JUMBO SHRIMP BLANKED 10-0 TO STRIPERS

Following a close Saturday night loss, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp were bested in Sunday's rubber match 10-0 against the Gwinnett Stripers at 121 Financial Ballpark. Making his first rehab start with Jacksonville, **Edward Cabrera** tossed three scoreless innings but struggled walking four and striking out just two. After blanking Gwinnett through the first four, the Stripers broke the game open with five runs in the fifth and five more in the seventh. Jacksonville was shut out for the first time in 2024.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through three games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only six runs, in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 3-for-28 (.107/.212/.143/.355) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 21 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Daren Brown returns in 2024 as Jacksonville's manager for the third straight season. A native of Holdenville, Okla., Brown holds a 1,282-1,271 (.502) record as a minor league manager. In 2022, Brown's first season with Jacksonville, he piloted the Jumbo Shrimp to an 80-69 (.537) record, placing third in the IL East. Brown also juggled a franchise-record 79 players in 2022, including a Jacksonville high for starting pitchers (25). The Jumbo Shrimp followed that up with a 70-79 (.470) record in 2023, with Brown utilizing a franchise-record 44 different pitchers throughout the campaign.

MOVIN' OUT (ANTHONY'S SONG)

Along with Jeff Lindgren, Devin Smeltzer and Eli Villalobos, Anthony Maldonado is returning to the Jumbo Shrimp roster in 2024. The Wellington, Fla., native is coming off a dominate 2023 campaign. Among the 247 pitchers who logged at least 40.0 IP in the International League in 2023, Maldonado ranked first in ERA (1.76), K% (39.4%), K-BB% (27.8%) and SwStr% (21.4%), fourth in xFIP (3.53) and ninth in FIP (3.40). Overall, Maldonado was 7-3 with a 1.76 ERA across 34 games (46.0 IP, 23 H, 21 BB, 71 K).

TROY MEETS WORLD

Jumbo Shrimp first baseman **Troy Johnston** is coming off an extraordinary season that saw him earn Marlins Minor League Player of the Year. Johnston finished the season leading all of Minor League Baseball in RBIs (116) while ranking fourth in extra-base hits (67), ninth in hits (157), tied for 10th in runs (102), 13th in OPS (.948), tied for 15th in doubles (36) and 17th in slugging percentage (.549). Over 134 games between Jacksonville and Double-Pensacola, Johnston slashed .307/.399/.549/.948 with 26 home runs and 24 stolen bases, becoming the first Marlins minor leaguer since 2008 to post a season with at least 20 homers and 20 steals.

DANE TIME

Originally selected by the Detroit Tigers as a pitcher back in 2017, **Dane Myers** converted to a full-time position player in 2021. The Katy, Texas native batted .292/.371/.442/.813 in 45 games in 2021 and then .267/.315/.489/.804 between Double-A Erie and Triple-A Toledo in 2022 before the Marlins selected him in the minor league phase of that winter's Rule 5 draft. In 2023, Myers unlocked a new level, hitting .316/.406/.489/.895 between Jacksonville and Double-A Pensacola while also making his major league debut with Miami. In Spring Training entering this season, Myers hit .412/.474/.735/1.209 with two doubles, three home runs, five RBIs, four stolen bases and seven runs scored in 17 games.

BACK TO WINNING PLEASE?

Thanks to a 75-55 (.577) record in 2021 and an 80-69 (.537) mark in 2022, Jacksonville collected back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 2013-14. In 2023, though, the Jumbo Shrimp finished just 70-79 (.470) to snap their run of winning records. Jacksonville finished the first half of the season with the International League's worst record at 32-42 (-51 run differential) before rebounding with a 38-37 (.507) in the season's second half (-23 run differential).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville was shut out by Gwinnett 10-0 on Sunday, they finished the 2023 campaign with only five shutouts... In 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp were 6-12 against Durham and the pitching staff tallied a 6.39 ERA in 156.1 IP.

ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Divison II Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

2023 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Jacksonville on July 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, he led the Southern League in wins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games started (14).

-Made 21 total starts with Pensacola in 2022. Led team in wins (10), innings pitched (114.0), strikeouts (114), double plays (T-1st, 11).

-Led qualified pitchers in ERA (3.32),

-Among the 119 Southern League pitchers with at least 30 IP, Monteverde ranked 40th in stranded runners (71.3%).

2022 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Double-A Pensacola on August 2 from High-A Beloit.

-Over his final 13 starts in High-A, Monteverde went 3-4 with a 2.30 ERA. He pitched 70.1 innings, yielding only 54 hits (.211 batting average against) and striking out 75 against 21 walks.

2021 SEASON

-Six of his seven outings were in a relief role. Prior to that, he had not pitched in relief since 2017, his freshman year at Virginia Wesleyan. Even during that 2017 campaign, 11 of his 15 appearances were starts.

-Monteverde's favorite pitcher growing up was Clayton Kershaw

-His favorite book is "To Kill a Mockingbird" and favorite movie is "American Pie."
