Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and the Charlotte Knights play the first of a six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. It marks the second series the teams have played against each other - the Sounds and the Knights split the first six-game set on June 1-6. Right-hander Thomas Jankins starts for Nashville against right-hander Reynaldo Lopez for Charlotte.

Thomas Jankins: 25-year-old Thomas Jankins makes his ninth appearance (seventh start) for the Sounds tonight. He is 0-0 with a 3.38 ERA (1 ER/2.2 IP) in 2 appearances out of the bullpen vs. the Knights this season. He last pitched on June 16 at Gwinnett and covered 5.0 innings and gave up 4 runs on 5 hits and struck out 3. In 2019, Jankins went 11-5 with a 4.19 ERA in 25 games (23 starts) with Triple-A San Antonio and Double-A Biloxi. He finished tied for fifth in the Pacific Coast League for wins (10), logged 10 quality starts and four starts of 6+ IP and one or less runs allowed. The Massachusetts native was named a Southern League All-Star in 2018 after he went 10-9 with a 4.42 ERA with Double-A Biloxi. The Brewers drafted Jankins in the 13th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

Reynaldo Lopez: 27-year-old Reynaldo Lopez makes his seventh start for Charlotte tonight. He last pitched on June 15 vs. Jacksonville and went 4.2 innings and gave up 3 runs on a season-high 8 hits. He got the ball on June 2 vs. Nashville and pitched just 2.0 innings and gave up 2 runs on 2 hits. Prior to the 2021 season, the last time he pitched in Triple-A was in 2017 when he made 22 starts for Charlotte. He pitched for the White Sox from 2017-2020. Lopez was part of the December 7, 2016 trade that sent outfielder Adam Eaton to the Washington Nationals.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 9, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

The Sounds vs. Lopez: The Sounds face Reynaldo Lopez for the second time season, they last faced him on June 2 in a 7-4 win. Nashville hit .250 (2-for-8) with a double and 4 walks against the right-hander with Pablo Reyes and Dylan Cozens driving in a run apiece.

Double Digits for Hiura: Hiura has reached base in a team-best 19 consecutive games, batting .412 (28-for-68) with 14 runs, 8 doubles, 5 home runs, 14 RBI and 13 walks. He had his first multi-homer game of the season on June 20 at Gwinnett and the sixth of his career (last - 8/7/19 at PIT). Hiura hit safely in 12 straight games from May 18-June 16.

First Loss in a Series: The Sounds lost their first series of the season to Gwinnett on June 15-20. The Strippers won 3 of the 5 games at Coolray Field. Nashville has won 3 series', tied 3 and lost 1.

Stay Hot: Infielder/outfielder Jamie Westbrock had his 10-game hit streak snapped on Sunday but has reached base safely in 11 straight games. He is batting .455 (20-for-44) with 9 runs, 6 doubles, 2 home runs, 11 RBI and 4 walks during that span. He has multi-hit efforts in 7 of his last 11 games.

Vs. Charlotte: Nashville and Charlotte met for a 6-game series on June 1-6 with the Sounds winning the first 3 games of the set and the Knights winning the last 3. On June 4, Charlotte snapped Nashville's 15-game winning streak with a 1-0 win.

Another Streak for Perez: Perez has hit safely in 7 straight games for the second time this season. Perez is batting .406 (13-for-32) with 2 doubles and 5 RBI during the streak. He has also recorded 4 consecutive multi-hit games. Perez is 1 of 4 Sounds to have 2 hit streaks of at least 5 games (Zach Green, Corey Ray and Dustin Peterson).

Grand Slam: Zach Green hit the first grand slam of the year for Nashville in the third inning of Friday night's contest. It was the first grand slam hit by a Sound since August 13, 2019 at Sacramento (Andy Ibanez).

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,053-1,935. The 2,053 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

LAST OUTING: Jankins last pitched on June 16 at Gwinnett and took his third consecutive loss. He covered 5.0 innings and gave up four runs on five hits and struck out three. He exited the game with the Sounds down 4-2 and threw 74 pitches (51 strikes).

AGAINST OPPONENT: Jankins is pitching against Charlotte for the third time in 2021 and making his first start. He is 0-0 with a 3.38 ERA (1 ER/2.2 IP) against the Knights.
