**Tonight:** The Lugnuts play the third game in a six-game series against the TinCaps, the third of 18 meetings between the two clubs this season. 23-year-old right-hander **Richard Guasch** makes his second start and third appearance of the season, taking on Fort Wayne right-hander **Moises Lugo**, in his third start of the season. The TinCaps defeated the Lugnuts in each of the first two games of the series, outscoring the Nuts 19-4 in total.

**Last Night: TinCaps 6, Lugnuts 3.** After blasting the Nuts in the series opener, the TinCaps rallied back from deficits of 2-0 and 3-2 to defeat Lansing on Wednesday night. **Jordan Diaz** homered in his first at-bat for the second consecutive day, giving the youngest Lugnut a team-leading three home runs this season. Fort Wayne right-hander **Gabe Mosser** turned in a sterling five-inning relief performance, taking over for **Edgar Martinez** (removed beginning the second inning for precautionary reasons) and **Luis Almanzar** made a run-saving defensive gem and delivered two RBI singles to aid the winning cause.

**Last Transaction:** The Nuts have made only one roster move this year, placing starting pitcher **Jeff Criswell** on the Injured List and adding relief pitcher **Brandon Withers** from Extended Spring Training on May 12th. Withers, the 835th player in Lugnuts team history.

**On the Air:** Today's game is on MiLB.TV stars **John Nolan** and **Jack McMullen** with the call of the game, doing their part to put the little-known Syracuse broadcast program on the map, and Lugnuts voices **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jaksa** delivering the online audio play-by-play via <http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing>.

### LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

**What's New in 2021:** Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland Athletics, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020). The Athletics had previously partnered with Lugnuts rivals Burlington (1963-1974, 2011-2012), West Michigan (1994-1996), Kane County (1993-2010) and Beloit (2013-2020).

**Meet the Boss:** **Scott Steinmann** is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017).

**Pitching Success, but...:** The Lugnuts' pitching staff ranks 2nd in the High-A Central with a 2.80 earned run average despite allowing the second-most hits in the league (109) thanks to issuing only 41 walks, second-fewest in the league behind only these Fort Wayne TinCaps. The Lugnuts lead the league in GO/ AO ratio (1.70) by a healthy margin and have also racked up the most runners caught stealing (8 in 28 attempts).

**Looking for Offense:** The Lugnuts have scored a league low 52 runs this season, with 12 total runs in the last six games. Not coincidentally, the Nuts have lost five of their last six games after getting off to a 5-3 start this year. Lansing has also drawn a league-low 47 walks while striking out 127 times, making the club the third-hardest team to strike out in the league. On the other hand, the Nuts have 33 doubles this year, most in the High-A Central.

**A Slew of Starters:** The Lugnuts have used eight starting pitchers this season, with a ninth on the horizon, namely: **Seth Shuman** (May 4, May 15); **Brady Basso** (May 5, May 12); **Richard Guasch** (May 6); **Reid Birlingmair** (May 7, May 14); **Jeff Criswell** (May 8); **Stevie Emanuels** (May 9, May 16); **Rafael Kelly** (May 11, May 18); and **Shohei Tomioka** (May 13); with **Colin Peluse** scheduled to start for the first time on Saturday.

**Major League Lugnuts, Part I:** Two former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, pitcher **Ty Tice** '18 and outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17, with the duo making their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals.

**Major League Lugnuts, Part II:** Who has been the best Lugnut in the Majors this year? Let's make two cases: Pitcher **Kendall Graveman** '13-'14, who went from Lansing to the Majors in one season in 2014, has turned into a relief ace for the Seattle Mariners: 16 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing six hits in 54 at-bats (.111) with only three walks and 17 strikeouts (0.54 WHIP). First baseman **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** '17 leads Major League Baseball with 2.5 WAR (according to Fangraphs) and is second to Mike Trout in wRC+ (199).

### History vs. Fort Wayne

The Lugnuts are 0-2 this season and 192-197 all-time vs. Fort Wayne, 102-80 in Michigan's state capital and 90-117 in the Summit City.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2014:** With all eyes on him and a Thursday night crowd of 9,823 in attendance, rehabbing Mark Prior made his first appearance since the 2003 National League Championship Series, beginning his road back to the Majors. Prior faced the minimum in three innings, striking out five and issuing one walk – to Drew Macias, who was then caught stealing by catcher Jake Fox to end the second inning. The Lugnuts defeated the Fort Wayne Wizards, 2-1, on two runs in the bottom of the ninth. Brian Dopirak tied the game with a two-out RBI double. Three batters later, Fox drew a walk-off walk to bring in Dopirak. Future Major Leaguer Carlos Marmol picked up the win, allowing one run in six innings and striking out eight.

**Familiar Settings:** 14 of the 30 Lugnuts players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members **Scott Steinmann**, **Don Schulze** and **Anthony Phillips** all have experience in the league.

**A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You:** **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University, and **Jeff Criswell** (Portage Central H.S.) and **Jack Weisenburger** (Rockford H.S.) are the fourth and fifth Michigan Wolverines to play in Lansing (following **Troy Miller**, **Jake Fox** and **Rich Hill**).

**Finally:** Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielders **Michael Guldborg** and **Jake Suddleson** are all making their pro debut this season.

**Front Office Connections:** Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

**Clubhouse of Higher Learning:** The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. Outfielder **Jake Suddleson** and first baseman **Patrick McColl** played for Harvard, reliever **Michael Danielak** was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher **William Simoneit** spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

**Power Five Baseball:** The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (**Michael Guldborg**, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (**Brady Basso**, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (**Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger**, Michigan; **Dalton Sawyer**, Minnesota); and the SEC (**Cobie Vance**, Alabama, and **Ryan Gridley**, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (**Stevie Emanuels**, Washington).

**International Appeal:** In addition to 15 different states represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

**Teammates Then, Teammates Now:** Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. **Jake Suddleson** and **Patrick McColl** played together at Harvard, **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and **Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger** pitched together in Ann Arbor. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons, but **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year. Simoneit has caught Peluse twice this season, forming a full Demon Deacon battery.

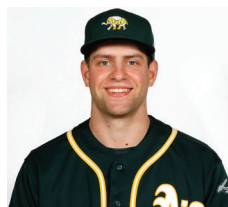

**Pronunciation:** The first letter of Richard's last name is pronounced with an "h" sound, as in "hwahsh."

**Last Outing:** Relieved Shohei Tomioka in a piggyback assignment on Thursday, May 13th, at Dayton... struck out six Dragons in four innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on four hits and a walk in a no-decision... relieved Tomioka starting the 3rd inning, allowing a home run to Jose Tello, the second batter faced; Victor Ruiz followed with a single, but was erased on a strike 'im out, throw 'im out double play... pitched around singles by James Free and Jonathan Willems in a scoreless 4th... whiffed Quincy McAfee and Ruiz in a perfect 5th... in frustrating 6th, walked Quin Cotton on a 3-2 pitch, Cotton stole 2nd and then stole 3rd on a strikeout of James Free, coming home on a throwing error by catcher Jared McDonald, giving Dayton an enormous insurance run, on their way to a 4-2 win over the Lugnuts.

**2021 in the High-A Central:** Richard opened the season as the No. 3 starter in the Lugnuts' rotation, working 2 1/3 scoreless innings on May 6th vs. Lake County... struggled with command, working around a one-out walk in the 1st inning with a strikeout of top prospect George Valera... hit a batter and walked a batter in the 2nd inning but stranded runners at the corners... gave up a double and a walk in the 3rd inning, but responded by striking out Valera and cleanup hitter Jonathan Engelmann before he was relieved in favor of Bryce Nightengale, who escaped the jam... departed with the Lugnuts leading, 3-0, only to see bullpen relinquish the lead in a 7-6 loss.

**2019:** Received one start with the Vermont Lake Monsters on June 19th, going four innings, allowing no runs, with five strikeouts and one walk, spending the rest of his 2019 season in Beloit, where he pitched in 18 games, 10 starts, and finished the year with a 4.53 ERA, 77 strikeouts / 37 walks, and just one home run allowed.

**2018:** Made his professional debut in DSL rookie league as a member of the A's starting rotation, pitching in seven games, starting five, with an ERA of 1.16 in 23.1 IP, walking four while striking out 27 in a stunningly impressive campaign.

**The Road to MLB:** At age 20, signed with the Oakland Athletics as an international free agent on July 13th, 2018... scout: Juan C. De La Cruz, who also signed teammate Rafael Kelly.

**Coming Up in Cuban Baseball:** First gained notice after reached the national championship game while pitching for Santiago de Cuba's 11- and 12-year-old team... pitched in 2013 at the U15 National Championship, where he went 8-0 with a 2.12 ERA and a team-leading 70 strikeouts... unfortunately, this experience damaged his elbow, preventing him from competing in 2014 at the U18 National Championship... appeared in the 2015 U18 National Championship, recording a 5-1 record with a 1.99 ERA in seven outings... went 8-2 with a 0.62 ERA in the 2016 U18 National Championship... member of Cuba's 2017 Pan-American team... also in 2017, Richard's father died, causing him to make the decision to leave Cuba and seek his fortune pitching professionally in MLB... he lived for three months in Mexico, two months in Guatemala, and then formally moved to the Dominican Republic... originally expected to sign with the Philadelphia Phillies, but after complications emerged, signed instead with Oakland. **Santiago de Cuba:** Richard hails from the second largest city in Cuba and the capital city of Santiago de Cuba Province... it lies in the southeastern area of the island 540 miles southeast of the Cuban capital of Havana... historically, Santiago de Cuba has been the second-most important city on the island after Havana, and remains the second-largest (Havana)... the city features a bay connected to the Caribbean Sea and is a major port... total population as of 2020: 1,253,838... also from Santiago de Cuba: Orestes Destrade, Adeiny Hechavarria and Barbaro Garbey.
