YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox came from behind on Sunday to defeat the Richmond Flying Squirrels and win the series by a final score of 3-2. Down 2-0 in the third, Chesapeake tied the score on an RBI grounder from **Creed Willems** and a sacrifice fly from **Silas Ardoin**. The Baysox took the lead for good in the sixth on a **Frederick Bencosme** sacrifice fly. **Ryan Long** pitched five strong innings and allowed just two runs while **Levi Wells** threw four scoreless in relief to collect the save and clinch the series.

ARMS RACE

Chesapeake pitching has allowed four earned runs or fewer in 12 of the 15 games played this season (1.99 ERA in 104 innings pitched), which leads the Eastern League. The Baysox have also already collected nine saves on the year, which leads all Double-A staffs, and have yet to blow a save. Last season, the Chesapeake bullpen led all of Double-A in strikeouts (724) and innings pitched (653.2).

CREED CRUSHES

C **Creed Willems** blasted his first homer of the season on Wednesday with a solo shot in the ninth. The Orioles No. 12 prospect is on a five-game hit streak and has reached base in 10 consecutive games. His five doubles are tied for the fifth-most in the Eastern League. The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the team.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE

OF **Doug Hodo** has been an on-base machine for the Baysox to start his first full season at Double-A. The 24-year-old is on a 12-game on-base streak, which is the longest on the team and the third-longest in the league. The Orioles 6th rounder in 2022 is tied for the league lead in walks (14) and is seventh in OBP (.434).

TELL THE WHOLE PHAM

RHP **Alex Pham** makes his fourth start of the season for Chesapeake. Pham pitched 4.1 scoreless innings on Wednesday in Richmond before giving up four runs in the fifth, including a three-run homer. The Orioles No. 29 prospect struck out a Double-A high nine batters in his last home start on April 11 vs Erie. The 25-year-old struck out 138 batters last season, the second-most in the O's system, the third-most in the Eastern League and the sixth-most in Double-A.

ACTION JACKSON

IF **Jeremiah Jackson** is tied for fifth in the Eastern League in hits (15) and doubles (5) to start the season. Over his last five games, Jackson has four multi-hit performances and is batting .391 (9-for-23) with three doubles and four RBI. The 25-year-old has struck out only four times in 57 total plate appearances (7% strikeout rate), while averaging a 27.5% strikeout rate in his career.

ONE RUN WONDERS

Despite having scored the third-fewest runs in all of Double-A (45), Chesapeake currently leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in one-run victories with six so far this season. Last year, the Baysox had the third-most one-run wins in the Eastern League (25).

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

The Altoona Curve are the Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The Curve won their most recent series over Somerset after winning four of the last five against the Patriots. Chesapeake won two of three on Opening Weekend in Altoona. Altoona's active roster features five Pirates' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com): IF Terrance Johnson (No. 4), LHP Hunter Barco (No. 7), IF Jack Brannigan (No. 11), UTL Mitch Jebb (No. 13) and LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 14).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Hunter Barco makes his fourth start of the season for Altoona. The Pirates No. 7 prospect has yet to allow a run in 13 innings pitched this season as he has struck out 14 batters and walked just two. Barco pitched in High-A Greensboro last season where he fanned 77 hitters in 62 innings to a 3.34 ERA. The Pirates 2nd rounder in 2022 was drafted out of Florida and was teammates in college with former Baysox OF Jud Fabian.

2025: Struck out Double-A high nine in 5.1 IP on 4/10 vs ERI....Enters third season in Chesapeake. Named Opening Day starter for second year in a row. Only second Baysox pitcher ever to receive two Opening Day starts, joining Chorye Spooner.

2024: Spent entire season in Double-A Bowie. Completed second season as full-time starter after beginning pro career in bullpen. Named Opening Night starter. Pitched career-high 119.0 IP and struck out career-high 138 batters over 50 walks to a 4.24 ERA. Led team in IP and K. Finished 2nd in O's system in K and IP. Was 3rd in Eastern League and 6th in Double-A in K. 2nd in EL and 4th in Double-A in K/9 (10.44). After a 5.85 ERA in first half, posted 2.59 ERA in second half. Allowed only 3 HR in second half after allowing 11 HR in first half. Named EL Pitcher of Week for 7/9 -7/14 for first time in career after dealing 6.0 shutout IP with 6 K on 7/11 @ Altoona. Retired 17 of final 18 batters faced. First Baysox player to receive weekly award last season. Held 3rd-lowest ERA by an Eastern League starter in August (1.69 ERA) with minimum 25 IP. Threw 19 consecutive scoreless innings from 8/1- 8/18, which was longest scoreless streak by a Baysox pitcher this season. Baysox won 16 of last 23 games that Pham has started in.

Career Notes: Began '23 season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023....Spent first portion of '22 on the IL before eventually being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Earned promotion to Aberdeen on May 24. Placed on IL for the second time in the season in late June. Activated on August 5 and finished the season with Aberdeen....Debuted professionally in '21 between FCL - Orioles and Delmarva.

College: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing 7th in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

Personal: Drafted by the Orioles in the 19th round of the '21 Draft out of San Francisco...Holds a black belt in kung fu. Skilled with martial arts weapons. Favorite pitcher growing up was Tim Lincecum.

The updated team name represents a new chapter in Baysox baseball, expanding the brand to better reflect the broad and diverse community of fans who support the team across the region. The Baysox will continue to play at their home, Prince George's Stadium, in Bowie, Maryland.

The Chesapeake Baysox logos were created by Baltimore-based Younts Design, whose clients over the years have included a variety of professional baseball teams (including the Baltimore Orioles).

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
