ANOTHER FUTURE STAR: On Wednesday, Major League Baseball announced the rosters for the **2026 MLB All-Star Futures Game**, presented by Nike, on Sunday, July 12, at Citizens Bank Park, including Fort Wayne TinCaps left-handed pitcher **Kash Mayfield**. This marks the fifth-straight season an active TinCaps player has appeared in the Futures Game. Fort Wayne is one of only two out of 30 High-A teams to have had a player selected for this showcase each year since 2022. Outfielder Robert Hassell III became the first active player to represent Fort Wayne in 2022, before Jackson Merrill appeared in 2023. This year's rosters also include Padres No. 1 prospect Ethan Salas (2024) and Athletics No. 1 prospect Leo De Vries (2025), both of whom return to the showcase after representing Fort Wayne in their respective seasons with the club. Including Mayfield, the Midwest League will have nine players who have donned an MWL team's jersey this season in the event. Fans can watch other top prospects on the national stage live on NBC.

QUITE THE DEBUT: TinCap right-hander **Winyer Chourio** picked up the win in his High-A debut last Wednesday on the road against Lake County. The 22-year-old gave up one run on five hits and saw his fastball reach up to 98 MPH while striking out four. The 89 pitches were the most he has thrown in a game in his professional career since signing with the Padres as an international free agent on May 13, 2024. Chourio fired back-to-back starts to end his time with Single-A Lake Elsinore in the Cal League and has punched out 6 or more batters in half of his appearances this season. Chourio struck out a career-high 10 batters on May 12 against Rancho Cucamonga.

KT WANTS TO RULE THE WORLD: TinCaps outfielder **Kavares Tears** finished last week's series 6-for-18 at the plate with 2 doubles and his 9th home run of the season that came on Wednesday. The former Tennessee Volunteer finished a triple shy of the cycle in Wednesday's win. Tears has 13 extra-base hits (5 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR) in his last 18 games with a 1.101 OPS and .302 avg since May 31. The No. 26 Padres prospect leads the Midwest League with six first-pitch home runs this season and is tied for fourth in Minor League Baseball. 5 of Tears' 9 home runs this season have come against Lake County.

JACK ATTACK: Fort Wayne left fielder **Jack Costello** got the 'Caps on the board on Tuesday with an RBI double in the second inning. 12 of Costello's 14 doubles this season have come since May 9, ranking him third in the Midwest League in that stretch. The 25-year-old has 32 doubles across the last two seasons, more than anyone else who has worn the TinCap uniform since Opening Day last season.

THE WORLD OF WIDEMAN: TinCap outfielder **Ryan Wideman** collected a double in the third inning on Tuesday, his first High-A extra-base hit. The Padres 2025 third-round draft choice has a hit in 6 of his first 7 games with Fort Wayne since being promoted last Tuesday, including a 2-for-4 showing last Friday against Lake County. Wideman leads all of Minor League Baseball with 47 stolen bases in 2026.

JD JUST DOING IT: Fort Wayne shortstop **Justin DeCriscio** has reached base safely in 10 of his last 11 games dating back to June 18. He is slashing .279/.354/.512 with a .866 OPS in the stretch with 2 home runs, 2 doubles, a triple, and 7 RBI. DeCriscio homered in consecutive games last week in Eastlake on Friday and Saturday after doing so on June 12 & 13 at Day Air Ballpark against Dayton. DeCriscio finished a double shy of the cycle on Friday and has the only grand slam hit by a TinCap this season (June 12). 5 of DeCriscio's 6 home runs have come away from Parkview Field this season, with the last 4 being hit in the state of Ohio.

GOOD WILL HUNTING: TinCaps reliever **Will Varmette** has allowed one run in his last six appearances dating back to June 10. The right-hander struck out three in 1 2/3 innings on Tuesday night and landed 16 of his 25 pitches in the zone for strikes. Varmette has punched out three in back-to-back outings and collected his first High-A save on June 12 at Day Air Ballpark against Dayton. The 23-year-old is second on the team in appearances this season with 25.

WE MEET AGAIN: Fort Wayne returned home on Tuesday to take on the Great Lakes Loons for the first time since Opening Weekend. The Loons will come to Parkview Field twice in the second half, with 18 of the 21 matchups between the two teams this season falling after the first half. Great Lakes took 2 of 3 from the 'Caps during Opening Weekend, with the final 2 games being played as part of a doubleheader on Sunday, April 5 due to rain that washed out the Saturday night game. Wednesday night is Fort Wayne Pufferbelly night, with the first 1,500 fans receiving a rally towel at the gate. Friday night is Harry Potter night, where fans can get their own Harry Potter game-worn jersey with a NUCOR All-Star ticket. Saturday will be the Fourth of July celebration of America's 250th Birthday, followed by the City of Fort Wayne Postgame Fireworks. Sunday concludes the week with a TinCaps reversible bucket hat Giveaway to the first 1,500 fans, presented by Parkview Health, and postgame autographs, presented by Midwest Box Breaks.

FOURTH OF JULY FIREWORKS: The City of Fort Wayne announced that the top of the Harrison Square parking garage that's attached to Parkview Field in downtown Fort Wayne will be the location for this year's Fourth of July fireworks show on Saturday, July 4. The fireworks show is scheduled to begin at 10 p.m., with ticketed fans being able to watch the display. Tickets will be sold even after the game for fans hoping to watch the fireworks display. The top six highest single-game attendances in franchise history are all on the Fourth of July, and the 250th anniversary of American Independence is on the brink of breaking the TinCaps' single-game attendance record of 9,508.

MAKING AN IMMEDIATE IMPACT: Some of the newest additions to the Fort Wayne roster did not waste any time making their presence known last week in Eastlake. First baseman **Luke Cantwell** homered on the first pitch he saw in the second inning in Wednesday's win and followed that up with a two-run double in the fifth frame. Infielder **Kerrington Cross** reached base safely in every game, including all five times in his debut on Tuesday. Cross hit his first High-A home run on Friday, a two-run shot to the opposite field, in the sixth inning. Right-hander **Winyer Chourio** picked up the win in his High-A debut on Wednesday. The 22-year-old gave up one run on five hits and saw his fastball reach up to 98 mph while striking out four. The 89 pitches were the most he has thrown in a game in his professional career since signing with the Padres as an international free agent on May 13, 2024.

DUGIE KEEPS CLIMBING: Fort Wayne third baseman **Rosman Verdugo** hit his 11th home run of the season on Friday, giving him a round-tripper in consecutive Fridays after having one last week at home against South Bend. Verdugo now has 25 across his TinCaps career, tying Tom Knauss (1993-94, 96-97) for seventh in franchise history. Verdugo is the 10th player in Fort Wayne franchise history to hit the 20-career home run mark. After leading the 'Caps with 13 home runs in 2025, 9 of Verdugo's 11 home runs in 2026 have come on the road.

THE COMEBACK 'CAPS: Fort Wayne has come from behind in their last 14 wins following Friday's victory. The 'Caps battled back after trailing 2-0 in the second inning to hit three home runs in their fifth win in the last six games. Fort Wayne now has 23 comeback victories in 2026.

SWIPING HOME: **Zach Evans'** straight steal of home in the fifth inning Friday, May 15, was the **first TinCaps straight steal of home in Parkview Field history**. It is the third straight steal of home in franchise history, with data dating back to 2005.

The other two instances:

- May 25, 2017: Fernando Tatis Jr. @ Bowling Green vs. RHP Pete Bayer (Top 5, 1 out, Before First Pitch)
- April 16, 2013: Corey Adamson @ South Bend vs. LHP Cody Wheeler (Top 5, 1 out, Before First Pitch)

In the expansion era (1961-present), only two MLB games have ever ended 1-0 with the lone run being a straight-steal of home. Reds' Chico Ruiz on Sept. 21, 1964 vs. the Phillies and the Royals' Amos Otis on July 31, 1972 vs. the California Angels (off Nolan Ryan).

AN OLD FRIEND BACK AT THE HELM: Manager Jonathan Mathews returns for his third stint in Fort Wayne and second as manager. The 54-year-old acted as the 'Caps manager in 2023, bringing Fort Wayne to the postseason behind a second-half Midwest League East Division title. Mathews' first stint in Fort Wayne spanned from 2018-2021 as the team's hitting coach. He spent the past two years as the Padres Minor League Hitting Coordinator.

APRIL PLAYER OF THE MONTH: On Tuesday, Minor League Baseball announced Fort Wayne TinCaps outfielder **Alex McCoy** as its Midwest League Player of the Month for April. In 22 games, the No. 20 Padres prospect batted .354/.386/.683 and led the league in hits (29), doubles (10), and slugging percentage (.683). He finished second in average (.354), total bases (56), and OPS (1.069) and was fifth in home runs (five). McCoy earned nine multi-hit games, including three with multiple extra-base hits. McCoy is the sixth TinCap player to win Player of the Month since the Midwest League began issuing the award in 2013. It is the second consecutive season a TinCap has earned April's nod, with baseball's No. 4 prospect, shortstop Leo De Vries, winning the award in 2025. Others include current Cleveland Guardians left-handed pitcher Joey Cantillo (June 2019), DH Hudson Potts (August 2017), C Austin Allen (April 2016), and OF Nick Shultz (August 2014).

Age: 54

- **FROM:** Centerville, IA
- **COLLEGE:** Indian Hills Community College (Iowa) and the University of New Orleans
- **PLAYING CAREER:** Drafted in the 42nd Round of the 1994 MLB Draft by the Colorado Rockies, played one season
- **COACHING CAREER:** Mathews returns to Fort Wayne for his third stint with the organization and second as the team's manager. Began coaching career at the University of Iowa and then in the Minnesota Twins' organization after his playing career. Became the hitting coach for the High-A Fort Myers Miracle in 1997, before managing the rookie-level Elizabethton Twins in 1998 and '99. Returned to alma mater, coaching at Indian Hills and taught economics from 1999-2012 before returning to professional baseball. Mathews coached in the Baltimore Orioles' farm system in 2013, and Arizona Diamondbacks' system from 2014-2016 before joining the Padres organization in 2017 as their major-league outfield coach. He first spent time in Fort Wayne as the TinCaps hitting coach from 2018-2021 before assuming the same role with Triple-A El Paso in 2022. He took over as the Fort Wayne manager in 2023, leading the TinCaps to a second-half east division title and first playoff appearance since 2017. He has spent the last two years as a minor league hitting coordinator.

Yorman Bazardo

Pitching Coach

Age: 41

- **FROM:** Maracay, Venezuela
- **SIGNED:** July 19, 2000 (Florida Marlins) as international free agent
- **CAREER:** Made 25 big league appearances, including eight starts across four seasons from 2005 to 2009. He also played 10 seasons in the minor leagues, accruing 1,112 innings pitched and a 3.91 ERA. He ended his playing career in 2017 after multiple seasons away from the states in Venezuela, Mexico, and Italy.
- **COACHING:** Became a pitching coach in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization in 2018, acting as a pitching coach in the DSL before going stateside in 2021. He then joined the Padres organization in 2023 and spent 2025 as the pitching coach for Single-A Lake Elsinore.
- **RELATIONSHIP:** Older brother of Seattle Mariners reliever Eduard Bazardo, who made nine appearances in the playoffs in 2025.

Luis Mendez

- **FROM:** San Juan de los Morros, Venezuela
- **CAREER:** Mendez played in the minors for nine seasons all of which in the Rangers organization totaling 506 games in the minor leagues. Retired from playing after winter league stint in 2018-19.
- **COACHING:** After retiring from playing in 2019, Mendez began his coaching career with the Tri-City Dust Devils before the COVID-19 pandemic cut down the 2020 season. Mendez then spent the next three seasons as the manager of the rookie-level Dominican Summer League (DSL) Padres. In 2024, Mendez managed the Arizona Complex League (ACL) Padres. He returns for his second season as the TinCaps bench coach.

About Parkview Field

- **BACKGROUND:** In 2007, the Fort Wayne City Council approved the Harrison Square Project to build a new ballpark downtown as well as other amenities.
- **DEBUT:** Opening Day for Parkview Field took place on April 16, 2009. The TinCaps played in front of a sold-out crowd and beat the Dayton Dragons 7-0.
- **CAPACITY:** 8,100
- **RECORD CROWD:** 9,508 (July 4, 2019)
- **DIMENSIONS:** 336 feet to the left-field foul pole... 377 feet to left-center field... 400 feet to straight-away centerfield... 383 feet to right-center field... and 318 feet to the right-field foul pole.
- **WALLS:** Range from 10 feet tall, from center to right-center field, up to 15 feet tall in the outfield corners as well as a small section of left-center field.
- **MORE THAN BASEBALL:** Parkview Field hosts hundreds of special events yearly, including concerts such as Florida Georgia Line, Dierks Bentley, Zac Brown Band, and Nelly.
