-high 13 games. His eight home runs in the month of June is one away from tying the franchise record of nine long balls in a month. He currently leads the league in home runs, slugging, runs, stolen bases, and total bases, and trails only Gabriel Moreno in OPS.

ALL...ARMS ON DECK? The two teams combined to use 19 different pitchers over the course of yesterday's two games. Hartford used nine of their ten available bullpen arms, while the Fisher Cats used all but two of their potential relievers in a marathon evening of baseball which stretched for seven hours over the course of both games.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: June 17, 2012- The Fisher Cats needed 13 innings for a 4-3 win over the Baysox in Bowie, Md. New Hampshire needed eight scoreless innings from the bullpen in relief of starter Deck McGuire, who left trailing 3-2. The Fisher Cats tied the game in the ninth, scoring a run on a bases loaded grounder by Sean Ochinko. Ochinko also drove in the winning run in the 13th with a sacrifice fly, allowing pinch-runner Justin Jackson to score. Ryan Goins had the other two RBIs.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays dropped their third straight game by one run, losing 3-2 to the Yankees in Buffalo. Former Fisher Cat Patrick Murphy made his return from injury, making his season debut going for one scoreless inning. Buffalo only put up two hits, spoiling an excellent start from Nate Pearson, as the Bisons fell 2-0 to Rochester despite only allowing three hits on the day. Dunedin beat Clearwater 6-3 despite being out-hit nine to six. Vancouver hung on to defeat Everett, winning 4-3 after allowing one run to score in the top of the ninth.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats host Hartford (Colorado) for the first time this season this week, before getting their first taste of interdivisional play when they travel to Bowie to face the division-leading Baysox (Baltimore).

GAME TWO STARTERS: Johnny Barbatto gets his third start in a Fisher Cats jersey tonight. The MLB veteran has only allowed two earned runs in his 12.1 innings of work for New Hampshire this season. Barbatto went seven innings against Portland last Saturday, giving up just four hits and one run.

Opposite Barbatto, newly-promoted Ryan Feltner will get the start for Hartford. Feltner, a 2018 fourth-round pick from Ohio State, recorded three wins with an era of 2.17 for Advanced-A Spokane, also notching 45 strikeouts in 37.1 innings of work.
