### WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

High-A Wilmington put together their second-straight win last night, beating Hudson Valley (NY) 5-2. **JACOB WALSH** went deep twice in the win, his second multi-homer game of the season (7/3 at HV) and second of his career.

**K** **KNIGHT NIGHT:** The Rochester Red Wings used a multi-run seventh and eighth inning to prevail over the Charlotte Knights, 5-2, on a beautiful Friday night in downtown Rochester...2B **LIDVER PEGUERO** turned in a 1-for-2 performance with a pair of RBI in his Red Wings debut...3B **TREY LIPSCOMB** also logged in a multi-RBI night, while Red Wings pitchers combined to only give up two runs while striking out 14 in the win...Rochester looks to make it back-to-back wins and guarantee at least a series split tonight, sending RHP **EDDY YEAN** to the mound to open things up against Charlotte right-hander David Sandlin...

**R** The Red Wings are now 23-5 against left-handed starters this season...they lead the International League with a .280 batting average, .372 OBP, .479 SLG, and .851 OPS vs. LHP while driving in the second-most runs (144).

**R** **EDDY, SET, GO:** Taking the mound as the starting pitcher for the first time since 9/13/2025 with Indianapolis will be RHP **EDDY YEAN**, the 25-year-old Dominican Republic native currently leads all International League pitchers and ranks third in Minor League baseball with 46 appearances this season...Yean has made a pair of scoreless appearances this week on both 8/11 & 8/12, tossing a combined 1.2 hitless innings with a pair of strikeouts and no walks...he has not allowed a run in nine consecutive appearances with the Red Wings and 15 of his last 16 with Rochester and Washington dating back to the start of July...over that stretch, the former Pittsburgh Pirates farmhand ranks second in professional baseball (min 20.0 IP, MLB & MiLB) with a .104 BAA, is T-2nd with a 0.55 WHIP, and is T-12th with a 0.90 ERA (2 ER/20.0 IP)...

**R** Since the start of 2022, Yean ranks second in MiLB with 226 total appearances, one spot behind teammate RHP **JACK SINCLAIR** (227).

**R** Nine consecutive scoreless outings is the second-longest by a Red Wing this season behind Julian Fernández (10 G, 4/4-5/7).

**R** **TREY FOR TREY:** 3B **TREY LIPSCOMB** led the offense for the Red Wings with a 3-for-4 night at the plate, highlighted by a two-RBI double in the bottom of the eighth inning...Friday night was his second three-hit performance in his last three games, marking the second time he's accomplished the feat this season (7/10-11)...since 8/2, the former Nats' third-rounder is riding an 11-game hitting streak, the second longest active streak in the International League, and the second longest by a Red Wing this season...over that stretch, Lipscomb leads all Triple-A batters in hits (20), runs scored (15), holds a share of the lead in RBI (15).

**R** **CHAMPLAIN POETRY:** RHP **CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN** twirled his seventh quality start of the season last night, allowing two earned on five hits while striking out five and walking one across 6.0 full innings of work...he now ranks third among all qualified International League pitchers with a 1.09 WHIP, fourth with 105.2 Innings pitched, sixth with a .243 BAA, and seventh with a 4.00 ERA (47 ER/105.2 IP)...since his professional career began in 2022, the California native holds a share of the Minor League-lead with 115 starts with RHP Casey Lawrence, and ranks second behind Lawrence with 606.0 Innings pitched...

**R** Seven QS are the most by a Red Wings starter in a single season since Logan Verrett in 2022 (9).

**R** **RING 'EM UP:** RHP **COLE HENRY** took over on the mound for RHP **CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN** last night, and turned in 1.1 scoreless innings of work on one hit with five strikeouts...four of those strikeouts came in the seventh after a passed ball on a swinging strike three extended the inning, making him the Red Wings first pitcher to strike out four batters in one inning at ESL Ballpark since at least 2004...three other Rochester pitchers have done so on the road over the last 20-plus seasons, most recently RHP Logan Verrett in the second inning on 5/12/2022 at WOR...the last reliever to do so was Anthony Slama in the eighth inning on 9/1/2009 at BUF...RHP **BUS VARLAND** came on in the ninth and earned his second save as a Red Wing while striking out three, becoming the only Red Wing this season to strike out the side in the ninth inning multiple times (7/11 at WOR)...since coming back from the All-Star break on 7/17, Rochester relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens and rank third in MiLB with 160 strikeouts...

**R** Nine strikeouts are the most by Red Wings relievers in 3.0 Innings of work or fewer since at least 2004...they have struck out eight three other times (9/4/21 vs. WOR, 5/7/18 at BUF, 5/17/16 at CLT).

**R** **GONE STREAKIN':** The eighth inning saw LF **PHILLIP GLASSER** reach base after being hit by a pitch, and later score a run off a two-RBI double from **TREY LIPSCOMB**...it marked the 21st consecutive game Glasser has reached base safely, maintaining his share of the seventh-longest active on-base streak in the International League, and surpassing teammate Andrew Pinckney for the longest by a Red Wing this season.

**R** **THE KING EATS FIRST:** SS **SEAVER KING** wasted no time putting the Wings on the board with a first-inning lead-off home run, while also adding a third-inning single to his stat line...the Nats' 2024 first-rounder now has hits in each of his last six games since 8/8, with five of those being multi-hit performances...during that span, King leads the International League in hits (12) and runs scored (9), with teammate **TREY LIPSCOMB** one shy of him in both categories...he also ranks second in batting average (.480), slugging percentage (.880), and holds a share of second alongside Lipscomb in total bases (22).

**R** **GAME LI-OVER:** In just his second at-bat as a Red Wing last night, 2B **LIDVER PEGUERO** connected on a 2-RBI single in the bottom of the seventh to put Rochester ahead, 3-2, beginning their streak of four unanswered runs to headline a 5-2 victory over CLT...the righty was assigned to the team on 8/14 after appearing in 67 games with LHV, closing out his tenure with the IronPigs by accounting for a hit in four of his last six games...between ROC and LHV this season, Peguero is now hitting .312 (34-for-109) in 33 home games...he is the 68th player to suit up for the Red Wings in 2026.
