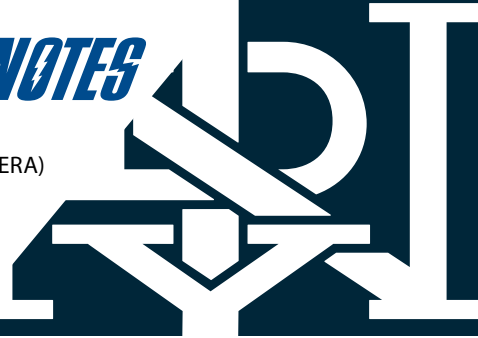

NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- Of 14 series played this season, Omaha has won 5, lost 6 and split 3 ... the Storm Chasers have a 6-6 record over their last 12 games, having split their last 2 series, June 15-21 @ St. Paul and June 23-28 vs. Columbus.
 - Omaha went 13-12 in April ... with a 13-14 record in May and 10-15 in June, the Chasers had back-to-back losing months for the first time since June/July 2025.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Chasers have 21 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 24 losses this year.
- 21 comeback wins are tied for the 8th-most in the International League, tied 11th in Triple-A ... 24 blown leads are tied for the 3rd-most in the league, tied 5th in Triple-A.
 - The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 12 of their last 20 losses, including 4 games where the team led for at least half the game and 2 losses where Omaha had a 6+ run lead at some point in the game.
 - In the last 46 games (since May 9), Omaha is 21-25 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 14 of 21 wins and led at some point in 14 of 25 losses, meaning 28 of Omaha's last 46 games (61%) have been a comeback win for one of the teams ... in this stretch, 32 of 46 games (70%) have been decided by 3 runs or less.

SUMMER SWINGING

- The Chasers ended June with one of the hottest offenses in the International League.
- Omaha's 102 extra-base hits in June led all Triple-A clubs and were the 2nd-most in the minors ... a .287 team batting average last month ranked tied 3rd in Triple-A, a .488 slugging percentage was 3rd and an .841 OPS was 4th ... 157 runs scored by the Storm Chasers in June were tied for the 4th-most in Triple-A.
 - Omaha scored 6+ runs in 14 of 25 games in June, tied for the most in the International League ... additionally the Chasers had 13 games with 10+ hits this month, the 2nd-most such games in the IL (1st: Charlotte, 14).

JUNE BUGS

- Individually, there were many key offensive contributors in the month of June.
- Since rejoining Omaha June 18, **Brandon Drury** has reached base in all 9 games, batting .382 (13-for-34) with 4 doubles, 3 homers and 10 RBI for a 1.227 OPS.
 - Abraham Toro** had hits in 18 of his 23 games in June, batting .326 (29-for-89) with 6 doubles, 3 triples, 6 homers and 24 RBI for a 1.041 OPS ... his 59 total bases this month ranked 4th-most in the International League, while tied 4th in RBI.
 - Matthew Lugo** was acquired by the Royals on June 2 and in his first 21 games with Omaha, has hit .325 (26-for-80) with 7 doubles, 7 homers and 21 RBI for a 1.035 OPS ... his 54 total bases last month ranked tied 5th-most in the IL.
 - Peyton Wilson** had hits in 16 of his 22 games last month, batting .312 (29-for-93) in June with 12 doubles, 11 RBI and 9 walks for an .814 OPS.
 - Brett Squires** hit .291 (23-for-79) in the month of June, with an .850 OPS ... he enters today's game on a career-best 12-game hitting streak and is batting .375 (18-for-48) since the streak started on June 16 with 6 XBH, 9 RBI and a 1.051 OPS.

HONEST ABE

- Abraham Toro** started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May
- Since May 12, Toro has a .326 average (43-for-132) ... he ranks 2nd in the IL in OPS (1.003), 4th in SLG (.606) and 7th in AVG ... his 35 RBI over 36 games since May 12 are tied 3rd-most in the league.
 - From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 12, Toro has hits in 27 of 36 games, with 4+ hits in 3 games.

CROSS ME UP

- Gavin Cross** had one of the league's slowest start to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.
- Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) with 3 XBH and 6 RBI, with 1 multi-hit game ... but in his last 34 games (since May 16), he's hitting .292 (35-for-120), with 9 XBH and 13 RBI, with 10 multi-hit games.

- Ethan Bosacker is making his **4th start** with the Storm Chasers this year, his **16th outing** with Omaha and his **18th overall appearance** this season.
- Playing his **4th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.

BOSACKER ATTACKER

- ROTATION ROULETTE:** Bosacker has split time between the rotation and bullpen in his four seasons in the Royals organization ... he made 2 Triple-A starts to open this year before transitioning to the bullpen, made an additional spot start for Omaha in May and made a pair of starts for Northwest Arkansas over a 2-week stint in Double-A ... between Double-A and Triple-A, he made 8 consecutive starts to open the 2025 season (April 5 to May 17), followed by 8 straight relief appearances (June 13 to July 30), then alternated between roles over his final 9 appearances of last year (August 1 to September 14).
- LATE ROUND STEALS:** As a 13th round draft pick by the Royals in 2023, Bosacker joins Ryan Ramsey (13th, 2022), Ben Sears (14th, 2022) and Luca Tresh (17th, 2021) as a group of four players on the Storm Chasers roster selected by Kansas City in the back half of the draft (11th round or later) since 2021.

LAST OUTING: SATURDAY, JUNE 27 vs. COLUMBUS

- Making his 5th relief appearance since returning to Omaha for his 2nd Triple-A stint of the season ... labored through a 42-pitch 3rd inning, facing 8 batters ... allowed a triple, two walks and a pair of RBI singles ... 42 pitches were his most in an inning as a professional, just the 2nd time in 4 years he threw 30+ pitches in an inning.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Did not appear in a Cactus League game for the Royals, was on the break camp roster for Double-A Northwest Arkansas, but assigned to Omaha on April 2 before pitching for the Naturals.
- On Omaha's Development List from May 4 to 7, activated May 8.
- Transferred to Double-A on May 27 and made 2 starts with the Naturals, allowing 2 runs over 9.0 innings while striking out 5 ... transferred back to Omaha on June 12.
- In 3 starts with Omaha, has a 8.10 ERA (9 ER in 10.0 IP) ... in 12 relief appearances with the Storm Chasers, has a 6.14 ERA (15 ER in 22.0 IP).

CAREER NOTES

2025

- Split time as both a starter and reliever between Northwest Arkansas (AA) and Omaha ... combined to post a 4.05 ERA (49 ER in 109.0 IP) with a 1.25 WHIP in 28 appearances (15 starts) between the two levels.
- Opened the year with the Naturals and started his first 7 games before a promotion to Triple-A, pitching at least 5.0 innings in all 7 Double-A starts and posting a 5.00 ERA (20 ER in 36.0 IP).
- Made his Triple-A debut for the Storm Chasers on May 17 vs. Columbus (CLE), allowing 5 runs in 5.0 innings ... had 3 separate stints with Omaha, his longest (and last) stint between July 18 and August 19 when he produced up a 4.73 ERA (7 ER in 13.1 IP) across 7 games (2 starts).
- Finished the season in Double-A, working a 2.84 ERA (6 ER in 19.0 IP) and 0.74 WHIP across 5 appearances (3 starts) after being transferred back to NWA on August 19.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- Began 2024 in Single-A, posting a 2.78 ERA (23 ER in 74.1 IP) and 1.12 WHIP across 15 games (9 starts) with Columbia before a July 9 promotion to High-A, where he pitched to a 1.97 ERA (11 ER in 50.1 IP) over 9 starts with Quad Cities ... combined for a 2.45 ERA (34 ER in 124.2 IP) with 96 strikeouts to 28 walks (3.43 K/BB) across 24 games (18 starts) between the two levels ... named the Royals' High-A Pitcher of the Year with Quad Cities by Royals Player Development.
- Made his professional debut with the ACL Royals (R) in 2023 after Kansas City drafted him in the 13th round of the 2023 MLB Draft ... pitched in 2 games in the Arizona Complex League, including a scoreless 2nd appearance on August 21 vs. the ACL Giants Orange.

- Pitched 3 seasons over 4 years (2020-23) for Xavier University (Big East), working a career 12-8 record with a 4.17 ERA (77 ER in 166.0 IP) and 160 strikeouts to 58 walks (2.76 K/BB) for the Musketeers ... named 2023 All-Big East 2nd Team, going 8-3 with a 3.67 ERA (38 ER in 98.0 IP) and 101 strikeouts across 16 starts.
- Threw a complete game shutout against Eastern Illinois on June 3, 2023, in the NCAA Nashville Regional.
- Was a two-sport captain in baseball and football as a junior and senior at Monticello High School (MN).
