TODAY'S GAMES: The Space Cowboys continue their first ever trip to Salt Lake in a six-game series against the Bees with the current series tied a 1-1... In mid-May, Sugar Land won 4 of 6 games against the Bees.

ABOUT WEDNESDAY NIGHT: Salt Lake scored six in the bottom of the 1st, including four on a grand slam by Jack Lopez... David Hensley hit a solo home run in the 2nd and Quincy Hamilton hit a two-run homer in the 6th to bring the Space Cowboys within four at 7-3... Sugar Land loaded the bases in the top of the 8th and got a run on a sac fly by Hamilton, but left the bases loaded as RHP Zack Weiss locked down a five-out save for the Bees.

ROSTER MOVES: 6/22 - C Cesar Salazar optioned to Sugar Land... 6/20 - INF Rylan Bannon activated from the IL... OF Marty Costes activated from the IL... 6/19 - OF Alex McKenna placed on the Development List... RHP Tyler Brown transferred to Corpus Christi.

HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's active roster has 11 players drafted by the Astros, 4 international signings and 2 player signed as non-drafted free agents in the five-round 2020 MLB Draft.

PROSPECTING: The Space Cowboys active roster boasts six of the Astros' Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline. They include C Korey Lee (#5), OF Pedro León (#6), OF Justin Dirden (#7), RHP Misael Tamrez (#11), INF Joe Perez (#14), & OF Quincy Hamilton (#22)

SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING: Sugar Land is 4-6-0 in six-game series this year, 0-1 in seven-game series and 1-0 in three-game series... The Space Cowboys have gone 2-1-0 in their last three home series and 2-3-0 overall at Constellation Field.

POWER SURGE: Since the start of their six-game series in Albuquerque on 6/6, the Space Cowboys have homered in 14 consecutive games, their longest consecutive streak with a homer this season... In that span, Sugar Land has hit 33 homers, the most in the PCL... 33 of Sugar Land's 123 hits have been home runs in the last 14 games, accounting for 26.8% of their hits.

ON THE RECORD: RHP Joe Record locked down his 10th save on Tuesday night, throwing a 1-2-3 ninth... Record in tied for fifth in MiLB in saves with 10, and since he logged his first save on May 4, Record's 10 saves lead Minor League Baseball (next closest - 7)... In 23 of his 28 appearances, Record has not allowed an earned run this year...His 10 saves are the second most in the PCL, and Record is tied for the league-lead in appearances in the Pacific Coast League with 28.

JUNE FOR JOE: In 15 games in the month of June, INF/ OF Joe Perez is slashing .333/.453/.608/1.061 with a triple, 4 home runs, 10 RBI, 13 R and 12 walks... Perez is currently riding a 9-game on-base streak in which he is 9-for-28 (.321) with a .487 OBP and has walked 10 times while striking out just 8.

GOTTA HAVE MORE THAN ONE: The Space Cowboys have recorded at least one extra-base hit in 64 straight games, currently the second-longest streak in MiLB behind the El Paso Chihuahuas (71).

to spark the comeback in the 7th on Tuesday night... All told, Whitcomb has homered in six of his first 14 contests, accounting for 15 RBI. Whitcomb now has 18 home runs between Double-A

WHIT-BOMB: Shay Whitcomb has brought his power

to the Space Cowboys, launching a three-run blast

and Triple-A, tied for the third most home runs in MiLB (Jo Adell - 20, 2 Players with 19, 9 players, including Whitcomb, with 18).

The Space Cowbovs infielder is also leading the way in the Astros' organization in home runs, RBI (51), extra-base hits (30) & total bases (130), is second in runs scored (47), and third in hits (64).

WHAT'S YOUR NAME, MAN?: In his Triple-A debut on 6/7, Quincy Hamilton homered in each of his first two times up, launching an opposite-field homer to left in the 2nd and a solo home run to right in the 4th... Hamilton provided an encore on 6/8, hitting a solo home run in the 7th inning, and homered for a third straight game on 6/10 with a solo shot in the 8th.

The outfielder homered on Wednesday night against Salt Lake, part of a three-RBI day... Including his final game with Double-A Corpus, Hamilton has gone deep in 8 of his last 17 contests.

GOT 'EM!: C Korey Lee threw out a pair of base runners in the Space Cowboys six-game series against the River Cats, giving him 16 caught stealing on the season, tied for the most in the Pacific Coast League with Ricardo Genoves of Sacramento... Lee is already just one caught stealing shy of his total from 2022, when he had 17 caught stealing in 62 total attempts.

THRIVING IN THIN AIR: The Space Cowboys bats have loved playing at elevation (3,500 ft.+) hitting .307 with an .552 SLG%, banging 56 doubles, 12 3B, 43 HR and scoring 180 runs in just 23 games... For comparison, in the Space Cowboys other 48 games, they are hitting .229 with a .337 SLG %, hitting 60 doubles, 11 triples, 49 home runs and scoring 219 runs.

WHAT A WEEK: The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. Here is how their offensive output ranked compared to every other single-week high among full season MiLB teams.

RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ: On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a 24-8 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) & at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN: Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on 5/4 against ABQ, going 4-for-5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: In the seventh inning on 5/5 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 & 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

MATIJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5-for-6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on 5/7, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as "Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV. Garrett Greene begins his first year as the 'Voice of the Space Cowboys' and will be on the call for all game, home and away. He'll be joined by longtime Houston area broadcaster Gerald Sanchez for home games.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

TO INFINITY AND BEYOND: Key elements of the Space Cowboys brand include the Mission Patch, Horizon Gradient and Primary Space Cowboys Logo.

- **Primary Logo:** The primary logo features the Space Cowboy donning a traditional cowboy hat, a bandanna and a blast shield over his face that is peppered with space dust and has a starburst at the eye.
- Horizon Gradient: Inspired by a shot of the horizon of the earth from space, the color palette and gradient
 feature light blue, navy, orange, gray and black notes that are prominent in the franchise's logo and uniforms.
 The colors represent the ever-expanding Sugar Land community and an exciting new chapter on the horizon
- Mission Patch: This patch will be featured on all three uniforms and serves as an alternate logo. It intertwines elements from the Texas state flag, with a rocket superimposed over the front ready to launch.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

REST OF THE CREM: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

LAST TIME OUT: Got the start on Friday night at Constellation Field... Allowed a run in the second, a run in the third and two in the fourth... Tied a season high with 5.0 innings pitched... Received just one run of support as Sugar Land was held without a hit through the first 4.0 innings in a 5-3 defeat.

NEW TO THIS: Garcia made 126 appearances in the Minors and 72 appearances in the Major Leagues before making his first career start on 7/10/22 @ Omaha... Today is just his 24th career start.

IN SPRING: Made 5 appearances for the Astros, one start... Went 1-0, 1.64 ERA... In 11.0 IP, allowed two runs on six hits with five walks and eight strikeouts... Made his only start of Spring Training on 3/15 @ Atlanta, earned the win while throwing 3.0 shutout innings.

WELCOME TO HOUSTON: Garcia signed with the Astros as a free agent on 2/7/23... Elected free agency from the Tigers on 11/11/22.

DON'T I KNOW YOU?: In 2021 with the Tigers, Garcia earned a save on April 14 at Minute Maid Park. The right-hander entered the game in the ninth inning with the bases loaded, no one out and the tying run at first. The rigthy allowed just one runner to score as he secured the save, the first Tigers' pitcher to inherit three base runners and earn a save in the same game since Francisco Rodriguez in April of 2017.

ROOKIE IMPRESSIONS: After debuting in 2019 with Detroit, Garcia spent all of 2020 with the Tigers, making 26 appearances. He recorded four saves and did allow an inherited runner to score, the first Tigers rookie to recorded more than two saves in a season since 2003. He earned his first Major League save on 9/6/20 @ Minnesota.

MISSED TIME: Did not pitch in the 2018 and didn't debut until May of 2019 while recovering from right elbow surgery.

NO RUNS FOR YOU: Pitched across four levels in 2017 and put together a 24.2 scoreless innings streak from April 29 through July 2... During that stretch, went 2-0 with 8 saves and 41 strikeouts

ROCK YOU LIKE A HURRICANE: Drafted in the 6th round of the 2016 draft by the Detroit Tigers out of the University of Miami. While at Miami, converted 43 saves, the most in school history and tied for the most in ACC history. In 2016, was named the NCBWA Stopper of the Year after going 2-0 with 18 saves and a 1.89 ERA in 35 appearances.
