**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 5-2. Jud Fabian gave the Baysox a 2-0 lead with a two-run homer in the third, the only runs allowed by **Ryan Murphy** in his four-inning start. **Donovan Walton** closed the score to 2-1 with a sac fly in the bottom of the third. In the sixth, Donta' Williams hit an RBI single and Silas Ardoin brought in a run on a double-play groundout in the eighth to extend the Bowie lead to 4-1. **Victor Bericoto** hit a solo homer in the bottom of the eighth to close the score to 4-2. In the top of the ninth, Jackson Holliday pushed the Baysox lead to 5-2 with an RBI double.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Richmond won four-of-five in Bowie from April 25-29 and went 3-4 in a series at Prince George's Stadium from June 13-18. The two teams split the most recent series at The Diamond from July 4-9, with the Flying Squirrels taking the first three and the Baysox winning the last three. The Flying Squirrels are looking for a win to clinch a winning record against the Baysox for the second consecutive season, which would also give them a split in this series.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 27-18 in their last 44 games since June 18 but they are 3-6 in their last nine games. They went 2-4 in last week's series at Altoona and are 2-3 in this series against the Baysox. Over the last 50 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 3.00 ERA (63 ER/189.0 IP) and have allowed 14 home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.82 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 390.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 531.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.62 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A and the 11th-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE BAYSUX went 4-2 in last week's home series against the Sea Dogs after going 1-5 the previous week on the road against the Patriots. Bowie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including SS Jackson Holliday (No. 1), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 9), OF Jud Fabian (No. 14), 3B Max Wagner (No. 15), OF John Rhodes (No. 21), OF Billy Cook (No. 28) and RHP Alex Pham (No. 30). Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes six Baysox players, including Holliday (No. 1), Fabian (No. 10), Pham (No. 17), Wagner (No. 19), Beavers (No. 21) and Rhodes (No. 29). Holliday is also rated as the No. 1 prospect in

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Carson Seymour takes the mound for his 18th Double-A start and his sixth outing against the Baysox. He started the series opener on Tuesday and picked up a win, surrendering one run over five innings with six strikeouts. In his previous start last Tuesday at Altoona, he allowed one hit over five scoreless innings with a season-high nine strikeouts. That performance led to Seymour being named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday. He first faced the Baysox on April 25 at Prince George's Stadium and allowed two runs over three innings. He pitched again in Bowie on June 16 and surrendered one run over four innings. On July 4 at The Diamond, Seymour held the Baysox to two runs over 3.1 innings and struck out six, which was a season high at the time. In the finale of that series on July 9, he allowed a season-high five earned runs in three innings. This season, Seymour is fifth in the Eastern League in ERA (3.70), third in WHIP (1.23) and fourth in BAA (.231). He also has the second-lowest HR/9 (0.72) and third-highest groundball percentage (48.1) in the Eastern League. Over his last five starts since July 15, Seymour has gone 3-0 with a 2.66 ERA (7 ER/23.2 IP) with 33 strikeouts and seven walks. A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 119 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on May 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 14 Giants prospect and No. 16 by MLB.com. FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Alex Pham makes his eighth Double-A start and his third appearance against Richmond. On Tuesday to open the series, he allowed a Double-A-high three earned runs over five innings in a loss. He pitched in Richmond on July 7, his lone Double-A relief outing to date, and fired three scoreless innings with five strikeouts. Pham was selected by the Orioles in the 19th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of San Francisco, where he was teammates with former Flying Squirrels catcher Robert Emery for three seasons. He began this season with High-A Aberdeen and went 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings, earning the South Atlantic Pitcher of the Month award for May.

**STARTING STRONG:** In last week's series, Richmond starting pitchers opened the set throwing 20 innings without allowing a run until the third inning on Saturday night. Flying Squirrels starters have a 2.32 ERA (11 ER/42.2 IP) over the last 10 games since August 2. In that stretch, **Carson Seymour** is 1-0 with a 0.90 ERA (1 ER/10.0 IP), **Spencer Bivens** has a 1.23 ERA (1 ER/7.1 IP) and **John Michael Bertrand** has a 0.90 ERA (1 ER/10.0 IP). **Wil Jensen** also threw four scoreless innings in his start on August 10.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With 31 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are tied for first place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings with the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half. Bowie and Harrisburg are tied for third, one game behind Richmond and Erie. Akron is in fifth place, two games out of first. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels are leading the Double-A level in total attendance (349,736) and average attendance (6,477) this year. They are also 13th in the minors in average attendance. Last year, Richmond led all 30 Double-A teams in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history.

**DONNIE'S IN HIS ELEMENT: Donovan Walton** has hit safely in each of his five games since being assigned to Richmond this week, combining to hit .353 (6-for-17) with two walks and two RBIs, adding two stolen bases. In his 13 games for the Flying Squirrels this season, he is batting .310 (13-for-42) with two homers and eight RBIs. Covering his two stints with Richmond, Walton has reached base in 12 consecutive Eastern League games and has hit safely in six straight games.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 38 times in his last 17 games since July 25 (19 hits and 19 walks), hitting .333 (19-for-57) with two homers, four doubles, two triples and 12 RBIs adding a .494 on-base percentage. He was riding a 12-game on-base streak and a seven-game hit streak prior to going 0-for-4 on Saturday night. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 127 walks, moving ahead of Ricky Oropesa (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails Jacob Heyward (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

**GLDW SHOW:** Over his last 26 games since July 1, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .310 (27-for-87) with four homers, seven doubles, 20 RBIs and nine walks. On July 18 at Akron, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On July 29 against the Sea Dogs, he hit a lead-off double to start the bottom of the ninth in Richmond's comeback win. He is hitting .389 (7-for-18) in his last six games since August 2 with two doubles, three walks and six RBIs.

**LOGAN'S LIFTOFF:** On Tuesday night, **Logan Wyatt** drove a three-run, go-ahead homer. It was his 12th-overall home run of the season, which is the tied for the seventh-most among Giants minor leaguers. It was also hit first home run since he went deep three times in a five-game stretch from June 23-30, snapping a 26-game homerless drought. Over a 21-game stretch from July 6-August 5, Wyatt hit .156 (10-for-64) with eight walks and four RBIs. In his last seven games since August 6, he is batting .300 (6-for-20) with a homer, five RBIs and four runs scored. Wyatt has not committed an error in 33 consecutive games played, which is the longest streak for a Richmond player this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23). RICHMOND
