TODAY'S HEADLINES

Under Gardenhire (since '21)... 272-251 LAST TIME OUT: The Saints got another strong start from Caleb Boushley, who threw 6.0 innings, allowing just one run in a 6-2 victory on Wednesday. The Saints scored the first four runs of the game, starting with a Yunior Severino RBI single that scored Royce Lewis to make it 1- Wynton Bernard hit the first of his two doubles in the second to double the lead and doubled again in the third to give the Saints a 4-0 lead. Anthony Prato tripled in the eighth to drive in another run and Rylan Bannon drove him in to add insurance and pad the lead at 6-2. Severino finished the game 3-for-4 with a double. Jose Miranda also notched a multi-hit game, going 2-for-4 in his first game on Major League rehab. Boushley picked up his ninth with of the season, the most in the IL and tying the Saints single-season record.

TRIPLES IS BEST: Anthony Prato logged his fifth triple of the season on Wednesday, four of which have come in July. His four July triples tie the most for any Saints batter in any month in franchise history, matching the five hit by Jake Cave in June of 2022. Prato is the fourth International League batter to collect four triples in a month this season. His five triples on the season are now tied for the second-most in the IL

WILLIAMS RECORD WATCH: Chris Williams hit his 12th home run of the season on Sunday and the 43rd of his Saints career. He has tied Mark Contreras for the career franchise lead at 43 long balls. His 43 home runs since his debut on July 17, 2022 are tied for the 10th-most in the International League

5 In the month of July, Williams has clubbed seven home runs, the most in the International League. He also leads the league in July with his .732 slugging percentage, ranking second with 10 extra-base hits and third with his 41 total bases. His 1.129 OPS is the seventhbest in the IL this month. It is also the best of any month he's had in 2024 and over double his .544 OPS in June.

REHAB ROUNDTABLE: The Minnesota Twins sent Jose Miranda to St. Paul on a Major League rehab assignment on Wednesday. The Saints have two Major League Rehab assignment on their roster, along with Royce Lewis. Lewis is making his second rehab appearance with the Saints, previously playing with them from May 25-June 2. Lewis has gone 5-for-29 with two doubles in eight total games. Miranda was placed on the 10-Day IL on July 14 (retro July 11) for a low back strain.

CHASING STORMS HOME RUNS: The Saints have hit 74 home runs against Omaha at CHS Field, the most long balls they have hit against any team in any venue in franchise history. Their .481 slugging percentage against Omaha is the fourth-best against any opponents at CHS Field since 2021.

TWINS UPDATE: The Minnesota Twins walked-off Philadelphia, 5-4, clinching the series victory on Wednesday. David Festa struck out seven over 4.1 innings of relief, following Steven Okert. LAST START: 7/19 @ TOL...made 18th start of the season, allowing two runs on five hits, three walks and four strikeouts...all five hits allowed were singles...gave up two hits and a walk in the third inning, allowing first run to score...allowed pair of singles in the fourth to score second run...recorded just two outs on ground balls...pitched seventh consecutive start that did not allow more than two earned runs...primarily threw the slider (45%), inducing 11 total whiffs, seven coming off the slider...received eight win, tying the (at the time) league lead in an 8-6 Saints victory.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 7/13 @ LOU...made 17th start of the season, allowing one earned run on five hits over 5.0 innings, walking two and striking out six...allowed an unearned run in the first inning after errant throw to second on a stolen base attempt came around to score on an RBI single...got out of the first with a lineout and 1-3 double play...retired seven in a row before allowing a solo home run to Blake Dunn to start the fourth inning...gave up an unearmed run in the fifth inning after a dropped catch at first base...gave up back-to-back singles with two outs, plating the run..generated nine whiffs, six with the changeup...did not factor into decision in 5-4 Saints loss in 10 innings.

SAINTS RANDY: In 2023, Dobnak was a workhorse for the Saints, setting a number of single-season records. He set the franchise record for starts (26), innings pitched (126.1 IP), and strikeouts (115). The 2023 season was Dobnak's third with the Saints and consequently he is the franchise leader in two of those three categories as well: his 33 starts are four more than the #2 pitcher, Simeon Woods Richardson, his 164.1 IP are 12.0 more than Ronny Henriquez, and his 147 strikeouts are just eight shy of Ronny Henriquez.

KNOW ANY GOOD PIRATE JOKES? NEITHER DO AYYYYE: Dobnak grew up a huge Pittsburgh Pirates fan and we would often go to PNC Park. His favorite food to get there was nachos with pulled pork and cheese. He finally pitched at PNC Park on August 5, 2020. The irony was no fans were allowed in, not even his parents. He tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing three hits and striking out one.

A BATTLE(R) OF WILLS: You can be forgiven if you've never heard of the DII school that Dobnak attended from 2014-17. He spent four years at Alderson Broadus (WV) University, located in Philippi, a town of 3.380. During his time with the Battlers he finished his career as the conference's all-time leader in ERA (2.61) and strikeouts (284). In his sophomore season in 2015, Dobnak threw a no-hitter against Bluefield

TWILIGHT SPARKLE MEET BUTTERCUP: Upon graduating from Alderson Broadus, Dobnak went undrafted and was looking for a way to continue his career. He got his break with the Utica Unicorns in the United Shore Professional Baseball League (a four team league where all four teams play in the same ballpark in Utica, MI near Detroit). He signed with them because he caught the eye of manager Jim Essian (a one time Cubs manager in 1981 & also played from 1973-84 in the Majors), whose son played with Dobnak at Alderson Broadus. Dobnak would become the only player to reach the Major League's out of

THERE'S ALWAYS THAT ONE PERSON: In order to make ends meet in the USPBL, Dobnak drove for Uber and Lyft. He began driving for both in October, 2017. His Uber rating was stellar, but not perfect. He had a 4.99/5.0 rating which meant he received all five-star ratings with the exception of one four-star rating. According to Dobnak, "I have one four-star. I'm hoping it was a mistake. I don't remember doing anything bad."

NOT QUITE MIKE ROWE: Just prior to joining the big leagues, Dobnak worked as a consultant for Jordan Tax & Accounting Services in Bethel Park, PA (2017), an accounting clerk at Accountant and Associates in PA (2017), pizza delivery for Italian Village Pizza in South Park, PA (2012-13) and supermarket stocker at Foodland in Pittsburgh (2010-12).

WE'RE BETTER THAN YOU, AND WE KNOW IT: Dobnak got married to Aerial Munson on September 28, 2019, never thinking he'd be in the Major Leagues. He returned home after the Twins finished a series in Detroit and got married on a Saturday. He wasn't exempt from the rookie ritual of having to dress up in a crazy costume. He had to dress up in a Globo Gym outfit and flew commercial home instead of the chartered flight. He showed up to his fiancées in full attire.

CANDLESTICKS MAKE A NICE GIFT: Before getting married, some of Dobnak's wedding registry gifts wound up in the Twins game notes on September 20 (Amazon Echo, 67-inch leaf rake and Pine-Sol). All of it was the handiwork of intern lan Kraft. The publicity of their registry becoming public made the soon to be married couple ask fans to donate to St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital, which has always been important to Aerial Dobnak due to her lifelong desire to be involved with children and her experience with the loss of a friend to cancer during her freshman year of college at Alderson Broaddus University, instead of buying them gifts. Their initial goal was \$2,000 and within 8 hours that goal was met. Eventually they raised \$4,093. But the story didn't end there. A representative of St. Jude reached out to her on social media afterward, wondering if the couple would be willing to engage in more significant involvement with the hospital once the wedding buzz had died down. They jumped at the opportunity, and the Dobnak's were flown to the hospital in Memphis for a weekend in January to meet patients, connect with fundraising coordinators and evaluate their options for continued future engagement. coordinators and evaluate their options for continued future engagement.
