JUMBO SHRIMP BLANKED AGAIN, 2-0

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp were shut out for the second consecutive game on Thursday in a 2-0 defeat to the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders at 121 Financial Ballpark. The game was scoreless until the top of the sixth inning for the second day in a row. Five consecutive RailRiders hits, capped by RBI singles from Luis Torrens and Josh VanMeter for what turned out to be the game's only runs. The Jumbo Shrimp mustered a season-low three hits and only advanced one runner to third base. Kyle Tyler tossed 4.0 shutout innings in a start.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 18 of Jacksonville's 30 games (60.0 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have excelled in these contests, going 12-6 (.667) in those closely-decided affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

TROY MEETS WORLD

Troy Johnston, the Miami Marlins Minor League Player of the Year in 2023, got off to a slow start this season. Through his first 16 games, the Puyallup, Wash., batted just .203/.292/.234/.526 with two doubles, six RBIs, four walks and three runs scored. In his last 14 games, however, Johnston is 19-for-55 at the plate, hitting .345/.390/.545/.935 with eight doubles, one home run, five RBIs, three walks and 10 runs scored.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 29 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered 131 runs (4.5 per game), a figure that ranks 25th in Triple-A in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 58-for-258 (.227/.326/.371/.697, ranking 29th, 27th, 25th and 28th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th at the Triple-A level.

BLANK SPACE

Jacksonville has not scored in 19 consecutive innings entering play on Friday, with the Jumbo Shrimp suffering back-to-back shutouts for the first time since May 26-27, 2021 against Durham. Over this current two-game stretch, Jacksonville has mustered only seven hits while getting only one runner to third base. The club is 7-for-60 (.117) at the plate without an extra-base hit.

ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Jonah Bride began the season with Miami, batting just 1-for-7 in five games before getting optioned to Jacksonville. Since coming to the First Coast, Bride is 28-for-82 (.341/.481/.707/1.188) with seven doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 15 RBIs, 19 walks and 14 runs scored. Bride leads the International League in OPS while ranking second in both on-base percentage and slugging percentage, seventh in batting average, tied for eighth in extra-base hits (15), tied for ninth in home runs, tied for 13th in walks (19) and tied for 23rd in hits (28).

IT IS HOW YOU START

Out of the club's 266.1 innings pitched thus far in 2024, Jacksonville starting pitchers have accounted for just 135.1 frames, a ratio of only 50.8 percent. That said, those 135.1 innings are the fourth-most in Triple-A for any starting rotation. Jumbo Shrimp starters have also provided quality in their innings. The club's starting rotation has posted the second-best batting average against (.236) and third-best ERA (3.92). Jacksonville starters have collectively ceded the 10th-fewest hits (120) and tied for the 11th-fewest walks (51). The Jumbo Shrimp's starting staff has yielded three runs or fewer in 14 of their last 15 games.

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In six games from April 5-14, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through an 0-for-20 stretch with seven strikeouts. In the 11 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 11-for-his-last-35, slashing .314/.455/.600/1.055 with a double, three home runs, five RBIs, eight walks, seven runs scored and only 12 punchouts. Conine has multiple hits in four of these last 11 contests, reaching base at least once in eight of those affairs.

ABOUT MAX

-Selected by the Marlins with the third overall pick of the 2020 draft, Meyer tied Hall of Famer Paul Molitor (No. 3 to the Milwaukee Brewers in 1977) as the highest pick in Minnesota Golden Gophers history. Meyer is one of four Minnesotans to be pick in the top five in the draft, along with Molitor, Joe Mauer and Dave Winfield. Prior to Meyer, the last time the Gophers had a pitcher taken in the first round of the MLB draft was left-hander Glen Perkins, who was selected 22nd overall by the Minnesota Twins in 2004.

-During his junior season at Minnesota in 2020, Meyer was tabbed as a consensus Preseason All-American and made four starts in a shortened season due to the pandemic. He finished fifth in the nation with 46 strikeouts and a team-best 1.95 ERA in 27.2 innings. Meyer has slashed .185/.214/.222 with one double, two runs scored, four RBIs and a stolen base while playing infield for the Gophers.

-As a sophomore in 2019, Meyer was named an All-Big Ten Second Team Selection. He made 16 appearances on the mound, including 11 starts, and went 5-3 with a 2.11 ERA and two saves 76.2 innings. He fanned a team-high 87 batters. Meyer also played in 35 games, including 30 starts, on the infield, batting .256/.323/.314 with four doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and 15 runs scored.

-A native of Woodbury, Minn., Meyer played hockey at Woodbury High School, lettering for three seasons as a forward. He was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 34th round of the 2017 draft, but opted to pitch collegiately at the University of Minnesota.

-Both of Max's parents, Kathy and Kent, played collegiately while attending St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.). Kent was a member of the Oles' football team while Kathy played on the school's women's soccer team.

2024 SEASON

-Optioned to Jacksonville on April 15.

2023 SEASON

-Did not pitch while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Meyer made his major league debut for the Marlins on July 16 by throwing 5.1 innings with five strikeouts in a game against the Philadelphia Phillies at loadDepot park. He made two starts before undergoing Tommy John surgery on August 9.

-Meyer needed just 53 pitches (38 strikes) to strike out eight in 5.0 perfect innings before departing with a calf cramp on April 12 at Durham.

2021 SEASON
